However, the appellee questioned whether they would be subject to penalties or interest and, before agreeing to the dismissal of the appeal, wanted assurance that the appellee, Liberty Mutual Insurance Company, would not impose any penalties or interest. Because the answer to the appellee's question was unknown at the time of the teleconference, the appellant agreed to determine an answer to the question and notify the participants.

On January 18, 2017, Ms. Hanni on behalf of the appellee agreed to the dismissal of this case by email.
