Requested Action:

Reinstatement and renewal

Statutory and Regulatory Authority:

AS 04.06.090(b): "The board shall review all applications for licenses made under this title and may order the director to issue, renew, revoke, transfer, or suspend licenses and permits authorized under this title."

AS 04.11.540: "...If a complete application for renewal has not been filed by February 28 or the required fees and the penalty fees have not been paid by that date, the license expires at 12:00 midnight February 28."

- 3 AAC 304.160(f): "The board will deny a request for reinstatement submitted under (e) of this section if
- (1) the license became available in accordance with 3 AAC 304.100(2) and was issued to a different applicant, unless the limit of licenses under AS 04.11.400 has not been reached; or
- (2) the board finds that the failure to timely file or pay was caused by
- (A) the licensee's failure to notify the board of a change of the licensee's mailing address;
- (B) a transfer of ownership of the business for which the license was issued without written approval of the board in violation of AS 04.11.040;
- (C) a lease of the licensed business to another person in violation of AS 04.11.450(c); or
- (D) any other action of the licensee whether active or tacit that the board finds constitutes a failure to lawfully operate the business for which the license was issued."

**Staff Rec.:** Evaluate reinstatement request in accordance with 3 AAC 304.160(f).

**Background:** During the 2021/2022 licensing period, the licensee expressed interest in either surrendering the license temporarily or expiring the license. Staff assisted the licensee with his questions and on December 28, 2020 the licensee turned in his license with a written statement that he will not be renewing and requested a refund.

January 25, 2022 staff followed up with a conversation on how to reinstate the license and information about a possible transfer of controlling interest.

May 24, 2023, staff had received a partial reinstatement and renewal application packet and emailed the licensee instructions on how to complete the application process.

The complete renewal and waiver applications, required fees and written request were deemed complete August 1, 2023.

#### To Whom It May Concern,

When I finally spoke to a person, I specifically asked about renewing this license later, they said renewing the license should not be an issue later and that many things were up in the air due to covid. I have not had any violations and have been in good standing for the ten years Table 6 was open at 3210 Denali Street. I have paid all late fees and renewal fees to have the license renewed.

I apologize for the delay, I had to ask management a couple questions before I could get back to you.

It's written into statute & regulations. If you wish to continue ownership of the license and operate in the future or sell the license, you will have to complete the renewal process. If the license is not operated for 30 days or more it will need to be surrendered to our office. You will still have the ability to operate or transfer the license after it's renewed.

If the license expires 2/28/21, you will have to go through the reinstatement process if you wish to operate again. The reinstatement would also need board approval. Please see 3 AAC 304.160(e) & (f)

#### 3 AAC 304.160(e) & (f)

- (e) For the purposes of AS 04.11.540, if a license has expired for failure to file a complete application for renewal by February 28 or for failure to pay the required fees and penalty fees by that date, the board will consider a written request to reinstate the license if the request is accompanied by
  - (1) a complete application;
  - (2) a reinstatement fee of \$1,000;
  - (3) all other required fees and penalty fees; and
  - (4) proof of good cause for the failure to file and pay by February 28.
- (f) The board will deny a request for reinstatement submitted under (e) of this section if
- (1) the license became available in accordance with 3 AAC 304.100(2) and was issued to a different applicant, unless the limit of licenses under AS 04.11.400 has not been reached; or
  - (2) the board finds that the failure to timely file or pay was caused by
- (A) the licensee's failure to notify the board of a change of the licensee's mailing address;
- (B) a transfer of ownership of the business for which the license was issued without written approval of the board in violation of AS 04.11.040;
- (C) a lease of the licensed business to another person in violation of AS 04.11.450(c); or
- (D) any other action of the licensee whether active or tacit that the board finds constitutes a failure to lawfully operate the business for which the license was issued. (Eff. 9/11/98, Register 147; am 6/13/2003, Register 166; am 2/21/2019, Register 229)

Per our conversation I am sending you information on how to reinstate a license. Please note that reinstatement is contingent upon ABC Board approval which is not guaranteed. In your case, you are wishing to reinstate a Beverage Dispensary license located in the Municipality of Anchorage. This license type is subject to population limits. Currently there are 96 BDL's allowed in the Municipality and 118 in existence. This is a valid count as of today. You may find the list of active licenses and the population figures both posted on our website at

https://www.commerce.alaska.gov/web/amco/OtherAlcoholResources.aspx

There are no available new BDL licenses in the Municipality of Anchorage. You may seek to reinstate your BDL but again, there is no guarantee the ABC Board will give their approval.

However, because it is not clear that the ABC Board, upon consideration, will approve your reinstatement our office will not address the transfer issue for license #4847 at this time. If you fill out and submit the 2021-22 renewal form as part of the reinstatement for license #4847 you should fill it out with the current AMCO approved ownership information.

Should you wish to seek to reinstate Beverage Dispensary License #4847 our office will need the following forms and fees:

- 2021-2022 Renewal Application
- Renewal Fees and related late fee
- If you did not operate for a minimum or 240 total hours in 2019 or 2020 an AB-29 form and related fees are needed for each year.
  - The Board waived fees and late fees for the AB-29 form for 2020 (and 2021) due to Covid but NOT for 2019
- Reinstatement Fee
- Reinstatement Request in writing

The following fees apply:

\$2500.00 Renewal fee \$300.00 Renewal application fee \$500.00 Late renewal fee \$1000.00 Reinstatement fee

If you submit an AB-29 form for 2019 the following fees apply:

\$1250.00 AB-29 form fee \$1000.00 AB-29 late fee
