Agenda Item 1 – Review of Agenda

The board reviewed the agenda and added the following:

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- Discussion of establishing fees to reflect the new license types coming into effect under the amended Chapter 28.

Agenda Item 2 – Review of Sedation Regulations

The Board began a page by page review of the sedation regulations. Ms. Greider’s presence in the teleconference proved quite useful. She was able to explain to the satisfaction of the board the reasons behind certain wordings and, for the few minor edits the board wished to make, provided appropriate vocabulary and input on the editing and placement of subsections.

Page 4 – Move “and” up to subparagraph 3 and renumber subparagraph 5 to be 4.

Page 6 – second line down remove one of the two “of”s.

Page 12 – Delete paragraph 4 move “and” to paragraph 3 and renumber paragraph 5 to be 4.

Page 20 – Delete “and” at the end of paragraph f.

Page 24 – Delete “and” at the end of paragraph m.

Page 28 – Delete “for moderate sedation” from paragraph 3; already clear what it is regarding. Same change on Page 27, but “for minimal sedation”. “for deep sedation” to remain.

On a motion duly made by Nielson, seconded by Ross, and approved by roll call vote, it was

RESOLVED to approve the recent draft of the sedation regulations to be sent out for public comment.

Dr. Nielson accepted Dr. Wells’ input regarding the inclusion of the edits made during the discussion and amended the motion before the roll was taken.
