This is a notice to you as licensee that an alleged violation has occurred. If the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board decides to act against your license, under the provisions of AS 44.62.330 - AS 44.62.630 (Administrative Procedures Act) you will receive an Accusation and Notice of your right to an Administrative Hearing.

Note: This is not an accusation or a criminal complaint.

On 10-11-2017 at approximately 1615 hrs. I conducted a routine inspection at the International Hotel & Bar, a beverage dispensary licensee, license number 556 at 122 N. Turner Street, Fairbanks, AK. When walking into the premises I saw a large sign posted on top of the building naming the business as "the BIG-I PUB & LOUNGE." I checked the liquor license posted in the premises to see what the Doing-Business-As (DBA) for the premises was as indicated on the liquor license. The liquor license listed the DBA as the "International Hotel & Bar."

In addition to the large sign mounted on the front of the building with the name "the BIG-I PUB & LOUNGE" I saw a banner displayed along the Illinois Avenue facing fence of the property with the business name "the BIG-I PUB & LOUNGE" printed on it. On the back side of the building was a banner with "the BIG-I PUB & LOUNGE" printed on it along with "International Hotel" printed in smaller font below "the BIG-I." I visited the licensee's Facebook page and saw the DBA on the Facebook page is "the BIG-I PUB & LOUNGE." I have also heard local radio station ads for events at the premises and it announces the premises as "the BIG-I PUB & LOUNGE." A check of licensing files revealed the listed DBA is the "International Hotel & Bar."

This is a violation of 3 AAC 304.185:

3 AAC 304.185. LICENSED PREMISES:

(a) A license is issued for a specific place which is the licensed premises and which must be clearly designated in a line drawing accompanying an application. The licensed premises must be one area, but may include separate rooms if the rooms are adjacent to one another or if they are rooms described in AS 04.11.090(d). The address of the licensed premises and the business name under which the licensee is doing business at that address must be indicated on the license application.

You are directed to respond in writing to this Notice of Violation within 10 days of receipt to explain what action you have taken to prevent a re-occurrence of this violation. FAILURE TO RESPOND TO THIS NOTICE OF VIOLATION WITHIN 10 DAYS WILL RESULT IN YOUR APPEARANCE, EITHER IN PERSON OR TELEPHONICALLY, BEFORE THE ABC BOARD AT THEIR NEXT REGULARLY SCHEDULED BOARD MEETING.

Dear Alcohol & Marijuana Control Office, Attn: Enforcement:

On Monday November 13th I signed a certified letter receipt# 7016 0910-0000 9694 4040, from our mail carrier. Upon immediately opening and reading my first ever (Notice of Violation) per 3 AAC 304.525, listed under 3 AAC 304.185: Licensed Premises (a). I was still unclear as to what might have arisen that I might have inadvertently violated this specific regulation. First let me apologize for any lack of understanding on my part of this regulation. Currently my DBA: International Hotel & Bar is listed and accompany all city, state, Federal & permit applications up to and including catering permits. I believe sections (a) & (b) I am following, however section (c) indicates AMCO provides form# AB-13 for "Business Name Change". My request and hopes are to keep my current DBA listed as the International Hotel & Bar. This premise and its landmark has a long history here in Fairbanks as one of the oldest Beverage Dispensary Licenses issued by our State of Alaska Alcohol Control office back in 1956, but the International Hotel dates back to 1920. I would like to request an appearance before the director and be heard regarding the notice of this violation.

My averseness to this request to a change my DBA from International Hotel & Bar to The Big-I Pub & Lounge is simply reasoning to the following explanation listed in the next paragraph.

In essence, a DBA is the business version of "a/k/a" (also known as). For example, International Business Machines Corporation is known as IBM. As far back as 1971 over 45 years ago the aka: Big-I took the form of a nick name for the International Hotel & Bar because of the letter "I" in International was bigger than all the other letters. I did not initiate this aka only followed suite as to not rock the boat on a long-established tradition of identity and the following business characteristics.

under a rumored name for a variety of reasons:

- A Hotel no longer exists on the 2nd floor,

- Achieve marketing, branding, expansion, or other goals
- Use the same aka: name that's easier to remember or pronounce
- Accentuate different detachments (Pub-vs-Bar) or products
- Avoid confusing public, police & Fire from DBA known by different names
- Maintain flexibility as trends and customer preferences change

In closing please let me state by no means had I known that AMCO viewed the use of The Big-I as a violation of my Licensed premises, I have read and seen hundreds of articles, stories, biographies', sport trophy's dating back to early 80's listing our establishment as The Big-I. I had only hoped that on Oct 11th I would have been onsite to meet with the issuing Investigator Mr. Michael Chiesa and asked that he use at his discretion the NOV verses and advisory notice as is stated in 3 AAC 304.525 D2. My on-duty bartender indicated that Mr. Chiesa acknowledge everything was fine and left my premises. I had been alerted by my Insurance carrier days later as I was binding a new Liquor Liability policy 2017-2018 that I was under investigation by AMCO, much to my astonishment I was dismayed that my Insurance carrier knew before me that I was under an investigation. This does not speak well to the relationship I thought I had with AMCO after 11 years, 5 months and 6 days. I also followed up with a call to inquire about his visit and if I could assist in answering any questions. I did not receive a call back. Now I'm between a rock and a hard place I only hope that my insurance carrier has bonded my Liquor Liability! I look forward to your response and openness from here forward. My reputation and respect for this industry and my business is above all relentless.

I am responding to my second NOV Case#: AB18-0586 from investigator Michael Chiesa, per 3 AAC 304.525. According to this notice the investigator feels that we have violated AS 04.16.015 "Pricing and marketing of alcoholic beverages". Please refer to my exhibits (A) that clearly shows my manager starting this drink special eleven (11) days prior to our advertising the May 5th special for Cinco De Mayo on our Facebook page. Our understanding is also clear and consistent with AS 04.16.015 (3). In addition to further substantiate our claim this special is still currently running. After speaking to investigator Chiesa he indicated that presenting these exhibits/photos would help clarify our compliance. Exhibit (B) is added to show our special is still posted on our back porch and Exhibit (C) for the table tents that also exist currently on our tables. I also have spoken to my manager as to clarify AS 04.16.015 in its entirety because the ambiguity lies within AS 04.16.015 sec (3), the wording "Calendar week" as per definition (is a period of seven consecutive days starting on Sunday). I would respectfully request that our AMCO director be notified of this anomaly of understanding amongst all licensees of Alcoholic beverages in our state up to and including package stores, breweries, brew-pub's, beverage dispensaries and so on. I conclude that ambiguity sets up hundreds of business owners for a Notice of Violation. Thank you for this time, if you should have any additional questions or concerns please don't hesitate to contact me at your earliest convenience.

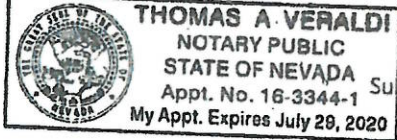

I am responding to my second NOV Case#: AB18-0586 from investigator Michael Chiesa, per 3 AAC 304.525. According to this notice the investigator feels that we have violated AS 04.16.015 "Pricing and marketing of alcoholic beverages". Please refer to my exhibits (A) that clearly shows my manager starting this drink special eleven (11) days prior to our advertising the May 5th special for Cinco De Mayo on our Facebook page. Our understanding is also clear and consistent with AS 04.16.015 (3). In addition to further substantiate our claim this special is still currently running. After speaking to investigator Chiesa he indicated that presenting these exhibits/photos would help clarify our compliance. Exhibit (B) is added to show our special is still posted on our back porch and Exhibit (C) for the table tents that also exist currently on our tables. I also have spoken to my manager as to clarify AS 04.16.015 in its entirety because the ambiguity lies within AS 04.16.015 sec (3), the wording "Calendar week" as per definition (is a period of seven consecutive days starting on Sunday). I would respectfully request that our AMCO director be notified of this anomaly of understanding amongst all licensees of Alcoholic beverages in our state up to and including package stores, breweries, brew-pub's, beverage dispensaries and so on. I conclude that ambiguity sets up hundreds of business owners for a Notice of Violation. On 10-11-2017 at approximately 1615 hrs. I conducted a routine inspection at the International Hotel & Bar, a beverage dispensary licensee, license number 556 at 122 N. Turner Street, Fairbanks, AK. When walking into the premises I saw a large sign posted on top of the building naming the business as "the BIG-I PUB & LOUNGE." I checked the liquor license posted in the premises to see what the Doing-Business-As (DBA) for the premises was as indicated on the liquor license. The liquor license listed the DBA as the "International Hotel & Bar."

In addition to the large sign mounted on the front of the building with the name "the BIG-I PUB & LOUNGE" I saw a banner displayed along the Illinois Avenue facing fence of the property with the business name "the BIG-I PUB & LOUNGE" printed on it. On the back side of the building was a banner with "the BIG-I PUB & LOUNGE" printed on it along with "International Hotel" printed in smaller font below "the BIG-I." I visited the licensee's Facebook page and saw the DBA on the Facebook page is "the BIG-I PUB & LOUNGE." I have also heard local radio station ads for events at the premises and it announces the premises as "the BIG-I PUB & LOUNGE." A check of licensing files revealed the listed DBA is the "International Hotel & Bar."

This is a violation of 3 AAC 304.185:

(a) A license is issued for a specific place which is the licensed premises and which must be clearly designated in a line drawing accompanying an application.
