Requested Transfer of ownership and location; dba change **Action:**

StatutoryAS 04.11.040(a) & (b): "A license issued under this title may not be transferred to
another person except with the written consent of the board.

(b) A license or permit issued under this title may not be transferred to a new location except with the written consent of the board."

AS 04.11.480(a): "A local governing body may protest the issuance, renewal, relocation, or transfer to another person of a license by sending the board and the applicant a protest and the reasons for the protest within 60 days of receipt from the board of notice of filing of the application... The board shall consider a protest and testimony received at a hearing conducted under AS 04.11.510(b)(2) or (4) when it considers the application... If an application or continued operation is protested, the board shall deny the application or continued operation unless the board finds that the protest is arbitrary, capricious, and unreasonable."

AS 04.11.510(b)(2): "The board may review an application for the issuance, renewal, transfer of location, or transfer to another person of a license without affording the applicant notice or hearing, except...(2) the board may, on its own initiative or in response to an objection or protest, hold a hearing to ascertain the reaction of the public or a local governing body to an application if a hearing is not required under this subsection;"

Staff Rec.: Reconsider the previous action; hold a public hearing on the protest; deny the transfer with a 180-day abeyance

Background: This is an application for transfer of ownership of a beverage dispensary license in Anchorage from Fish or Cut Bait LLC, dba Blues Central, located at 609 F Street, to Whisky & Ramen, LLC, dba Whiskey & Ramen, located at 436 W 4th Avenue.

The board approved this application with delegation at the last meeting, due to an objection from the Department of Labor – Employment Security and a creditor. Since then, the Department of Labor – Employment Security has lifted its objection, but a protest has been received from the

Municipality of Anchorage pending certification from the Fire Department and issuance of a conditional use permit.

In accordance with AS 04.11.480(a), the board should uphold the protest and deny the transfer with a 180-day abeyance, giving the applicant 180 days to resolve the issue with the municipality and have them lift the protest. If the municipality lifts the protest within 180 days, the transfer would then be approved with delegation, as the creditor objection would need to be lifted before the transfer could be effectuated. The licensee should be notified that under 3 AAC 304.145(h), the abeyance period may not be extended or renewed.
