

Dear Ms. Franklin,

I am writing you regarding the Alcohol Beverage Control Board's preliminary rejection of Melanie White's application for renewal of her liquor license. Ms. White's liquor license renewal was to be postmarked and mailed by February 28, 2015. The attached affidavits of Ms. White, and her father, William Sewell, attest to the fact that Ms. White substantially complied with the post marking and mailing requirements of her liquor license renewal.

Because of hazardous road conditions, Mr. Sewell drove the application packet to the Geist Post Office and attempted to purchase a postage meter strip which would have had the appropriate postmark. But the automated postage meter did not properly dispense the postage strip. He then purchased stamps and placed them on a large express mail envelope, crossing out references to express or priority mail. Because of the 4:00 PM postmark deadline for the drop box at Geist Post Office, Mr. Sewell drove to the Airport Post Office, where he used the dropbox. Mr. Sewell had no idea that The Airport Post Office would return the liquor license renewal packet for failure to apply enough postage for express delivery when all he intended was regular delivery.

I'm enclosing copies of Mr. Sewell's receipt for the postage stamps he bought at the Geist Post Office. This receipt is dated February 28, 2015 and time stamped at approximately 8:19 PM.

I'm also including copies of the large mailing envelope Mr. Sewall Dropped off at the Airport Post Office. An examination of this envelope shows:

1. The crossing off of all references to express or priority mail (the blue marker used does not show up on the black and white copies. Color copies are being mailed with the original of this letter); **See Attachments 2 & 3**
2. The address side of the envelope has a sticker marked returned for postage due; **See Attachment 2**
3. A postal agent also handwrote on the address side of the envelope "postage" with an arrow pointing to the reverse side where the postage stamps were placed prior to mailing. **See Attachments 2 & 3**

I believe when this matter is looked at in its entirety it is clear that Ms. White substantially complied with the requirements of post marking and mailing her liquor license application by February 28, 2015. Unfortunately, because of the malfunctioning automated postage meter, Mr. Sewell had to purchase stamps and use an available express mail envelope to complete the mailing. In good faith, he crossed out all references to express or priority mail expecting regular delivery.

This is not a situation where the applicant was dilatory. The Geist Post Office has confirmed problems with its automated postage meter. In view of the totality of the circumstances, Ms. White respectfully requests her liquor license renewal application be given reconsideration and that it be accepted as having been substantially postmarked and mailed on February 28, 2015.

I, Melanie White, being first duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

1. I am over 18 and competent to testify.
2. I am the Chief Executive Officer of H54B, Inc., doing business as The Moose Creek Lodge (Lodge). The Lodge dispenses alcoholic beverages pursuant to State of Alaska license number 527.
3. The renewal deadline for license number 527 was February 28, 2015.
4. I believed that in order to renew my liquor license I needed to complete, signed and notarized the liquor license renewal application, and mail and post mark it, along with the appropriate fees, by February 28, 2015.
5. On February 28, 2015, Salcha and the Fairbanks North-Star Borough area experienced a snowstorm resulting in very poor and dangerous road conditions. Because of the very poor road conditions, my father volunteered to help me mail my liquor license renewal application.

6. I signed and notarized my liquor license renewal application at the Wells Fargo Bank branch located at University and Giest in Fairbanks on February 28, 2015. This bank branch is several blocks away from the Geist Post Office.

6. My father offered to mail my liquor license application from the Geist Post Office because of the bad road conditions. The Geist Post Office has an automated postage meter and that office is open until 10 PM.

7. I did not anticipate that there would be any problem whatsoever in mailing and post marking my liquor license application on February 28, 2015.

8. On March 2, my father received a call from the Salcha Post Office and forming him that my liquor license application had been returned for insufficient postage. My father instructed the postal agent to repackage four remailing my liquor license application and I went to that Post Office on March 3, 2015 to pay for that remailing.

9. On March 4, 2015 I received a call and an e-mail from Jane Sawyer, business registration examiner for the Alcohol Beverage Control Board informing me that my liquor license renewal application was being rejected as untimely. Because I believe my father substantially complied with the process of mailing my liquor license application on time I believe the rejection of my liquor license renewal application was wrong.

10. On March 18, 2014, I went to the Geist Post Office with my attorney, Mike Stepovich, in order to troubleshoot the automated postage meter located there. I purchased a postage meter strip from that automated postage meter and it failed fully dispense the post marked meter strip. Mr. Stepovich then spoke to the Post Office

Carrier Supervisor who confirmed that customers had frequent problems with the automated postage meter failing to fully dispense postage meter strips. When the postage meter strip is not fully dispensed, it is not visible to the customer and the customer is led to believe that the automated postage meter accepted his/her monies without dispensing the appropriate postage meter strip.

11. My father then purchased and applied postage stamps to my liquor license renewal application packet, at approximately 8:19 p.m., because of the failure of the automated postage meter to properly dispense the post-marked meter strip.

12. My dad then drove to the Airport Branch Post Office to mail my liquor license renewal application packet because, even though the automated postage meter is available at the Geist Post Office until 10 p.m., post marking is only available at the drop box until 4 PM. Post marking is available at the Airport Post Office until at least six p.m..

I, William Sewell, being first duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

1. I am over 18 and competent to testify.
2. I am the father of Melanie White. On February 28, 2015, the Fairbanks North-Star Borough experienced a heavy snowstorm and hazardous road conditions. Because of that, I volunteered to help Melanie mail her liquor license renewal application.
3. After Melanie had the completed application notarized at the Wells Fargo Bank branch, located at University and Geist, I drove it to the Geist Post Office for post marking and mailing.
4. At the Geist Post Office, I attempted to buy a postage meter strip from the automated postage meter. I paid the appropriate monies, but the automated postage meter did not dispense a postage meter strip as far as I could tell.

5. I then took an express mail envelope, available at the post office, and crossed out any references to express or priority mail. At about 8:19 p.m., I purchased a book of stamps and placed nine of them on the large envelope I was using to mail the liquor license renewal packet.

6. The automated postage meter is available at the Geist until 10:00 p.m. although postmarks are only available from the dropbox until 4:00 PM. In order to assure proper post marking, I went to the Airport Post Office to drop off the liquor license renewal packet. Post marking is available at the Airport Post Office dropbox until at least 6:00 p.m.

7. I placed enough postage on the liquor license application package for regular delivery. I fully believed that by crossing out all references to express or priority mail on the large envelope, the liquor license application packet would be postmarked on February 28, 2015, and delivered by regular mail.

8. On March 2, 2015 I received a call from the Salcha Post Office telling me that Melanie's liquor license application had been returned for insufficient postage. I asked the postal agent to repackage the liquor license application and to send it back out. This was done on March 3, 2015, after Melanie went to the Salcha Post Office and paid for an express over-night delivery of that liquor license application packet.

9. I believe in examination of all of the facts in this matter demonstrates that Melanie substantially complied with the post marking and mailing requirements of her liquor license renewal. I have receipt for the stamps I purchased and placed on the liquor license application packet on February 28, 2015.

10. I attempted to use the automated postage meter at the Geist Post Office but it did not dispense a postage meter strip.

11. In order to assure proper post marking, I bought stamps and then went to the Airport Post Office to mail the liquor license application packet. I had no idea this packet would be returned because I used an express mail envelope even though I crossed out all references thereto and had applied enough postage for regular delivery.



The Advertisement did not state "Members only or invited Guests".

I as Commander of Post 4352 apologize for this oversight on our part, I too, saw the recent Ad's on this event and I did not notice it didn't state members only and invited guests. I spoke with our Post Quartermaster Gene Topping, the Kitchen and Bar Staff and informed them all that any VFW Post Home Advertisements for events that include anything to do with Alcohol, Beer, or Wine must include the "Members Only & Invited Guest" on the Advertisement. As an option I informed them that it might be better not to include alcohol, beer, or wine in any advertisement from Post 4352. Quartermaster Topping is going to be 88 years old in a couple months and is going to retire from Post Home duties, Post 4352 will install a younger veteran to oversee business operations at the Post Home in May.

In closing, we again, apologize for this oversight and understand the rules on advertising alcohol, beer, or wine on our Alaska Club License.

I want to take this opportunity to respond to the Notice of Violation, AB15-0152. As stated in the Notice, on 02/13/15 former Brown Jug employee Callai Ankrum did make a sale of alcoholic beverages to an underage person in violation of AS 04.16.052.

Ms. Ankrum's conduct in this matter does not meet the professional standard of care we require our employees to exercise at Brown Jug. Accordingly, her employment was immediately terminated, (termination form attached). Notice regarding the circumstances of her termination was posted on our internal website. All employees see this notice each time they clock in and out. We have made it very clear to all employees that the sale of alcohol to a minor will result in criminal prosecution, and immediate termination of employment. In addition, we will communicate via our internal weekly communication document that all employee's must carry a copy of their TAP's cards on their persons during their shifts.

At Brown Jug, we make every effort to prevent the sale of alcohol to minors. All store employees are required to attend a 'TAPS' alcohol server class before working in a store and they are required by company policy to be in possession of the server card while at work.

We also require each associate to review and sign a copy of our "Social Responsibility Policy", this policy reinforces our company's requirement that all Anchorage customers are asked for identification prior to making a purchase. Included in this policy is the acceptable forms of identification required. This policy is reviewed and signoff's completed on an annual basis by each employee.


Since July of 1998, we have seized over 2425 ID cards from minors attempting to make a purchase at a Brown Jug location. Additionally since 2002, we have performed over 6300 in-house policy compliance tests on our employees to ensure that they are requesting ID from customers as required by company policy. Our current mystery shop program will see every Brown Jug location shopped a minimum of once per quarter. Employees that fail to request ID from an external mystery shopper as required by company policy will be immediately performance managed which may result in termination.

Each day when an employee reports for work, they sign a statement advising that they understand the policy regarding ID checks, and that they will follow the policy. Each time a transaction occurs on one of our registers, a pop up appears, reminding the employee that "Age Verification Is Required", displaying the "on or before" date of birth to legally make a sale. Additionally, any employee that successfully passes an ABC compliance test is eligible for a \$250 bonus.


Euvenah Pinnow is a hardworking, dependable and conscientious employee, I don't want to lose her. I may reassign her to other duties as I gear up for summer, as I determine her level of ability to perform in a sale position.

While Ms. Pinnow earned 100% on the TAP test, I have not been fully satisfied with the TAP course because of its shortage of relevant training for package liquor store retailing. Therefore I train each employee in the particular difficulties of the liquor retail environment. I also stress the penalties (criminal, civil and administrative) they and I face.

I have a community store, 85% of my customers are regular local customers. I have tried to maintain that community feel and have my employee's card only those customers they don't know. Part of the job is to learn to know your customers. I now feel compelled to reevaluate that position. As of I now I require my employees to card all customers buying alcoholic beverages and entry of DOB into the Point Of Sales system is required to complete the transaction.


I some how have lost my last TAM card? I did however attend a class the next day with Daniel with the Alaska Hospitality Alliance and have a new card.
