Requested Action: Reinstatement, renewal, transfer of license

Statutory and Regulatory Authority: AS 04.06.090(b): "The board shall review all applications for licenses made under this title and may order the director to issue, renew, revoke, transfer, or suspend licenses and permits authorized under this title."

AS 04.11.040(a): "A license issued under this title may not be transferred to another person except with the written consent of the board."

AS 04.11.540: "...If a complete application for renewal has not been filed by February 28 or the required fees and the penalty fees have not been paid by that date, the license expires at 12:00 midnight February 28."

3 AAC 304.160(f): "The board will deny a request for reinstatement submitted under (e) of this section if

- (1) the license became available in accordance with 3 AAC 304.100(2) and was issued to a different applicant, unless the limit of licenses under AS 04.11.400 has not been reached; or
- (2) the board finds that the failure to timely file or pay was caused by
 - (A) the licensee's failure to notify the board of a change of the licensee's mailing address;
 - (B) a transfer of ownership of the business for which the license was issued without written approval of the board in violation of AS 04.11.040;
 - (C) a lease of the licensed business to another person in violation of AS 04.11.450(c); or
 - (D) any other action of the licensee whether active or tacit that the board finds constitutes a failure to lawfully operate the business for which the license was issued."

AS 04.11.400(d)(2)(A)(ii) requires that for a Beverage Dispensary – Tourism transfer to be approved, the facility must maintain at least the minimum number of rental rooms required at the time of initial licensure.

Staff Rec.: Evaluate reinstatement request in accordance with 3 AAC 304.160(f) and consider the renewal and transfer

Background: During the 2019/2020 renewal licensing period, it came to AMCO's attention that the licensee had transferred ownership of the license without board approval. The licensee was informed by email on February 6, 2019, that there were some corrections required on the renewal application and that a transfer application was required as well. The licensee did not submit the corrections or the transfer application. An expiration and cessation of operations letter was sent on May 14, 2019.

The licensee has submitted a request for reinstatement, a transfer application to transfer ownership from Leslie Lequire to The Perch Resort at Denali Inc, a complete renewal application, and all required fees.

AS 04.11.400(d)(2)(A)(ii) requires that the facility must maintain at least the minimum number of rental rooms required at original licensure. This license was first issued on May 18, 2009. Staff has determined that the license was compliant with the room number requirements when originally issued.

The applicant offers 25 rental rooms, none of which include kitchenettes. Alcohol is not stocked in the rental rooms, and the establishment has a restaurant. The facility provides a shuttle from Cantwell to Healy, walking trails and recommendations regarding tours, trips and rentals to support tourism activities in the area.

I am writing to ask for forgiveness and ask to have this liquor license reinstated. This laps in timely filling is all my fault. It has been the hardest 6 months of my entire life.

My mother collapsed early December and I had to get a emergency flight to Oregon to help her. she was totally paralyzed, couldn't talk - nothing except move her eyes. Her sister stayed with her until I flew in late that night. She should of called an ambulance. I called one and got her to the hospital. After a very lengthy stay in emergency they found she had 7 tumors in her brain. Once admitted they started heavy doses of steroids to relieve the pressure and she gained some of her faculties. I was able to finally get her home the 23 of December, all she wanted was to get out of the hospital and go home for Christmas.

More Dr's tests reviled that our only course of action was hospice care. I kept her home, took care of her full time, and we made the best of what little time we had left. She died at home with me - exactly where she wanted to be. I was amazing and at the same time the hardest thing I have ever done.

Then came the family - a death can bring out the worst in them. I am still dealing with settling her estate. At the same time I was diagnosed with a kidney problem that required surgery. Just keep putting on foot in front of the other. Next was a very bad fall in a walk-in fridge. I have been dealing with daily pain and sleepless nights, trying many different things in hopes of avoiding surgery. My surgery is June 26th.

With all that I have had to deal with my son and his family has stepped in to run this 4 generation family business. He has quit his job and this is this family of fours only income. I have been working on getting things to make this a smooth transition for them. And I honestly thought I was doing all I needed to make this transfer from sole proprietorship to incorporation. I did not thoroughly read the letter sent to me. This is all on me, I ask for this forgiveness for the kids and their young family.

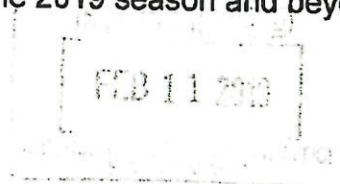
Tourism Statement for the liquor license renewal for Panorama Pizza Pub, 2019

4. 4. We offer room rentals to the traveling public. We have 25 rooms available, each sleeping four guests. Our rooms do not include kitchens and are not stocked with alcoholic beverages.
5. 5. Our establishment includes a dining facility--a pizza restaurant-- that serves pizzas, salads and appetizers.
6. 6. Additional property amenities provided to our guests include: a 24 hour free shuttle with routes from Cantwell to Healy, walking trails, wifi, and an additional dining room on the other side of the property that serves breakfast and dinner, and packed park lunches. Panorama Pizza Pub has been a staple in the Denali community for over twenty years. We are one of the few remaining businesses in the Denali National Park area that is still family owned and operated, a major selling point to visitors traveling here. We look forward to continuing offering our guests the option to have a beer or cocktail with their pizza when visiting us. Included below are the answers to the AMCO mandatory points:

1. 1. Visitors looking for small, locally owned businesses to support, can expect to have all the same food and beverage options included at the large, corporate hotels near by, encouraging tourism to our area. Renewing our license would keep us competitive with these out-of-state owned businesses. Guests to Alaska looking to have a true Alaska dining experience come to Panorama for our extensive local beer and spirits collection and knowledge of the surrounding area. Guests are delighted to speak with owners and employees who are from Alaska, and many of those guests return year after year. We have a waiting list for guests nearly every night at dinner service during our short summer season, almost all guests traveling from outside of Alaska.
2. 2. Panorama Pizza is constructed to promote a safe beverage consumption environment. There are clearly marked beverage consumption areas, and an open floorplan to promote safe monitoring of guests by all of our TAPS educated servers. Any future improvements or expansions will include all of these points. We do hope to expand the outdoor beverage drinking area this year to include a horse shoe pit and badminton court.
3. 3. Panorama Pizza Pub is owned and operated by Leslie LeQuire and the Denali Perch Resort.
4. 4. We offer room rentals to the traveling public. We have 25 rooms available, each sleeping four guests. Our rooms do not include kitchens and are not stocked with alcoholic beverages.
5. 5. Our establishment includes a dining facility--a pizza restaurant-- that serves pizzas, salads and appetizers.
6. 6. Additional property amenities provided to our guests include: a 24 hour free shuttle with routes from Cantwell to Healy, walking trails, wifi, and an additional dining room on the other side of the property that serves breakfast and dinner, and packed park lunches. We also offer our guests assistance with booking all their trips and /or tours with our extensive 20+ years of knowledge from living in the area year round.
