ACCUSATION

&

ORDER OF DENIAL

Lori Wing-Heier, Director of the Division of Insurance (division), Department of
Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (DCCED), State of Alaska, states
the issues on which the accusation is based as follows:

1. On or about May 25th, 2021, the Alaska Department of Commerce,
Community and Economic Development, Division of Insurance
(division) issued an Insurance Producer license to transact the business
of insurance to **Benjamin Roth Robertson (ROBERTSON)**, domiciled
in the State of Texas. The license has an expiration date of January 31st,
on even numbered years.

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2. In this initial application, **ROBERTSON** responded negatively to all background questions regarding administrative action and criminal history.
3. At close of business on January 31st, 2022, the license expired for failure to renew. **ROBERTSON** received three renewal notices from the division, dated December 7th, 2021, January 6th, 2022 and February 5th, 2022.
4. On November 29th, 2022, a reinstatement application was received for **ROBERTSON**'s Insurance Producer license. This application indicates that **ROBERTSON** has an administrative action in his insurance producer history. The action taken by the state of South Carolina dated November 10th, 2020, was not disclosed at initial licensure.
ROBERTSON obtained his initial Insurance Producer license in Alaska supplying inaccurate information.
5. AS 21.27.040(a) states that "(a) Application for a license shall be made to the director upon forms prescribed by the director. As a part of or in connection with the application, the applicant shall furnish information concerning the applicant's identity, personal history, experience, business record, purposes, and other pertinent facts that the director may reasonably require. The applicant shall declare, subject to penalty of denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license issued by the director, that the statements made in or in connection with the

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application are true, correct, and complete to the best of the applicant's knowledge and belief..."

- 6. AS 21.27.020(a) provides: "For the protection of the people of this state, the director may not issue or renew a license except in compliance with this chapter and not issue a license to a person, or to be exercised by a person, found by the director to be untrustworthy, incompetent, or who has not established to the satisfaction of the director that the person is qualified under this chapter."
- 7. AS 21.27.020(b)(4) provides: "To qualify for issuance or renewal of an individual license, an applicant or licensee shall (4) be a trustworthy person." Pursuant to AS 21.27.020(a) and (b)(4), the reinstatement of **ROBERTSON'S** insurance producer license should be DENIED.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, under the provisions of AS 21.27.020 that **ROBERTSON'S** reinstatement application for the Insurance Producer license # 3001322817 is DENIED for supplying inaccurate information at initial licensure.
