STIPULATED AGREEMENT AND ORDER

The Division of Insurance (division), and Jennifer C. Heesch (Heesch), the license applicant in this case, stipulate and agree to the following:

I. BACKGROUND

A. On or about December 13, 2013, the division received from Heesch an application for an individual producer property and casualty authority license.

B. One question on the application asks whether the applicant has ever been convicted of a misdemeanor or felony; had a judgment withheld or deferred; or was currently charged with committing a misdemeanor or felony. Heesch responded affirmatively to this question but failed to submit the supplemental documentation pertaining to the conviction(s). The filing was also incomplete pending receipt of the state and federal criminal history reports.

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2 C. The division subsequently received the supplemental criminal documents and
3 criminal history reports necessary to process Heesch's application.

4
5 D. Heesch's criminal history reports identified a number of incidents including a
6 July, 1998 Assault; a 1999 Theft by Deception, in which Heesch pled no contest and was
7 placed on probation for three years; and a 2012 felony conviction for Controlled Substance 4 –
8 Possession, in which Heesch was placed on probation for two years and 180 days.
9 Additionally, there were several other misdemeanor charges and one felony charge that were
10 dismissed or not prosecuted.

11 E. AS 21.27.020 sets forth the general qualifications for licensure in this state.
12 AS 21.27.020(a) provides: "For the protection of the people of this state, the director may not
13 issue or renew a license except in compliance with this chapter and may not issue a license to a
14 person, or to be exercised by a person, found by the director to be untrustworthy, incompetent,
15 or who has not established to the satisfaction of the director that the person is qualified under
16 this chapter."

18 F. To qualify for issuance or renewal of an individual license, AS 21.27.020(b)(4)
19 requires the applicant or licensee to be a trustworthy person and AS 21.27.020(b)(6) requires
20 the applicant or licensee not to have committed an act that is the cause for denial, nonrenewal,
21 suspension, or revocation of a license in this state or another jurisdiction.

23 G. Under AS 21.27.410(a)(7), the director may deny issuance of or not renew a
24 license or may suspend or revoke a license issued under this chapter for conviction of a felony.

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2 II. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

3 1. Heesch agrees to the issuance by the division of a conditional license under the
4 following conditions:

5 i. All terms of Heesch's current probation are to be completed successfully.

6
7 ii. Heesch agrees that the conduct for which she was convicted, if occurring
8 under a license, would constitute a violation of AS 21.27.410(a)(8).


9
10 iii. The conditional license is predicated on Heesch not violating any laws. If
11 Heesch violates any laws or regulations, Heesch shall notify the division within ten days of
12 being charged with or receiving notification of the violation.

13 iv. If Heesch violates the insurance laws and regulations while issued a
14 conditional license, the division will take administrative action to suspend or revoke the license
15 issued to her and Heesch shall be subject to any and all sanctions authorized by law, including
16 the imposition of additional penalties regarding such violation.

17
18 2. Heesch understands that this agreement is not binding on the parties unless and
19 until the director signs the order adopting this agreement.






