Requested Action: Reconsideration of denial of third and fourth waivers of operation and denial of license renewal application

Statutory and Regulatory Authority: AS 44.62.540 (in the Administrative Procedures Act) allows an agency to reconsider a case on its own motion.

AS 04.06.090(b): "The board shall review all applications for licenses made under this title and may order the director to issue, renew, revoke, transfer, or suspend licenses and permits authorized under this title."

3 AAC 304.170(b): "A licensee may apply to the board, requesting that the board waive the operating requirement of AS 04.11.330(a)(3)... Under AS 04.11.330(a)(3), the board will determine whether, through no fault of the licensee or because the premises are under construction, the licensed premises could not be operated for the required time during the preceding calendar year."

3 AAC 304.170(e): The board will, in its discretion, deny a third or subsequent consecutive application for waiver unless the licensee clearly shows that the licensed premises were not operated because the premises were condemned or substantially destroyed by any cause. If the premises identified on an applicant's license are not leased or owned by the licensee, the third or subsequent application will, in the board's discretion, be denied. Additionally, a third or subsequent consecutive application for waiver that does not identify a licensed premises location will, in the board's discretion, be denied."

3 AAC 304.170(g): "If an application for waiver is denied, an application for license renewal for the succeeding license period will be denied by the board under AS 04.11.330(a)(3)."

Staff Rec.: Do not reconsider denial of waivers or renewal

Background: On April 3, 2018, the board denied a third and fourth waiver of operations request by this beverage dispensary license in Wasilla, and as required by 3 AAC 304.170(g), also denied the renewal of this license. The licensee requested in informal conference with me under AS 04.11.510(b)(1), which was held on May 2, 2018. At the informal conference, the licensee explained that they did have plans for transferring the license to a new location in Wasilla, but they had not provided information regarding those plans to the board. I informed the licensee that even with said plans, they still didn't meet the regulatory requirements for being granted a third and fourth waiver, but that I would give them the opportunity to provide additional information to the board.

Additional information was provided, indicating that the licensee had applied for a transfer of this license in 2016. The transfer application was approved with delegation by the board in October of 2016, but the licensee never finalized the transfer by requesting an inspection at their new location. When the licensee applied for renewal at the end of 2017, they did not mention the transfer. They were required to file for waivers, and on their waiver application, they stated "At this time we have no set plans for it [the license] and their [sic] is a possibility we may sell it."

Despite having an approved (though unfinalized) transfer, the license was not operated in 2016 or 2017. Regulations at 3 AAC 304.170 indicate that waivers of operations are intended for situations such as construction, condemnation, or destruction of the premises, or other situations that may be out of the licensee's control. There is no information provided that this licensee experienced any of those circumstances.

Dear Director McConnell:

First, I would like to thank you for taking the time to meet with Mr. John Emmi and I on May 2, 2018 regarding above referenced dispensary liquor license, #4733. We appreciated you taking the time to discuss this matter with us. You indicated that we could present our case to the full AMCO Board at the June 12, 2018 scheduled board meeting. You indicated that we would need to submit to you by today information and the formal request to be on the June 12, 2018 agenda. Please accept this letter as that submission and request.

On April 16, 2018, Notice was sent to Triplets, Inc. regarding the AMCO's actions of April 3, 2018 to:

- (1) deny the application for a third (3rd) and fourth (4th) waiver of operations;
- and
- (2) deny the application to renew the above referenced beverage dispensary license. [Exhibit 1]

Triplets, Inc. requested an informal conference, while preserving its right to appeal, [Exhibit 2] and we were then provided this opportunity to be heard by the board, while again preserving its right to an appeal..

The April 16, 2018 notice indicated that the Board denied the waivers citing 3 AAC 304.170(e) which states: "The board will, in its discretion, deny a third or subsequent consecutive application for waiver unless the licensee clearly shows that the license premises were not operating because the premises were condemned or subsequently destroyed by any cause."

Because it denied the third (3rd) and fourth (4th) waiver request, then under 3 AAC 304.170(g), the board denied the renewal application because absent a waiver, then Triplets, Inc. was not able to meet the minimum use requirements of AS 04.11.330(a)(3).

Since the informal conference, I was able to interview Sandra Joynes, Triplets, Inc.'s manager/bookkeeper individual responsible for navigate the various licenses for Triplets, Inc. She left their employment about a year ago, and is currently out of the country, but made herself available by phone. She has a distinct memory that she was in communication with Sandra, then Maxine at the ABC Board office who walked her through this license transfer process. Sandra recalls being concerned about not wanting the seek a third waiver, and she recalls filing out an application for transfer from Triplets, Inc. to Twins, Inc., for this license to be placed at the location on known as the Grill located at 2900 E. Parks Highway, Wasilla, Alaska 99654. Sandra was truly the company's right hand man, and since she moved, the files from their office came to me in less than perfect order. While I have not been able to locate a copy of the transfer application, I do plan on visiting the AMCO offices to review all files prior to the June 12, 2018 meeting.

That said, I have been able to locate a copy of the advertizing that was put into place referencing that transfer. [See Exhibit 3]. Both she and Ernie Emmi, one of the owner/shareholders, now recall he needing to be finger printed as part of this transfer application process. He recalls getting finger printed and that it was submitted.

As indicated earlier, they do not have any copies presently of the associated documents. They do have a print out of the Quick Books registry reflecting the cost of the finger printing, and the filing fee, which Mr. Emmi believes based n timing is the filing fee for the transfer application. [Exhibit 4]. He has tracking down the copy of these checks directly from the bank, and is tracking to determine if check 14918 was in fact the transfer fee paid to the ABC Board, as it was known at the time. [Exhibit 5]. It was clearly deposited by the ABC Board. [See back side of check]. While we currently do not have all the information, and will be attempting to secure it between now and the Board meeting, it was Sandra Joynes best memory that the above mentioned license was to have already been transferred and placed at the Grill.

Ernie Emmi clearly did not recall that when he went to apply for the third (3rd) and fourth (4th) waiver for license #4733. That said, their plan is to have a license located at the property at the refurbished swimming "pool" area of the hotel that has been converted into a local pool hall. If there has been some technical glitch in the prior transfer process, they stand ready and willing to have it immediately located in the "Pool Hall".

This license cost the owners over a quarter million dollars. They are respectfully asking this Board not to have that significant financial investment evaporate into nothing, and allow that immediate placement to prevent a loss of the license.

This board has the discretion to under good circumstances, to approve a 3rd and 4th waiver. While the regulations provide significant guidance for the Board, it is without question that the Board "may, in its discretion" grant these waivers if warranted and impose those conditions its deems appropraite. Triplets, Inc. respectfully suggests that the conditions the Board should impose would be for the immediate placement, within a very tight and specific time frame, of the license into the newly constructed "Pool Hall"¹.

Triplets, Inc and its owners, John and Ernie Emmi thank the Board for its consideration.

Dear Triplets, Inc.:

At the April 3, 2018, meeting of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board in Nome, Alaska, the board voted to deny your applications for third and fourth waivers of operation and license renewal for a beverage dispensary license. The Board denied the applications in accordance with 3 AAC 304.170(e): *"The board will, in its discretion, deny a third or subsequent consecutive application for waiver unless the licensee clearly shows that the licensed premises were not operated because the premises were condemned or substantially destroyed by any cause."*; 3 AAC 304.170(g): *"If an application for waiver is denied, an application for license renewal for the succeeding license period will be denied by the board under AS 04.11.330(a)(3); and AS 04.11.330(a)(3): "An application requesting renewal of a license shall be denied if the applicant has not operated the licensed premises for at least 30 eight-hour days during each of the two preceding calendar years, unless the board determines that the licensed premises are under construction or cannot be operated through no fault of the applicant."*

Because your applications have been denied, you have the right to an informal conference with the director or the Board under AS 04.11.510(b)(1), which you may initiate in writing within 15 days of receiving this letter.

The Alaska Administrative Procedure Act, AS 44.62.330 et seq., provides you with a means to appeal the Board's decision. Specifically, AS 44.62.390 allows you to initiate a hearing to determine whether a right, authority, license, or privilege should be granted, issued, or renewed. If you request an administrative hearing, the Office of Administrative Hearings will assign an administrative law judge to hear the matter. You may hire an attorney to represent you in such a hearing, but are not required to.

Please consider this letter as a Statement of Issues as required by AS 44.62.370. If you intend to request a hearing, you must notify AMCO in writing within 15 days of receiving this notice, although the 15 day period is held in abeyance between the date of request of an informal conference (should one be requested) and the holding of the informal conference. A Notice of Defense form is enclosed for this purpose; however, you may submit any written notice that meets the requirements of AS 44.62.390.
