Only officers (president; vice-president; secretary; treasurer) who have an Executive Officer Waiver (EOW) issued by the Alaska Workers' Compensation Board are exempt from workers' compensation; all other directors and employees must be insured.	
Attach your Executive Officer Waiver. Your application is incomplete and will not be processed without an EOW.	
I am aware that, based on the type of business checked above, I am exempting myself, my partner(s), and all members of our LLC from workers' compensation insurance. I understand that should an injury occur on a jobsite, I/we will not be eligible to seek benefits under the Alaska Workers' Compensation Act.	
I declare that if there is a change to my exemption status, I will provide proof of workers' compensation insurance to the Division to remain in compliance with AS 23.30.
