The 2023 Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) Awareness Feedback survey was distributed to prescribers in Alaska to gauge their experience with the PDMP. This fact sheet shows the results of this survey for the 22 prescribing dentists who responded to the survey. The majority (87%) of dentists have been using the PDMP for at least 5-6 years.

Most dentists review patients in the PDMP before their appointment, and those that they review beforehand are patients with a current prescription or who they anticipate will need a prescription.
