

The Anchor Inn & Lounge provide room rentals to all/ any traveling public and is located near our local harbor and fish processing plant. Having a total of sixteen rooms where ten provide kitchen areas. Currently being operated by Michelle Gronholdt for the Lounge where the liquor license is operated and Pam Gundersen for the Inn portion. No dining facility is available but for the Inn a laundry mat and check-in basket with coffee and cereal bar are available. As for the Lounge, we provide sports channels, internet and frozen food items along with beer, wine and basic cocktails which is connected to the liquor license.

The Anchor Inn and Lounge encourage tourism by being available to our locals and any traveling public. Tourism helps our small fishing community, with the Anchor Inn and Lounge available, being one of the only places that offer room rentals with a lounge area here in Sand Point. The issuance of a liquor license at our establishment has encouraged tourism by providing a place to stay with amenities such as a warm place to have a drink.

The Lounge area is also open until midnight and makes for a place to connect for any late-night travelers especially from the seasonal ferry and sail boats and has been a place for coming and going bear hunters. Shumagin Corporation, Anchor Inn & Lounge encourage tourism and attract the traveling with advertisements such as with our web site and radio station.
