The 2023 Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) Awareness Feedback survey was distributed to prescribers in Alaska to gauge their experience with the PDMP. This fact sheet shows the results of this survey for the 13 prescribing veterinarians who responded to the survey. The majority (72%) of veterinarians have been using the PDMP for at least 3-4 years.




How helpful is your licensing board regarding PDMP registration?



A third of responding veterinarians indicated they <u>have not attempted</u> to contact their board. Of those who did, 55% found their board not at all helpful.










