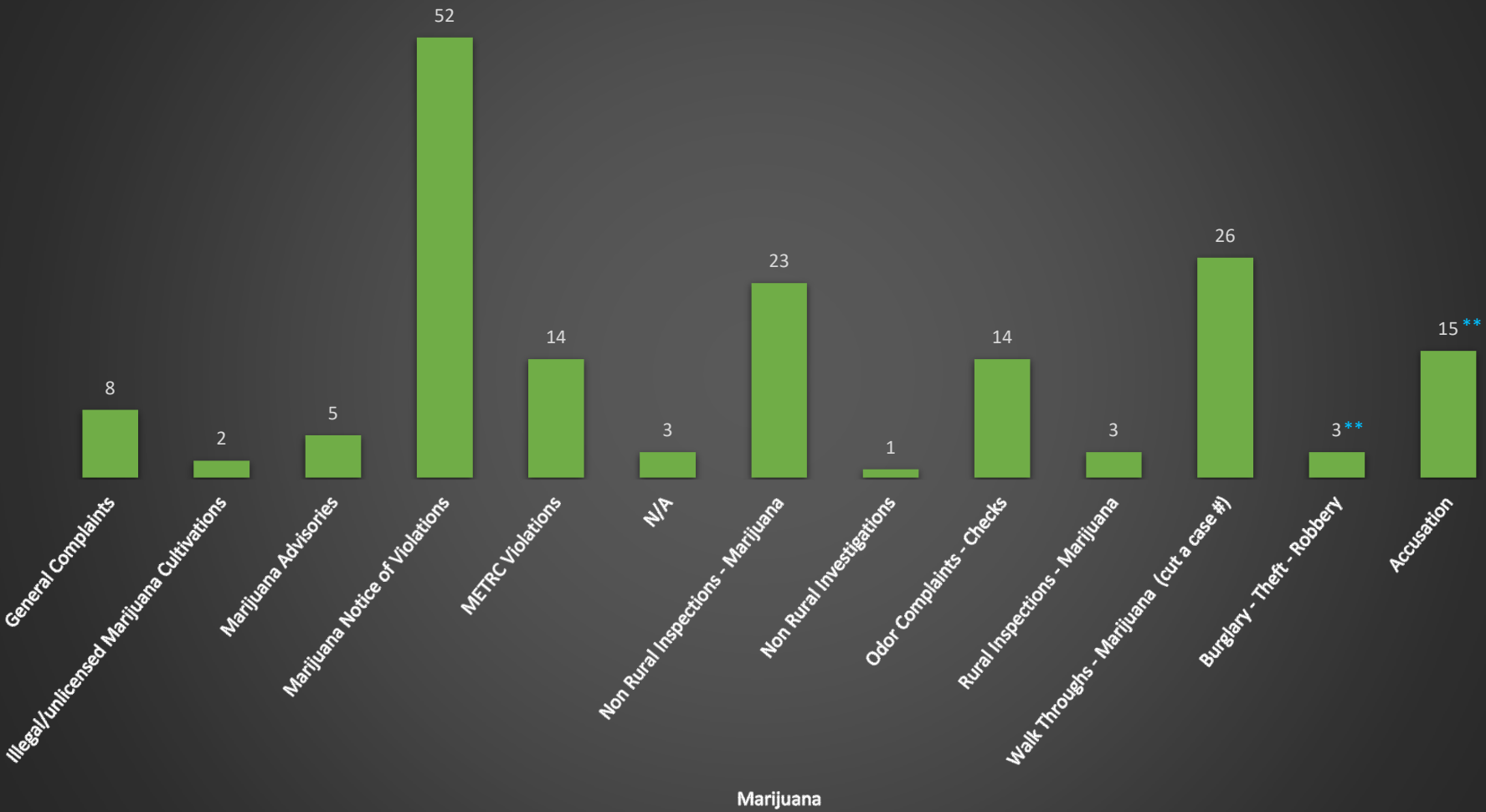
AMCO Enforcement has continued to conduct regular inspections and audits of marijuana establishments. We are anticipating a busy spring and summer as we increase travel to more locations across the State. Our two newest Investigators continue to familiarize themselves with the industry and have proven to be valuable assets to our team.

The Metrc Customer Success Team will be in Anchorage the week of June 10th. They will be providing advanced user training for our newest team members as well as conducting on-site visits with licensees. In past years this opportunity has proven very valuable to both AMCO and licensees, so we are looking forward to their return.

We have entered into an updated MOU with the Division of Agriculture to assist with enforcement of industrial hemp products. We plan to conduct joint inspections beginning later this month.

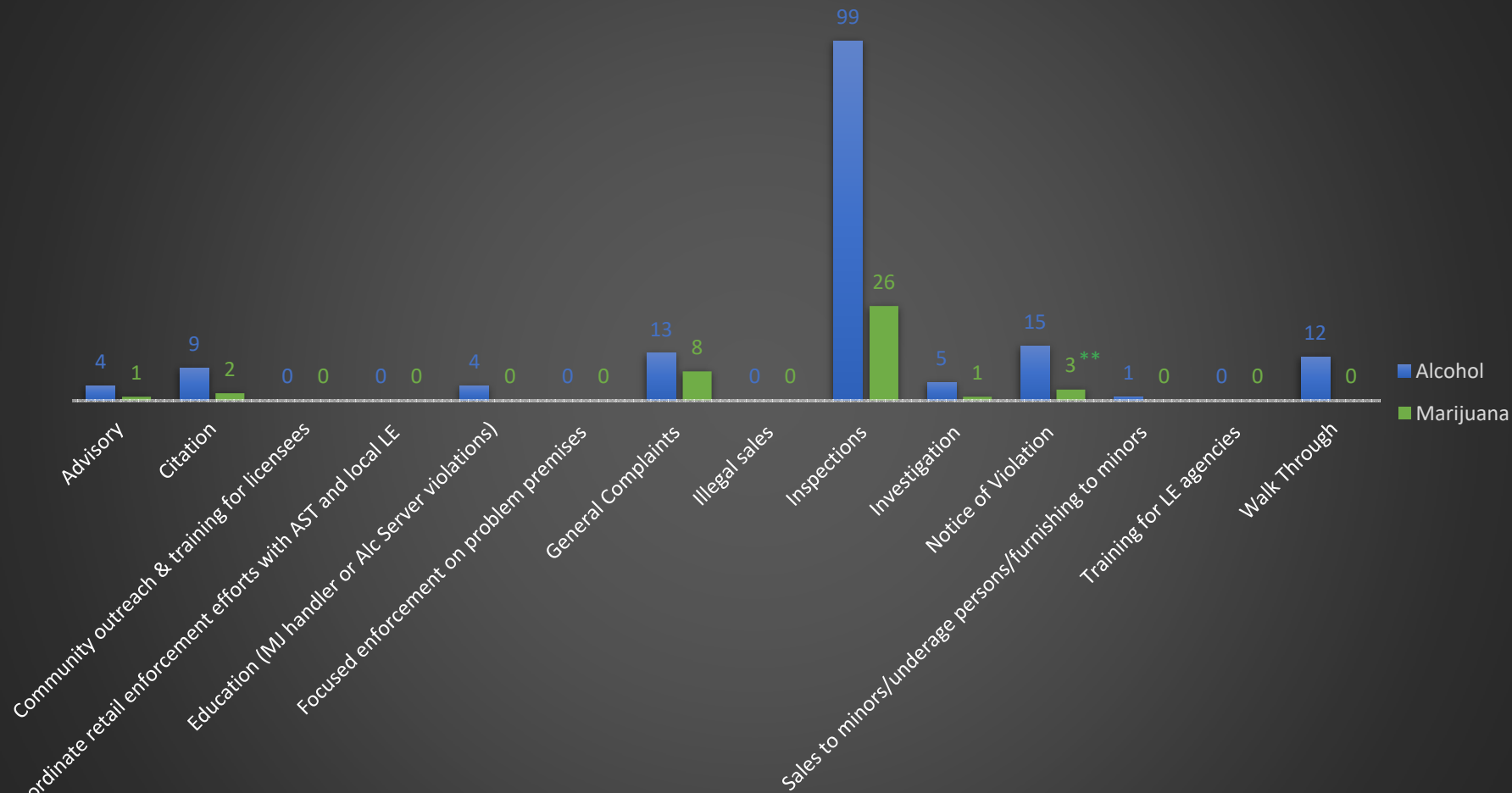
