## **Session 2 Focus Points**

## General Working Group Subjects:

- 1. Concentrated drinkable products (designed to be added to another beverage)
- 2. The one-drink equals one-serving approach
  - Delineating the what a serving is on the drinkable
- 3. The multi-serving-size approach
  - Delineating what a serving is on the drinkable packaging
  - Delineating the measurement of an actual serving on the drinkable
- 4. The secure packaging and safety labeling of the drinkable.

## Focus Points from Session 1:

- 1. The Alaska Poison Control System (APCS) data (sent by email to the Working Group and posted under Documents on web site for the public)
- 2. Advisory/warning labels to include minimum font size
- 3. A Universal Symbol (sent by email to the Working Group and posted under Documents on web site for the public)
- 4. Encourage product manufacturing licensees to hold an Alaska trade fair and information exchange related to:
  - (a) A catalog of selected/approved packaging
  - (b) Bulk combined orders for better pricing and reasonable unit amounts
  - (c) Measuring devices/systems for customers
  - (d) Child proof packaging
  - (e) Elimination of plastics/greener alternatives that safely comply
- 5. Education:
  - (a) DHSS education cards
  - (b) Point of Purchase education
- 6. Inform the discussion THC research (sent by email to the Working Group and posted under documents on web site for the public)
- 7. Breakdown of Article 5 of MCB regulations to have a separate drinkable subcategory from other editable products
