Chelsea Foster, with AMIA: They are grateful for the opportunity to share their thoughts. The Marijuana Control Board has discussed over the past year license caps and the impacts of federal legalization. In response, AMIA hosted a panel discussion on August 31 with local and national experts. It was an informative discussion on the impacts of federal legalization but that addressed a multitude of complexities that are likely to occur. This discussion will be provided to the board via the marijuana mailbox. They are excited to be at the table, along with others in this industry on the topics of laboratory testing standards. Especially with regards to pesticide use and additive and microbial identification. There's also much work to be done on regulations surrounding packaging, required labeling and transportation. They continue to stand ready to line to any collective expertise they are invited to provide. They also appreciate recent action by AMCO Enforcement to address an illegal and unregulated product sales. They understand this type of investigation is difficult and demanding, but it is incredibly important the enforcement of these laws and regulations - supports those whose livelihoods depend on the regulated cannabis industry as part of the foundation for the legal industry it's key to consumer confidence and for product safety. Thank you to the director, the board and to the staff for all of your hard work, thank you for your time today.

Teri Zell, licensee: Audio issues with Zoom. Every day COVID has been the headliner the last two more desperate vaccine breakthroughs more cases than ever more and deaths. Wondering why we're waiting for the Governor to take an emergency what didn't you like it or not, and whether

the regulations say we can't talk about it or not, most of our customers are coming in, for their medicine and they want to feel safe. Many are going through cancer treatments and have compromised immune systems, I understand that were the main issues your attorney made with it, and AMCO has no jurisdiction inside people's vehicles, having a point of sale in the car is unenforceable. Point of sale does not change, whether you are in the store or inside your vehicle - the transaction is on camera, or rather several cameras, we can see everyone in the vehicle, around the vehicle, inside the store where the transaction is taking place. Our drive window, we have pharmacy caliber system -the transaction takes place just the same as if you drove up to your pharmacy and we're picking up opioid prescriptions. It can't get any safer than that. Last year I sent AMCO many customer surveys that were supportive in bringing the drive thru back. I also invited AMCO officers to come out and see our operation so they could understand how it works. Nobody did. Not only is it more convenient for people with compromised immune systems, but also much safer for handicapped and openly people in the winter, to use the drive thru. I am asking the board to allow us to reopen our drive thru, I am not asking for curbside pickup to be reinstated, because I believe that is an unsafe practice.

Ryan Tunseth, licensee: He invites the MCB to Kenai for a meeting. He has good and bad statements. The Bad: testing. We sort of tied the cash register this number that we can quarantee is right, it seems difficult and if you have, that it's obvious, people are going to try to manipulate or do whatever they can to get the highest number. Some people will. And it's also difficult when you have different types of bud to carry that same testing, so whether it's trim for amateur or whatever, it doesn't mean that it's going to be at the same test number and so that's the whole manifest having open information still. I trust all my budtenders, I know they're really good but I'm not so sure about yours kind of thing and it worries people in the industry that information is still on there. And the frustration over what appears to be loans from state of Alaska for delinquent taxes in it, it is very much alone, in my opinion when you're on a payment plan sort of removes you from the short list. Is kind of difficult for people in the industry to handle, obviously questions about looming federal legalization that's a whole other issue - I don't know if that's good or bad. The Good: the board efficiency of the staff. I really feel like this between the legal team and everything that's together right now is like really super good so any engagement between outside people with Jana, Jason and like to the AMIA just feel like it's a really good group right now, and also enforcing outside actors or increasing the limit because it's definitely on the edible side that most of the black-market activity is occurring because we have this really low number. And you know, moving that number up, I think, helped and I think it helped edibles manufacturers and I think it also helps break into that black-market sales. Finally, I think the answer is in very, very brief short way, I think that we, I didn't think I was ever going to say this, but I think the tax probably should eventually be moved to retail - that probably gives us the best protection long term. Outside of that, I would just tax everything if it doesn't go there just tax everything into. That was certainly give the relief to cultivators that they very much need. I think the market could probably absorb it and it would get rid of any of this moving product.

Jana Welzin, with JDW Law - counsel for many licensees: I wanted to thank Enforcement for their recent actions against folks that are engaged in the marijuana market without going through the hassle getting regulated testing of the product. So we really, really support Enforcement in that effort and the Director for helping Enforcement get there and feeling empowered enough to take those steps. I agree with Teri on that, on the drive thru concept is something to think about. I think that conversation should continue.

Last week I was in Vegas for the marijuana conference and there was a lot of good takeaways. I talked to a lot of B2B companies from Canada, a lot of experts, a lot of lawyers. Some are realizing

that it's not going to be for five to seven years, some people think it's more like, how I think, two to three years. One thing is clear, though, that you know there's going to be some changes the way we do business once it happens, and you know, one of those changes kind of was brought up by Ms. Muse pointed out about the concentrates, and so one thing to think about when you have a 99% concentrate level is that there's no additives right, so the FDA is not going to allow food grade glycerin like we have right now. I think we can start looking at what's in vape pens and really thinking about the packaging and making sure it's clear to the public, whether there's coconut oil in there or whether there's food grade glycerin in there, because your lungs don't eat and those things can have negative consequences. I think that's actually a really good focus point for this board and the folks that really work on those issues.

I wanted to discuss separating the application review queue because it is really long right now and it's not a not a staff problem, it's more of like renewals on top of new applications, on top of premises changes, on top of operating plan changes. Before, I'm not sure when they stopped doing this, the new applications kind of went their own review and then the MJ-14s, the operating plan changes, MJ-15s, MJ-16s will be in their own review queue. There's a couple reasons for this, one would be you know, for example, if Enforcement comes and does an inspection, they say, "well, this is pretty much like your diagram but you kind of missed this wall and when it's covered by cameras. It will be better if you would update your diagram and before and found MJ-14 to make sure that your local government and the board knows exactly the layout." And so they do that and they kind of anticipate that's going to get, well I don't want to speak for them, but I kind of anticipate that's going to get processed quickly, but sometimes it gives me the same with us what takes seven months to meet regulatory compliance - to have your diagram match the actual layout so that's one example.

Another issue that's going to come up, and we're going to see it more and more, as a PACT Act got passed right and the final rules and regulations and response to the 15,000 comments that were received on it got finalized, and so the PACT Act is going to prohibit interstate commerce and using appropriate interstate commerce prohibit the shipping of certain vape pen cartridges off hardware through USPS, and so for Alaska that that means a lot more than it does for, say Michigan, that is accessible through different means of transport. So for folks that are going to be negatively affected by this, they're going to have to find a different source or a different type of hardware that isn't prohibited by the PACT Act so they're going to need a MJ-15 to make those changes.

So streamlining those MJ-14s and 15s. I mean MJ-16s, is a little less arguable for a trade compliance because products, but at least MJ-14s and 15s really help folks staying compliant and not have to make business decisions of what do, "should I stop making this product that, basically, is 90% of my businesses in and wait seven months" or do I just say, "well I'd rather just asked for forgiveness". I think that's a hard choice to put people in.

I also wanted to revisit the idea of transfers with security interests, like how we do for liquor licenses. So for liquor licenses if you sell your license to somebody you can finance it, and then you take a security interest on it, and then you can foreclose on that debtor for security interest if they don't pay their obligation and we've seen a few of these issues come up in front of us already putting this really awkward position of, "he says, she said", did you comply with your obligations, did you not to even want to answer that question, but what the security interest regulation that kind of negates that people have already made the choice if they default on our obligations, then they agree to have their license go back to the original license holders and I think that would be helpful in this industry.

When I was in Vegas I ran the idea, the concept of the distributors license through several different states, I mean stays several different license holders in different states and several different attorneys that practice in different states. And they all said, that's a great idea and I actually got some experts to agree to help me come up with some proposed language so at the next meeting I'm going to put it in the marijuana mailbox. Because I have some tobacco and alcohol distributors in the Lower 48 and Missouri and whatnot and they're going to help me kind of with an idea of what I mean you could look like for just. That's it, thank you for your time.

# A. STEC Testing Guidance

<u>TAB 9</u>

Due to the availability of Patryce McKinney, EHL Chief, Tab 9 is rescheduled for discussion at 1 pm 10/26.

10/26 1:04 pm: Rick Helms and Director Klinkhart summarize the memo. Patryce McKinney is present on Zoom. A majority of illnesses come from the 7 referenced organisms, but there are about 200 organisms that could make someone ill. Bruce S. suggests if they go down the route to requiring all 7 be tested, the board should allow a grace period for the labs to come into compliance. Ms. McKinney suggests the board should define and specify all 7 in a guidance document. Joan W. speaks about appeal rights. The board can issue quidance legally. Bruce S. suggests they open a regulations project to revisit at the January meeting while issuing quidance with the grace period to perhaps the end of January. Nick M. asks how long it could take a lab to get ready to do this? Ms. McKinney says 3 months would be realistic – could ask for an extension with a real timeline in place. If the board says the testing would be done by PCR, they are limiting the lab to specific technology. Rick H. suggests adding at the end of the guidance "Lab testing licensees must be in compliance in three months of the approval of this document." Bruce S. says to remove "reminds" in first sentence and replace with "advise". Nick M. doesn't want to include all 200 organisms without more discussion and suggests that Rick H. gets with the labs to discuss extending to the 200. STEC is either found or not found in the DNA. Bruce S. motions to adopt the guidance and change the word "remind" to "advise" testing labs in first paragraph. Add a final paragraph that it becomes effective on February 1, 2022. Christopher J. seconds for discussion. Bruce amends motion "to clarify for testing labs". Christopher J. seconds. None opposed, motion passes.

# B. Handler Permit Applicants Under Preindictment Memo

**TAB 10** 

Rick Helms summarizes the memo. Some people were denied a handler's permit while in preindictment status. Bruce S. isn't comfortable with that action. Christopher J. says the redesign of the card is up to the Director. What is the suggested timeline? Rick H. gives some examples such as self-reporting. Joan speaks to the process of someone getting arrested. Pre-Indictment Hearing (PIH) can take 10 days unless it is extended and can't deny someone in this status. She suggests waiting until after the PIH hearing. Eliza M. doesn't see a need for a regulation change. Nick M. says a redesign is fine, but do not increase fees even if renewing annually – he does not want to see an increase of cost.

# A. Enforcement Supervisor's Report

**TAB 11** 

10:46 am: James Hoelscher presents his report. Chief Hoelscher has seen a large uptake of signage violations. The intent of the regulations has been stretched by licensees. 3 signs are allowed. But there are LED signs with moving words. He requests the board create a definition of signage in 3 AAC 306.770. Bruce S. is open to revisiting the issue. Eliza M. would like to see what other states have for regulatory language. Christopher J. agrees with both board members – this does need to be addressed. Nick M. believes they need a regulations project – but also allow the local governing bodies decide the size and number of signs – what should

the board be regulating? Bruce S. would like to think on this topic more before making a motion.

There is a discussion about granting peaceable powers to Investigator Moses. **Bruce S. motions to grant peaceable powers contingent on concurrence from public safety for Investigator Moses based off his qualification listed in the letter. Christopher J. seconds for discussion.** Eliza M. asks what is the purpose of carrying a firearm? Chief Hoelscher and
Director Klinkhart answer, the investigators are peace officers and able to work with other law
enforcement agencies. **Eliza M. abstains from voting, motion passes 3-0.** 

Director Klinkhart has an updated report from Department of Revenue (DOR) – the list is getting smaller. Nick M. asks if DOR is pursuing collections or are they waiting to hear from the board for those who are out of business? Nick M. is more interested in current licensees that owe back taxes. Nicole Reynolds, Deputy Director of the Tax Division, is present on Zoom. They include the out of business licensees because AMCO had asked for that information. There is a collections section in their department. Christopher J. likes seeing the out of business names – it's helpful for transfers. Nick M. speaks about the taxes are owed by the individual. Staff should be double checking – flag them somehow.

Eliza M. mentions Enforcement's priorities regarding selling to minors – asks how he has the data. The Chief says it's both industries combined. How often does he report this data – she would like to see it separated from alcohol to study the trending. Chief Hoelscher says a records reporting system would need to be purchased.

There are too many issues doing it this way which in turn creates more work for staff.

Nick M. mentions the security interest public comment for transfers. Jana Weltzin explains the security interest process – asks the board to explore it by reviewing the alcohol regulation, 3 AAC 304.106. The board would like a memo from Jane Sawyer and Joan Wilson about exploring the possibility.

Nick M. would like a regulation project on the "will" regarding the taxes. **Bruce S. motions to open a regulation project to explore modification in order to give the board greater** 

discretion about renewals and taxes, 3 AAC 306.080(b). Christopher J. seconds. None opposed, motion passes.

Nick M. asks for a motion to direct Joan Wilson to work with DOR on the security issue. **Bruce**S. motions to request counsel open dialogue with DOR focusing on offering security on taxes.
Christopher J. seconds. None opposed., motion passes.

Eliza Muse would like a working group put together regarding intersection of hemp products and how they make their way into the products AMCO regulates. She would like to have a better guidance or framework to be able to make a better decision on approving or not approving pasteurized products, additives, adulterants. She would like to have a better framework to make these decisions.

# C. Opened Regulations Projects

### 1. Initial Drafts

**Enforcement Action Process** 

**TAB 95** 

Status: draft for board discussion

Potential Board Actions: board to discuss at meeting

Joan Wilson summarizes the draft and she emphasizes that this is a first draft. The point of this draft was to take all the discussions on enforcement that we have power points on and creating the violation/intermediate series and taking that process and changing our regulations to conform with that, if we could. Creates an initial verbal warning. It defines when an advisory notice would be given. It creates an NOV process that links with the fines schedule the board will be looking at here later. Joan further explains what the draft does. Joan gives the board options on what to do with the draft at this point: working groups, more staff work, send it out for public comment. (Some more discussion).

The board would like more time to thoroughly review the draft and develop some thoughts and come back at the January meeting.

(The board goes to Tabs 96, 97, and 98, and then comes back to this Tab.)

Bruce Schulte moves to put this draft out for public comment for 60 days. Christopher Jaime seconds. No further discussion. Motion passes 4-0.

### **Transfer of License to Another Location**

**TAB 96** 

Status: draft for board discussion

Potential Board Actions: board to discuss at meeting

Jane Sawyer and Joan Wilson summarize the draft. Nick Miller states that he is who requested this regulation but he needs more time to read it. Bruce Schulte feels the same way about needing more time to review the draft but he does support the idea of transferring location in any part of the state recognizing that licensees will need to go through the same review and approval process. No further discussion. Draft to be put back on the agenda for January 2022.

Joan Wilson offers to have special meetings on regulations.

Director Klinkhart summarizes the background. **Bruce Schulte motions to adopt. Christopher Jaime seconds. None opposed, motion passes.** 

Fine Schedule TAB 98

**Status:** public comment closed September 28, 2021. Comments were received. **Potential Board Actions:** board to discuss at meeting

Director Klinkhart summarizes the background: in May the board sent out this fine schedule out for public comment. The schedule was out for 61 days. Comments were received and they are attached. Nick Miller asks if there was only one comment received. Bruce Schulte clarifies that there are more in the packet. (board looking over the comments). Bruce thanks Bryan for his submitted written comment. Christopher Jaime asks Bryan if he was part of the working group for the fine schedule. Bryan states he was. Bruce acknowledges that there was a lot of work put into the project.

Joan Wilson states that not knowing what the board is going to do today with this project, she just wants to say that until a separate NOV process is in place (currently in the works), fines will still have to be issued through accusations and, unless the party agrees to the (fine) amount, they will have an appeal right there directly to OAH. She further states (the process) will work smoothly once there is an NOV process in place but still works now, and just wants people to know that there will be still be an appeal process.

Glen Klinkhart offers comments on the project: ... he doesn't think this project is "putting the cart before the horse"... he states the fine schedule (the dollar amounts) is already being used to try to determine, in an accusation, what is a reasonable fine, which is good because he is already seeing some consistency.

Joan states that it could be that there is not an appeal; the licensee may say that this (fine) is reasonable based upon the Fine Schedule. All of the members of the industry are being treated the same... Bruce asks Joan if she is comfortable to say that if they adopt this fine schedule now it's going to be okay. Joan might have to explain it to someone, but she thinks it is.

Christopher Jaime states that with the fine schedule in place it does promote consistency across the board, ...(inaudible).. with an experienced director who is there to guide enforcement, he thinks this is a good first step.

Joan brings up the struggles on the alcohol side where almost all violations are treated as misdemeanors... (small discussion around the topic). Nick Miller brings up the issues regarding getting insurance where MCB accusations exist: accusations affect their

(licensees) insurance rates. He is concerned with having to issue an accusation just to give a fine; this is concerning to him. He considers accusations to be very serious, but he acknowledges a lot of work has been put into this (project) and wants to get it done. But he does not want to penalize businesses because in order to give them a fine, they need to be given an accusation when it doesn't rise to the level of an accusation. He states accusations means different things in the way (people) do business. (little more discussion regarding the issuing of an accusation just to fine a licensee).

Glen explains that he is using discretion to issue accusations for the most egregious matters. Joan states that 3 AAC 306.840 "the board may, in addition to any other penalties..., impose a civil fine...." She states that the board, absent an accusation, does not have a mechanism to impose a fine, but she hears the concerns. (more discussion regarding accusations and insurance premiums). Joan reiterates that the director is already looking at the fine schedule to determine the appropriate amount when issuing an accusation. She believes there is value to the board adopting it.

Bruce Schulte moves to adopt the project as presented. Christopher Jaime seconds. No further discussion. Motion passes 4-0.

### Reinstatement of License - failure to renew

**TAB 99** 

**Status:** public comment closed October 1, 2021. Comment was received. **Potential Board Actions:** vote to adopt as is; amend and send back out for p.c.; send back to staff for more work; close project without action

Joan Wilson and Jane Sawyer summarize the memo. Bruce Schulte motions to adopt the regulation change. Christopher Jaime seconds. Bruce motions to amend the draft to change the look back period from 10 to 5 years. Christopher Jaime seconds for discussion. None opposed, motion passes. Main motion: None opposed, motion passes.
