(a) As an alternative to the disciplinary sanctions set out in AS 08.68.275, the board may offer successful completion of an alternative to discipline program (ADP) approved by the board, to a licensee who habitually abuses alcohol or illegally uses controlled substances.

- (b) The board may offer an alternative to discipline program under this section to a licensee who
- (1) has not been found by any state or federal authority including any regulatory or administrative authority to have harmed a patient while under the influence of drugs or alcohol;
- (2) has not been convicted of any crime related to the sale or distribution of any medication;
- (3) has not been terminated from or failed to complete an alternative to discipline program in any state; and
 - (4) has not had a nursing license suspended or revoked in any jurisdiction.
- (c) A licensee who meets the requirements in (b) of this section and is approved by the board to participate in an alternative to discipline program must
 - (1) provide disclosure authorizations as requested;
- (2) abstain from all alcohol and drugs, including cannabinoids, except as prescribed to the participant;
- (3) provide documentation of a substance use disorder evaluation from a licensed physician or APRN experienced in the diagnosis and treatment of substance use disorders.
