On 5-18-17 it was discovered The Wood Center Pub has been advertising on its Facebook page for discounted drink specials on various days in 2017. The specific dates and advertisements discovered are as follows: Posted 1-31-17 "Superbowl Sunday LI" with "Beer Specials" and "\$5 Mimosas"; Posted 2-1-17 "Hump Day Specials" including drink specials for \$3 pints from Denali Brewing, Shock Top, and Kenai River Brewing beers; Posted 4-18-17 "UAF Grad Bash" held on 4-29-17 with "Beer and Wine Specials"; Posted 03-01-17 "Hump Day Specials" including drink specials for Alaska Brewing Company, Kenai River Brewing, Woodchuck Cider, and Silver Gulch beers; Posted 3-8-17 "Hump Day Comedy Specials" including drink specials from New Belgium Brewing, Alaskan Brewing Company, and more; Posted 4-5-17 "Hump Day Specials" including Ras Wheat, Frank Kassik Beaver Tail Blonde, Double Shovel Cider, and Irish Death Can; Posted 5-4-17 "#maythefourth" drink specials; Posted 5-5-17 last day open for the semester with discounted cans of Alaskan and Mike's Harder drinks. All advertisements and discounts are a violation of Title IV.

Your attention is directed to AS 04.16.015 Pricing and Marketing of Alcoholic Beverages.

You are directed to respond in writing to this Notice of Violation within 10 days of receipt to explain what action you have taken to prevent a re-occurrence of this violation. FAILURE TO RESPOND TO THIS NOTICE OF VIOLATION WITHIN 10 DAYS WILL RESULT IN YOUR APPEARANCE, EITHER IN PERSON OR TELEPHONICALLY, BEFORE THE ABC BOARD AT THEIR NEXT REGULARLY SCHEDULED BOARD MEETING.

3 AAC 304.525 (B) provides that upon receipt of a Notice of Violation, a licensee may request to appear before the Director and be heard regarding the Notice of Violation. 



On June 1, 2017 the Wood Center Pub and the University of Alaska Fairbanks received a Notice of Violation from the Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office. The Notice alleges violations of AS 04.16.015 due to eight different Facebook posts offering drink specials for less than a calendar week.

AS 04.16.015(b) prohibits certain off-premises advertising defined in AS 04.16.015(a). Specifically, AS 04.16.015(a)(3) prohibits the sale, offer to sell, or delivery of alcoholic beverages at a price less than the regular price for the beverage during the same calendar week. "Calendar week" is not defined in AS 04.21.080 or associated regulations.

I consulted with Wood Center Pub staff in responding to this Notice. Staff confirmed that all of the specials referenced in the Notice ran for seven consecutive days. The understanding that specials could be offered for seven consecutive calendar days was based on instructions employees received at their TAMs classes.

The alleged violations appear to be based on the Wood Center Pub's incorrect interpretation of the meaning of "calendar week." The term "calendar week" is not defined in state statute or regulations and Wood Center Pub staff understood calendar week to mean any seven consecutive days. Our additional research suggests that "calendar week" actually means Sunday through Saturday, and I would appreciate confirmation that this definition is consistent with AMCO's interpretation.

I have taken this opportunity to educate all Wood Center Pub managers and staff about the restrictions on pricing and marketing alcoholic beverages pursuant to AS 04.16.015. I met with all Wood Center Pub staff and clarified the meaning of calendar week as I now understand it. As a result of this additional training, the Wood Center Pub will no longer offer specials starting mid-week. Moreover, all advertisements for drink specials will clearly state that they run for at least a calendar week.
