Licensee Christina Motaragol was asked to show proof of server education. After returning from the main service area, Motaragol presented an altered TAP card #124357. Contact was made with a CHARR representative and it was learned the card she presented had expired on 1-13-18.

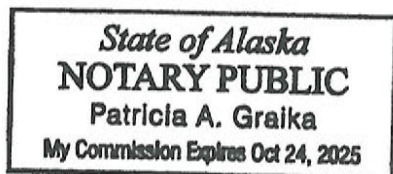
