Cynthia,

I received the Notification of Violation, and I am responding per your request. We were expecting this notification as we had been investigated by J. Bankowski. After reviewing what happened internally, we did in fact have a violation as the event that our representative hosted did not have a license.

This is an event that we have participated in for a number of years when it was part of "Tailgate Alaska" and later when it became "Passport to Powder" with Alaska Snowboard Guides. In the past, the same promoter Dave Geist would work with Fat Mermaid and obtain a banquet permit for the event.

Our sales representative, spoke to Dave and to Karen from Fat Mermaid and was under the impression that the permit had been applied for, just like it always had been in the past. For reasons our rep does not know, the permit in 2016 was never applied for; therefore, we did participate in a violation.

We have a policy on donations and require that the catering permit be on our donation order form. However, when we are sending it to a license account, we don't require the permit number. The sales rep wrote the order to Fat Mermaid and then took the product to the event and has been reprimanded for that.

In the future, we are requiring our credit manager to investigate all donations and have written correspondence from the charity or event coordinator and a banquet permit. We will also make a phone call to the licensee to insure that they have completed the proper paperwork.

We are well aware of the laws on this subject, and we were surprised by how this took place. We feel that we have corrective action in place to make sure it does not happen again. We had no intent to sell or promote our products in an un-licensed environment

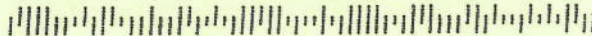

It is our responsibility to carefully consider our actions and judge each and every patron as to whether or not he/she is intoxicated. We must make this judgement whether or not the patron is driving. Excuses such as "I'm taking a cab" (true or not) do not relieve us of our legal or moral responsibilities.

It is the policy of this establishment to make every effort to curb service to visibly intoxicated persons. This includes regular patrons, employees, and board of directors.

If you feel someone is intoxicated and wish to stop the sale of alcoholic beverages, notify the Manager on duty. Offer water or coffee, you will be supported in this decision, as I will never overrule decisions made by the staff in this area.

Bartenders and floor service personnel must be aware of the intoxicated customers, they must also communicate with each other regarding possible problems or when a patron has been refused service.

It will continue to be the policy that patrons are here at our hospitality. This means that patrons will respect the establishment and patrons will respect all other people, including staff. We shall not lose business due to loud, unpleasant, obnoxious persons! Patrons will be cut off or asked to leave if they violate these policies.

We will not encourage excessive drinking. When appropriate, we encourage the service of a "spacer", such as coffee, soft drink, another non-alcoholic beverage, or food.

If someone appears visibly intoxicated, try to arrange safe transportation home through his or her friends (**friends don't let friends drive intoxicated**), or call a taxi. We will pay for the cab!!!

Remember, we must recognize that taking good care of our customers and protecting them against the effects of alcohol abuse constitutes good business and is our legal and moral obligation!!
