Statutory AS 04.06.090(b): "The board shall review all applications for licenses made under

this title and may order the director to issue, renew, revoke, transfer, or suspend

licenses and permits authorized under this title."

**Staff Rec.:** Approve the renewal

**Background:** This recreational site license appears to meet the statutory requirements of the

license type:

Sec. 04.11.210. Recreational site license.

- (a) The holder of a recreational site license may sell beer and wine at a recreational site during and one hour before and after a recreational event that is not a school event, for consumption on designated areas at the site.
- (b) The biennial fee for a recreational site license is \$800.
- (c) In this section, "recreational site" includes a location where baseball games, car races, hockey games, dog sled racing events, or curling matches are regularly held during a season.

The board should clarify with the licensee that events where alcohol is served under this license must be limited to competitive sporting events in order to comply with AS 04.11.210. This is consistent with direction the board provided to License #4895, AK Tuesday Night Fights, where the licensed premises (the Curtis Menard Sports Complex in Wasilla) can be used for non-sporting events such as concerts. Non-qualifying events such as concerts must be done through the use of permits.

In addition, it appears the licensee is beginning service 1.5 hours before the recreational event, which is earlier than permitted. The board should direct the licensee to comply with the hours of service stated in the statute.

Dear Sirs,

Per the Alcohol & Marijuana Control Office request, SMG of Alaska, Inc. offers this;

The "Anchor" tenant of the Carlson Center is the University of Alaska, Fairbanks Seawolf men's hockey league. Their season typically runs the first week of October through February and may continue through March depending on the team's reaching the playoffs, post season play. Normally, games are played on Friday and Saturday nights during the season, but may also be played Sunday or during the week, depending on visiting team's availability. Normal hours of operation for these hockey games is one and one-half hours prior to the games. Alcohol points of sale typically close at the beginning of the third period of play, approximately one hour prior to the end of the event.

Additional events are held throughout the year include sporting events such as football, pickleball, community fundraiser hockey games, concerts featuring various artists, trade shows of all kind and catered meal services. Times vary for these events but typically follow the same pattern of closing approximately one hour before the end of the event with the exception of concerts when the alcohol points of sale normally close when the "headliner" takes the stage, one and one-half to two hours prior to the end of the event.
