This is request by the licensee, Blue Loon, for a board review of the denial by the director of certain privileges relating to the issuance of a Restaurant Designation Permit per 3 AAC 304.715.

Date RDP Application reviewed: June 9, 2015 by Robert Beasley, former Enforcement Supervisor

RDP privileges granted: Approval of items #1 (Bona fide restaurant per 3 AAC 304.305 and 304.715-794) and #4 (Persons 16-20 may be employed) only and with restrictions: Employment of persons 18-20 only; persons 16-20 must be accompanied by parent/guardian per AS 04.16.049*

*Staff mistakenly sent RDP with full (1-4) privileges to Licensee on June 10, 2015; error identified and corrected RDP sent August 27, 2015

Review of RDP Eligibility: Current Enforcement Supervisor James Hoelscher visited Blue Loon on April 5, 2016 accompanied by Investigators Finney and Whiteman to review premises related to RDP application

New Recommendation on RDP: Portion of premises (dining area #3195) be granted #1 and #4 but with restriction to employees 18-20 years and portion of premises (theater area #4834) not appropriate for any access by person under 21 and not bona fide restaurant (See Hoelscher's Memo)


Recommendation: Support of Board for RDP application determination by its Enforcement Supervisor and enforcement team

Review of Blue Loon #3195/#4834 premises related to eligibility of a Restaurant Designation Permit per 3 AAC 304.715.

Only for identifying each license in this memo, #3195 is referred to as the restaurant/bar side and #4834 is referred to as the Theater/Bar.

Date RDP Eligibility review: April 5th, 2016 by James Hoelscher, Enforcement Supervisor

Information: On 4-5-2016 at approximately 1630 hours, Investigators Richard Finney, Kendrick Whiteman and I arrived at Blue Loon #3195/Duplicate #4834. The building appeared to be a large Quonset hut style with the main entrance on the north side of the building.

Upon entry I observed License #3195 was clearly separated by a wall from the Duplicate License #4834 with one common entrance located at #3195. The restrooms were also located in #3195.

Access to #4834 is gained through #3195 by way of a door on the lower level, as well a door on the balcony.

License #3195 included a bar, dining area, kitchen and balcony.

License #4834 included a bar, theater seats, some dining tables and a balcony.



Recommendation:

My recommendation is that Blue Loon #3195(Restaurant/Bar side) be approved for a Restaurant Designation Permit with approval of items 1 and 4, with the following restriction(s):

Item #4 –

- Employment of persons 18-20 restricted to kitchen.

Items 2 and 3 are denied, premises is not suitable environment for minors for the following reasons:

- Bar atmosphere (i.e. advertisements, lighting, bar, layout)
- No separation of bar and dining area.
- It is likely persons under the age of 21 will enter and remain on the premises for purposes other than dining. 3 AAC 304.725(3)
- Live entertainment, the bar and movies are the primary advertised activities.
- Numerous calls for service for AST response within the past year including complaints of assault, drugs and theft. Not conducive to atmosphere for minors.

My recommendation is that Blue Loon #4834(Theater/Bar side) be denied for a Restaurant Designation Permit for the following reasons:

- It is not a Bona-fide Restaurant; the principal activity is not consumption of food. 3 AAC 304.305(1)
- The layout is in such a way that would not allow for adequate supervision of minors on premises. 3 AAC 304.725(2)

Waka Flocka Flame: I never in my life wanted to rap. Let me quote that sh*t now.—Waka Flocka Flame on his 2009 debut mixtape, Salute Me or Shoot Me, Vol. 1 Waka Flocka Flame didn't want to be a rapper when he grew up. He didn't want to write hit songs, perform in front of thousands of people at packed clubs or hear his songs played on radio stations across the country. But more than a year after bursting onto the scene with his debut single, "O Let's Do It," the Atlanta rapper has managed to make more of an impact on the music industry than most rappers who have spent their entire lives trying to do it. And thanks to an influential cosign from fellow ATLien Gucci Mane, and a string of chart-topping singles, including the remix to "O Let's Do It," featuring Rick Ross and Diddy, and his latest hit, "Hard In Da Paint," it doesn't look like Waka Flocka is ready to quit rapping anytime soon. Adam,

When you look at 3 AAC 304.725, you can see the problems with RDP designation as it relates to your movie balcony. The board would have to determine that the balcony is a bona fide restaurant, there is supervision adequate to ensure someone under 21 will not obtain alcohol and that it is unlikely persons under the age of 21 would enter and remain for purposes other than dining. They are entering and remaining to see a movie, not dining. An additional issue is whether a movie qualifies as entertainment under the presumption sections in 3 AAC 304.725(c).

I do not remember discussing at all the concept of switching licensed premises back and forth between an alcohol free balcony and the main auditorium at your pleasure. That is something I would really have to look at since all of Title 4 is centered around a fixed premises concept.

The best thing for you to do at this point would be to put the entire proposal in writing with all of the details and let me and Bob review it. We will determine whether the proposed activities are permitted by statute and regulation and I will give you a written decision. If the decision is adverse, you can appeal my decision to the board.

Cynthia,

I do remember a conversation with Sarah and I thought also with Bob but maybe it was all through Sarah. I thought it was discussed and understood that the minors would be entering through the licensed premise. It was my understanding that access to a licensed premise would be allowed if I had a RDP. In other words minors go into licensed restaurants for the purpose of

dining. I told them that the balcony could be made an area for minors with separate entrance if needed but that this entrance would be from within the dining area. They also told me that under certain circumstances, a children's movie for example, I could allow minors into main viewing auditorium and allow alcohol only in the balcony. In other words I could flip/flop the drinking and non-drinking area if so desired.

They basically were allowing me to act like a RDP restaurant with the added restriction that in my movie theater I wouldn't allow unaccompanied minors to be in the same area as drinking patrons.

This is exactly what I presented to the borough assembly.

I am happy to pursue this further as needed either by submitting my proposal in writing or talking to the borough.

Under statute it is allowable to have minors on a licensed premise with an RDP, correct? Are there other restrictions?

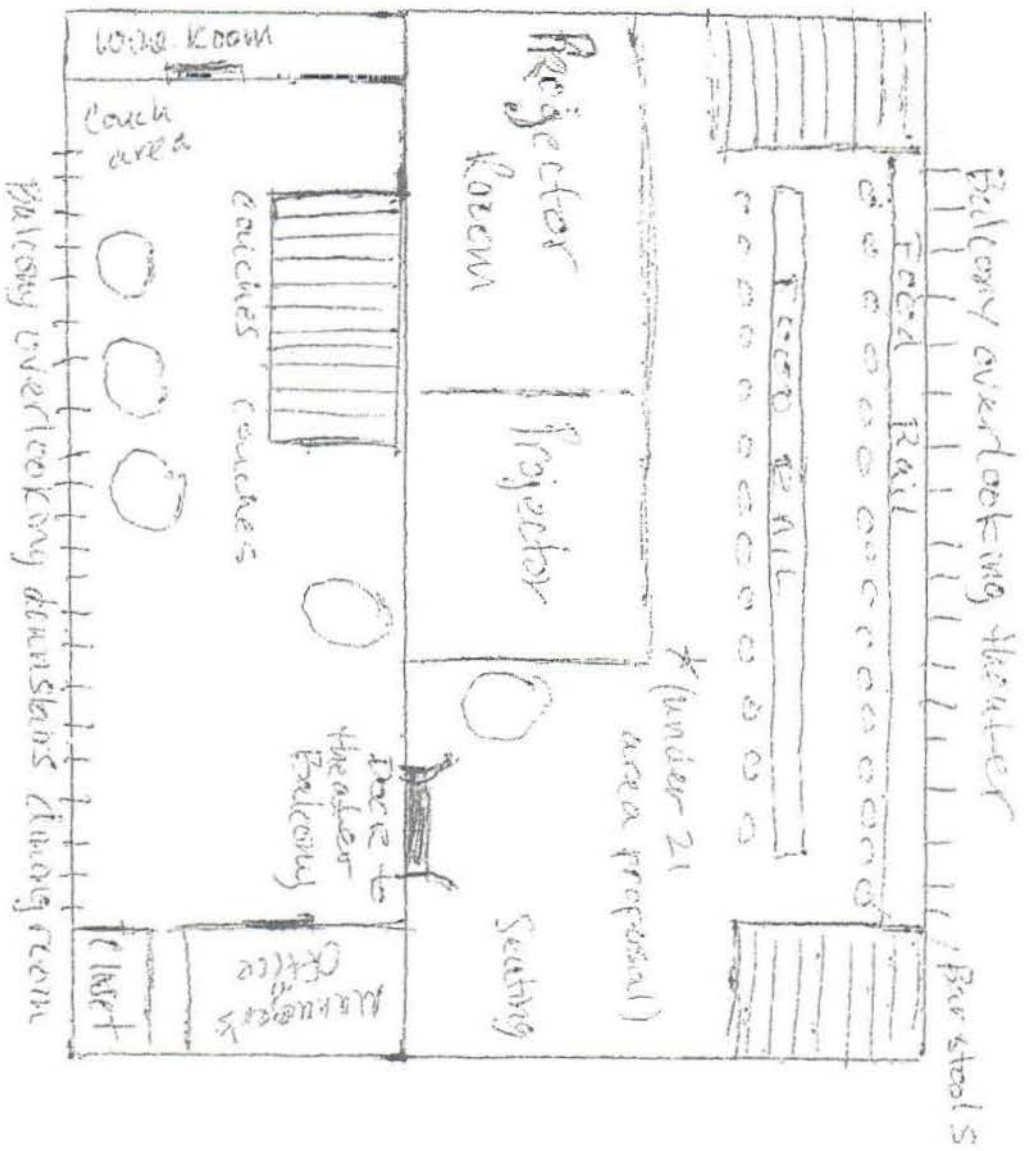
