Requested Action: License renewal; time extension for license transfer; refund of late fee assessed under AS 04.11.270(b)(3)

Statutory Authority: AS 04.06.090(b): "The board shall review all applications for licenses made under this title and may order the director to issue, renew, revoke, transfer, or suspend licenses and permits authorized under this title."

AS 04.11.030(b) and (c): "(b) If an application for the transfer of ownership of a license from a deceased licensee is not made within 90 days of the death of the licensee or within an additional 90 days if an application for transfer of ownership made by the executor is denied, or no petition is made to the board for an extension of time under (c) of this section within the time, the license is forfeited.

(c) The board may extend the time limits in (b) of this section on petition of the executor or administrator."

There is no statutory authority for the board to refund a late fee. The board may conclude that the late fee was assessed in error, which would then require a refund.

Staff Rec.: Approve the renewal; approve final six month time extension to October 3, 2018; deny the request for late fee refund

Background: Ms. Caddell, the personal representative for both deceased owners of this package store license in Anchorage, requested a time extension under AS 04.11.030(c) in April of 2016, which was granted, until December 2016, by the board. No transfer application was submitted. The license appears to have been operated for a few months at the beginning of 2017. When this situation came to light in October of 2017, I informed Ms. Caddell that the license was forfeited in accordance with AS 04.11.030(b).

Ms. Caddell appealed the decision to the board at the November 13, 2017, meeting, and the board resurrected the license and extended the deadline to file a transfer to April 30, 2018.

While Ms. Caddell did not get a formal notice of board action until late February, 2018, she was notified by email on December 8, 2017, that her license was reinstated. She never notified our office that she intended to start operating her license again, so a new copy of her 2016/2017 license was not sent to her.

Her renewal application was received on January 3, 2018, and deemed complete on March 1, 2018. A temporary license was issued on March 5, 2018. As noted in her renewal application, she is transitioning to a seasonal license with the intention of operating from January to June.

Ms. Caddell is requesting an extension to December 31, 2018. I disagree that she was unable to begin marketing her license until a physical copy of the license was in her possession, so I disagree that AMCO is responsible for causing her delays. That said, I suggest the board renew the license and approve an additional six month extension, to October 3, 2018, for a transfer application to be submitted. Should the board agree and set that as her deadline, Ms. Caddell will have been given approximately 33 months from the time the second of the two licensees passed away, and approximately 54 months from the time the first licensee passed away, to file a transfer of the license. I recommend that the board indicate to Ms. Caddell that no additional time extensions will be considered.

The renewal application for this license was first received on January 3, 2018. An incomplete letter was emailed to the email address provided by the licensee on January 25, informing the licensee that corrections were needed to the application and that if the application was still incomplete after seven days, the \$500 late fee would be assessed. The email address is the same one with which Ms. Caddell and this office have communicated previously. Email is an accepted method of business communication.

Corrections to the renewal application for this license were received on February 28.

Dear Ms. McConnell,

When I last appeared before the board on behalf of AWG, INC and the Estate of Ernae Caddell/Thomas Faughnan, I was granted six months to market license #5120 for sale. While working diligently with Director McConnell and Sarah Oates to get the license renewed following the decision of reinstatement by the board this license was held up and severely impacted by the license renewal process itself. On December 8, 2017 I was told I would be getting a letter of reinstatement which I did not receive until the license was physically issued on March 5th. Per the advice of my real estate broker and others I did not list this license for sale until it had been fully issued and was transferable. Please see attached correspondence with Director McConnell and Sarah Oates regarding the license reinstatement process and my efforts to renew the license.

While I appreciated being granted the six months to attempt to sell the license in November, due to the time lost during the processing and reissuance of the license AWG, INC would require and does request additional time to attempt to transfer this license through 12/31/2018. Being that until I was in true possession of an active license I was unable to fully start the process of selling the license I believe that allowing additional time to sell the license would be allowed in this circumstance. As described during the November board meeting all proceeds of any sale would be used to first cure any and all debts held against the license from sale proceeds.

Moving forward during the remainder of 2018 an additional intent is to untangle the license from the estate to assist the sale of the license to satisfy the creditors. Following this board's approval and extension of term to sell the license I will be submitting an application to transfer the stock of AWG, Inc out of the estate and into the name of a family member until the license is sold.

Thank you for your time and attention to this matter, I respectfully request that I be given an extension of time thru 12/31/2018 to sell the license and satisfy the creditors.

Good afternoon Sherri,

I have attached the email that was sent to your email address on January 25, 2018. Also attached is correspondence regarding what is needed to complete your application, along with the application that is needing correction. I am sorry to say that I am not able to waive the late fee that was issued.

I see that Ernae Caddell has been reported to the Alaska Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing (CBPL) as the 100% owner of AWG, Inc. and that Thomas Faughnan was removed after a Notice of Change of Officials filed with CBPL on January 2, 2018. However, AS 04.11.040 indicates that a liquor license

issued under this title cannot be transferred to another person except with the written consent of the board. Because a transfer was not approved, this license cannot be renewed unless ownership is reverted to as it was before the Change of Officials. These officials will also need to be accurately listed on Page 3, Section 4 of the application.

Please contact CBPL regarding what is needed to revert ownership. If a second Change of Officials must be filed, please send us a copy that has been stamped as received by CBPL, as their website can take up to fifteen business days to update.

Please note that the due date to have applications complete is midnight on February 28, 2018. Applications that are still incomplete at this time will expire per AS 04.11.540.
