Hi Joe,

Thanks for responding so quickly. Do you know if this is going to impact our renewal? I had written this lengthy letter explaining our operation, that we are a very simple lodge only serving to our guests, all of which you obviously already know. And, I of course explained my oversight in not notifying the board about the change in officers when I was reinstated.

I know "ignorance of the law" is no excuse, but I didn't know of the statute and really with the craziness of everything, it never occurred to me to notify AMCO of my reinstatement as on officer. As I had told AMCO in spring of 2017 when we were going through our renewal and they had a question about my background check, I was stepping down as an officer for the time being anyway because I had just been diagnosed with breast cancer, which I spent most of 2017 battling, but I am now cancer free. I was reinstated as an officer so I could act on behalf of the corporation in other matters, and I didn't really think again about AMCO or notifying them. I apologize.

The issue with the background check has been resolved as well, but I don't know if that is something I need to discuss further with anyone.

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
