

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



The garage door will be secured from the inside and both doors will have exterior security lighting. Surveillance cameras which can be monitored from inside and outside the building will be installed near both doors. All interior rooms will also have lockable doors and a surveillance camera inside.

Describe your processes for admitting visitors into and escorting them through restricted access areas:

Any visitor must have an appointment before coming to our facility and days available for visiting will be limited. The visitor will be met at the entry door by two employees and after checking the visitor's photo ID to make sure they have an appointment and are over the age of twenty-one, they will be signed into the visitor log and be given a visitor pass to wear. An authorized employee will escort the visitor into the proper or necessary restricted access areas. The visitor will wear the pass at all times while in the facility and will at no time be left unsupervised by an authorized employee. At the end of the visit, visitors will return their passes, sign out of the log book and be escorted out of the building.

Our general policy for preventing diversion during growing operations will be to check plant and product inventory at every stage and with more than one employee and/or company manager present. Inventory checks will be entered and saved to a database kept on and off site.

-The use of Greenbits, a cannabis inventory tracking used by the company is compatible with Metrc.

-Metrc RFID tags will be placed on all plants and products throughout the cultivation and processing.

We will have a zero tolerance policy for loitering. Signs will also be posted to notify the public of the surveillance cameras. No loitering signs will also be posted on the building. The facility will have exterior video surveillance cameras at both entrances, and will be monitored by employees. If anyone is caught loitering, they will be told to leave or law enforcement will be notified. Employees will be given direction and training for these incidents.

Motion detection alarms will be installed throughout interior of the facility. These alarms will notify law enforcement if any intruders are detected. All solid plant waste will be weighed and entered into the Metrc system. The waste will be stored in sealed storage containers in the secure areas inside the facility. The Marijuana Control Board will be given at least three days notice before the waste is disposed of. After the waste has been shredded and mixed with coconut coir, it will be disposed of at the Juneau landfill or composted in the company owners' bins to be used in their private gardens. Records will be kept of the final destination of the waste.

The company cultivation method is designed around having zero wastewater. Our plants will be grown in a coconut coir medium and hand watered with no fertilizer runoff.

Describe what material or materials you will mix with the ground marijuana waste to make it unusable:

Shredded cannabis waste will be mixed with an equal amount of used growing medium. We plan to use a coconut coir based medium called Tuper.

After receiving positive test results, the approved batches of dried cannabis will be packaged for retail in quantities not exceeding one ounce. Packages will be child resistant, opaque, and re-sealable. Packages will have a Metrc tracking label and be labeled as required under 3AAC 306.475.(a) and (d). Packages will have a written statement containing the information required by 3AAC 306.475.(b).

We plan to have two specific types of retail packages. One type will consist of a glass mason jar with a re-sealable childproof lid to hold the cannabis. The jar will be placed in a small opaque paper box. On the box will be printed the company logo, testing results, and necessary warning labels. The other packaging style will use opaque five mil mylar bags. The bags will be child resistant and re-sealable. We will use a pre-bagged coconut coir based medium called Tuper for all our plants. Tuper contains: coco fiber, aged forest materials, perlite, crushed basalt.

Describe the marijuana cultivation facility's fertilizers, chemicals, gases, and delivery systems, including carbon dioxide management, to be used:

We will use a veganic (non-animal based) fertilizer call Vegamatrix for all our plants. For fungus and insect control we will use organic Neem oil.

Each grow room will contain a CO2 system to keep CO2 levels at a constant 1500 ppm while the lights are on. The CO2 systems will use 50 lb. CO2 tanks located outside each grow room. Each system will have a manual shutoff valve and will be connected to a computer controlled CO2 monitor.

Describe the marijuana cultivation facility's irrigation and waste water systems to be used:

All of our plants will be hand watered with no fertilizer runoff. We will have no leftover or residual fertilizers to dispose of. The only waste water that will leave our facility will be from normal usage of the shop sink and bathroom, and will go into the city sewer system.

After plant waste has been shredded and mixed with used growing medium, it will be disposed at the city landfill. Non-plant waste will also be disposed at the landfill. Any hazardous waste will be disposed of at the weekly CBJ hazardous waste disposal location.

COMMERCIAL PROPERTY LEASE

THIS LEASE, made March 17, 2016 by and between MACKINCO, An Alaskan Partnership, 1114 Glacier Ave., Juneau, Alaska 99801, Lessor and The Fireweed Factory LLC, 8393 North Douglas Hwy, Juneau, AK 99801

WITNESSETH:

That the Lessor in consideration of the payment of the rent and the performance of all of the covenants herein contained by the Lessee does hereby demise and lease unto the Lessee the following-described property located in the Juneau Recording District:

A portion of the of the Building located at, 8415 Airport Blvd (space B), Juneau, Alaska, containing approximately 2150 square feet for a term of three (3) years from June 1, 2016 for a term rent of \$77,400.00. The term rent is payable as follows:

\$2150.00 on the first day of the term and the same date each month thereafter throughout year one of the term.

In addition Lessee agrees to pay the sales tax in effect in the City and Borough of Juneau on each payment as it falls due.

LEASE RENTAL INCREASE. If the items listed below increase in the aggregate of ten per cent (10%) the Lessor may increase the rent once a year on the first of the year following the date of execution of this lease on a pro-rata basis of space rented to total space owned in the building by Lessor where the building wide increase in rent is equal to the total amount of the increase in said items:

Fire and other hazards insurance Real property taxes Increases in the consumer Cost-of-Living Index as released by the U.S. Government

LIABILITIES FOR TAXES. The responsibilities of the parties for taxes which may become due or owing as a result of this lease are as follows;

1. Taxes upon personal property owned by lessee or being acquired by Lessee, such as for furniture, equipment, and merchandise used or to be utilized by Lessee are to be paid for by Lessee.

2. License taxes, sales taxes, or other taxes attributable to Lessee's occupation of the demised premises are to be paid by the Lessee.

3. Real property taxes and assessments fro public improvements are to be paid for by the Lessor, subject to the paragraph entitled Lease Rental Increase.

MAINTENANCE OF THE PREMISES. The parties' responsibilities as the condition of the demised premises during the term of this lease are as follows:

1. The demised premises are accepted by Lessee in their present condition and state of repair.

2. Lessee is responsible for maintaining the interior of the demised premises in its present condition and at Lessee's own expense.

3. Lessor is responsible for maintaining the exterior and foundations of the demised premises in a good state of repair during the term of this lease.

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4. No remodeling or structural alterations of the demised premises may be undertaken without the Lessee first having obtained Lessor's written consent thereto, and all such undertakings shall be performed and completed in a workmanlike manner, with remodeling to include the authority to change and alter interior walls and to install necessary plumbing and wiring for Lessee's purposes. Lessee to bear the costs of any and all alterations. Lessee, subject to the express direction and control of Lessor, shall be responsible for restoring the demised premises to its original condition at the termination of the lease term. Lessor's written consent for remodeling shall not be unreasonably withheld.

5. In connection with any maintenance or repair of the furnace or heating systems, the obligation for the payment of same shall be that of the Lessee, on a pro-rata basis, as the normal wear and tear and that of Lessor as to permanent fixture replacement needs. Lessee's pro-rata share of the maintenance or repair of the furnace or heating systems shall be based upon the percentage of the entire area being heated for Lessee's benefit to the total of all leasable space.

6. Lessee is to make the demised premises available to Lessor or Lessor's agents at reasonable times in order to permit inspection concerning the condition and state of repair of the demised premises.

7. Lessor is not responsible for the repair or replacement and the maintaining of water pipes utilized in connection with Lessee's occupation of the demised premises and Lessee shall save Lessor harmless from any damages that may be sustained as a result of Lessee's neglect in allowing said water pipes to freeze.

8. Lessee is responsible for and shall erect and maintain only those signs which are suitable to Lessor, and in order to advertise Lessee's business operation on the demised premises, and Lessee shall obtain Lessor's approval of any such signs prior to ordering, purchasing or erection any such signs.

9. UTILITY AND SERVICE CHARGES. Those expenses which are incurred from day to day in connection with Lessee's occupation of the demised premises shall be apportioned as follows:

1. The obligation of payment and the expense of all utility and local government service charges including, but not limited to, electricity, telephone, and garbage removal, in connection with the demised premises, shall be that of the Lessee.

2. Lessee shall arrange, at Lessee's expense, for adequate garbage collection services so as to preclude any unsightliness as a result of garbage litter on the surrounding area.

TERMINATION OF THE LEASE. The conditions governing the termination of this lease and the Lessee's departure from the possession of the demised premises are as follows:

1. Time is declared to be of the essence as to the performance of all conditions and covenants created by the execution of this Lease Indenture with the consequence that any default hereunder gives Lessor the right to take possession of the demised premises and to occupy the demised premises to the exclusion of Lessee, with Lessor thus having the option to thereupon terminate the lease.

2. On termination of this lease, whether by breach or expiration of its term Lessee agrees that Lessee will vacate and depart the demised premises leaving them in as good a condition and state of repair as when possession was taken except as to ordinary wear and tear and damage or destruction by a fire which destroys 20% or more of the demised premises.

3. A default occurs hereunder if Lessee, within ten (10) days of receipt of written notice by Lessor of a failure by Lessee to comply with this agreement.

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4. In the event of destruction by fire or other cause, or in the event of damage sufficient to make the demised premises untenable for period in excess of ninety (90) days, then this lease may be terminated by Lessor or Lessee provided that in the event of an untenable period of less than ninety (90) days the Lessee is relieved of the obligation for the payment of the required monthly lease installments during said untenable period but the lease can only be canceled under such circumstances at the option of the Lessor.

5. In the event that the United States federal government withdraws or substantially alters the enforcement priorities outlined in the memorandum that United States Deputy Attorney General James Cole issued to all U.S. Attorneys on August 29, 2013 (commonly referred to as "the Cole Memo"), such that continued operation of a marijuana establishment in compliance with State of Alaska and/or City & Borough of Juneau laws and regulations would no longer likely shield from federal intervention, whether civil or criminal, then this lease may be terminated by Lessor or Lessee.

6. In the event that the State of Alaska and/or City & Borough of Juneau enacts, amends, or repeals laws or regulations, or conditions permits such that the Lessor or Lessee is no longer able to perform any act or operation intended under this lease, or rendering any service required under this Lease, then the performance of any such act or obligation affected by the change in law, or rendering of any such service affected by the change in law shall be excused for the period of the resulting delay and the period of the performance or rendering shall be extended for a period equivalent to the period of such delay. Should such delay extend six (6) months, then this lease may be terminated by Lessor or Lessee.

7. Within ten (10) days after termination and the Lessee vacating the demised premises, any carpeting or flooring, lighting fixtures, wall paneling, and other permanent fixtures or improvements which may have been installed by Lessee or at Lessee's direction become the property of Lessor without cost or expense to the Lessor except as may otherwise be expressly provided herein.

8. This lease may be terminated at any time by mutual consent of Lessee and Lessor.

LIEN INDEMNIFICATION. Lessee is responsible to Lessor for liability incurred as a result of Lessee's acts or neglect, and Lessee shall not allow the demised premises to become subject to any lien, charge, or encumbrances.

QUIET ENJOYMENT AND LEASE RENEWAL. During the term of this lease and as to any renewals of said lease:

1. Lessee is entitled to, and shall hold and enjoy, the demised premises without interference from Lessor so long as Lessee promptly pays the monthly lease installments herein required and performs the covenants and abides by the conditions herein contained.

2. All provisions hereof shall inure to the benefit of, extend to, and include, and be binding upon, the heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns of the Lessee and the Lessor.

3. This lease is not renewable by the Lessee, except as may otherwise be expressly provided herein, and any occupation of the demised premises by the Lessee beyond the term of this lease shall only be upon the basis of a month to month tenancy subject to all of the terms and conditions herein contained and not otherwise in conflict.

LIABILITY FOR FIRE LOSS. The Lessor is not responsible to Lessee for any loss by Lessee of personal property maintained on the demised premises as a result of fire or related cause and Lessee shall, at Lessee's sole expense, maintain such insurance as Lessee may desire in order to protect against any such loss.

DAMAGE RESPONSIBILITY. Lessor shall not be liable for any damage occasioned by the negligence or fault of the Lessee, or for any damage resulting from the act or negligence of co-

tenants or other occupants of the same building or any owners or occupants of adjacent or contiguous property.

ABANDONMENT OR VACATION. If lessee shall abandon or vacate said premises prior to the expiration date of this lease, the same may be relet, by the lessor, at the best rent obtainable and any deficiency in the amount of rent herein mentioned to be paid by the lessee and the rent herein mentioned to be paid by the Lessee and the rent received after such abandonment or vacation shall be paid by the Lessee to the Lessor.

SAVE HARMLESS. Lessee will save and indemnify the Lessor harmless from all judgments, liabilities, expenses, costs, and attorneys' fees arising out of any act, omission, or neglect in such respect of the Lessee, lessee's agents or employees, or of any person permitted by Lessee to be upon or about the demised premises, as well as from all judgments, liabilities, expenses, costs and attorney fees incurred or paid by the Lessor in defending against any action at law, suit in equity, or statutory proceedings brought by or at the instance, or in the name of any governmental body, or any public authority in which it shall be attempted to subject the Lessor or the demised premises, or any part thereof to any damages, costs, injunctions, restriction, or regulations, by reason of any claim that there shall have been any such act, omission or neglect of Lessee in any of the respects aforesaid. This save harmless obligation does not apply to loss by fire.

LIABILITY INSURANCE. Lessee agree at all times during the term hereof, at Lessee's own expense, to maintain, keep in effect, furnish, and deliver to the Lessor evidence of liability insurance in form and with an insurer satisfactory to the Lessor, insuring both the Lessor and the Lessee against all liability for damages to person or property in or about said demised premises: the amount of said liability insurance shall not be less than \$100,000.00 for injury to one person, \$300,000.00 for injuries arising out of any one accident, and not less than \$50,000.00 for property damage. All such insurance shall name Lessor as a co-insured by policy endorsement.

OPTION TO RENEW. Lessee shall be entitled to renew this lease for an additional term of three (3) years upon the same terms and conditions as set forth in this lease, save for the rental terms which, unless the parties otherwise agree, will be established as hereinafter set forth. This option may only be exercised by giving written notice of Lessee's intention to renew not sooner than one hundred eighty (180) days, nor less than ninety (90) days before the expiration of the original term of this lease, which notice must declare the rental rate at which Lessee is willing to renew the lease. Unless Lessor gives Lessee written notice of Lessor's rejection of the renewal rental proposal within thirty (30) days of the date of receipt of Lessee's notice, the renewal rental proposal of Lessee will be deemed accepted by Lessor. If Lessor rejects the renewal rental proposal, Lessee's renewal rights will automatically cease and terminate.

BANKRUPTCY. In the event that the lessee becomes voluntarily or involuntarily bankrupt, or if a receiver be appointed by any court for the business of the Lessee, then the term of this lease shall, at the election of the Lessor, immediately terminate.

CONDEMNATION. With reference to condemnation and any proceedings in regards thereto, the following shall apply:

1. In the event title to the entire demised premises shall be acquired by anyone by exercise of right of eminent domain, this lease shall cease and terminate upon the vesting of title and Lessee shall make all payments required to be made by Lessee hereunder pro-rata to the date of such vesting of title, but Lessee shall be entitled to a pro-rata refund of any rent paid in advance. Lessee shall be indemnified for the depreciated value of any improvements Lessee has made which have increased the value of the demised premises as reflected in the purchase price under eminent domain proceedings.

2. In the event title to less than the whole of the leased premises but more than twenty (20%) percent of any ground floor area of the building thereon, or more than twenty (20%) percent of the entire demised premises shall be so acquired by eminent domain, or, as a result of exercise of such right of eminent domain, the part of the demised premises remaining shall not be one undivided whole, then Lessor shall immediately give to Lessee written notice of such acquisition and Lessee

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shall have the option to terminate this lease effective on a date to be specified in a written notice to be given by Lessee to Lessor, provided, however, that the date so specified in such notice shall be a date not more than sixty (60) days after the receipt by Lessee from Lessor of notice of such acquisition, and in such event Lessee shall make all payments required to be made by Lessee hereunder pro-rata to the date of such termination, but Lessee shall be entitled to a pro-rata refund of any rent paid in advance.

3. In the event Lessee does not exercise Lessee's right of termination, then this lease and all of the covenants, agreements, terms and conditions hereof shall continue in full force and effect as to the portion of the demised premises not taken by exercise of the right of eminent domain. If a portion of the demised premises shall have been so taken by exercise of the right of eminent domain without termination of this lease, as aforesaid, Lessor shall repair and rebuild the portion of the demised premises not so taken in such manner as to render such remaining portion commercially usable for the purpose of Lessee, and lessor shall restore such portion to a unit of substantially like quality and character as existed before such taking. Commencing with the date said portion of the demised premises so taken, the monthly rental shall be reduced in the proportion that the total square footage of the demised premises so taken shall bear to the total square footage the demised premises prior to such taking.

4. Any condemnation award with respect to the demised premises shall be the sole and exclusive property of the Lessor.

PERSONAL PROPERTY. All equipment unique to Lessee's business, and located on the demised premises by Lessee are the property of Lessee and shall be removed by Lessee or at Lessee's expense at the termination of this lease.

WINDOW GLASS. Lessee shall repair and replace, with like quality, all window or door glass on the demised premises which may become broken or cracked during the lease term or any renewals thereof and shall do so at Lessee's sole expense.

INSURANCE RECOVERY WAVER. Lessor and Lessee, and all parties claiming under them, hereby mutually release and discharge each other from all claims and liabilities arising from or caused by any hazard covered by insurance on the demised premises, or covered by insurance in connection with property on or activities conducted on the demised premises, regardless of the cause of the damage or loss and to the extent of any recovery collectible under such insurance. Lessor and lessee agree to notify fire and extended coverage insurance companies of these conditions and have insurance policies appropriately endorsed in order to preclude insurance coverage invalidity.

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

OPERATING AGREEMENT THE FIREWEED FACTORY LLC

THIS OPERATING AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is entered into this <u>(9</u> day of <u>May</u>, 2016, by and among the undersigned.

ARTICLE I GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.1 Name. The name of the organization is The Fireweed Factory, LLC (the "Company"), formed when the executed Articles of Organization were filed with the Alaska Department of Commerce and Economic Development, in accordance with and pursuant to the Alaska Revised Limited Liability Company Act ("Act").

1.2 Principal Place of Business. The Company's principal place of business shall be located in Juneau, Alaska, and at any other or additional places the Members may from time to time determine.

1.3 Purpose. The purpose of the Company includes commercial production and sale of cannabis and cannabis products and any and all lawful purposes for which limited liability companies are allowed under the Act.

1.4 Property. The property of the Company shall be owned by and in the name of the Company as an entity. Such property and the credit of the Company shall be used solely for the benefit of the Company and not for the benefit of any individual Member. Insofar as permitted by the laws of Alaska, no Member shall have any ownership interest in such property in the Member's individual capacity. Each Member's interest in the Company shall be personal property.

1.5 Term. The Company is effective as of the date the Articles of Organization were filed with the State and shall continue until terminated as provided herein.

ARTICLE II MEMBERSHIP INTERESTS

2.1 Membership Interests. "Membership Interest" shall mean the Member's ownership interest in the Company. Each Member's Membership Interest is equal to such Member's capital account as set forth in Section 4.1 divided by the aggregate of the capital accounts of all Members and is expressed as a percentage. As of the date of this agreement, the Members' capital contributions and Membership Interests are as follows:

2.2 No Interest, No Withdrawal of Capital. Capital contributions shall not earn interest. Except as otherwise provided for in this Agreement, no Member shall be entitled to withdraw or receive a return of any portion of his capital contribution.

2.3 Additional Contributions. No Member shall be required to contribute any additional capital to the Company unless determined necessary by vote of a Majority-In-Interest of the Members in order to enable the Company to conduct its business. Any additional capital contribution shall be made pro rata by all the Members unless all Members consent to a non-pro rata contribution.

2.4 Failure to Contribute. If any member fails to make a capital contribution as required by Section 2.3 at the time and in the amount specified (the "Defaulting Member"), the Defaulting Member's right to vote shall be suspended, and his share of any distributions from the Company shall be retained by the Company as a contribution until his obligation to make the additional contribution has been satisfied. The members other than the Defaulting Member may agree by vote of a Majority-In-Interest to make the additional contribution owed by the Defaulting Member in such proportions they choose. If the members other than the Defaulting Member agree to make such a contribution all Membership Interests shall be adjusted accordingly.

2.5 The fair market value of any property other than cash or publicly traded securities to be contributed as a capital contribution shall be (a) agreed upon by the contributing Member and a Majority-in-Interest of the Members before the contribution, or (b) determined by a disinterested appraiser selected by the Manager.

ARTICLE III OPERATIONS AND MANAGEMENT

3.1 Actions by Members. The Company shall be Manager-managed. The Members will not be entitled to participate in the day-to-day affairs and management of the Company but instead, the Members' right to vote or otherwise participate in operation of the Company shall be limited to those matters on which Members are entitled to vote by the Act, the Articles, or this Agreement. On those matters on which a Members may act, each Member shall have a vote equal to his Membership Interest at the time of the vote; for example, if a Member holds a 10% Membership Interest, he has 10% of the total voting power. For matters on which the Members may act, the vote of more than 50% of all Membership Interests in the Company (a "Majority-In-Interest") shall be binding upon the Company unless a higher standard is required by this Agreement.

3.1.1 Actions Requiring Approval of the Members. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Operating Agreement, the approval of the Members shall be required in order for any of the following actions to be taken on behalf of the Company:

(a) Amending the Articles or this Operating Agreement in any manner that materially alters the preferences, privileges or relative rights of the Members, which shall be by unanimous consent.

(b) Taking any action that would make it impossible to carry on the ordinary business of the Company.

(c) Confessing a judgment against the Company.

(d) Filing or consenting to filing a petition for or against the Company under any federal or state bankruptcy, insolvency or reorganization act.

(e) Loaning Company funds to a Member in excess of \$1,000 or for a term in excess of one year.

3.1.2 Method of Action by Members. Members may take action either by meeting or by written consents. Meetings of Members may be called at any time by the Manager. Notice of meetings must be given to Members by the Manager calling the meeting at least 10 days but not more than 60 days before the meeting. Members may participate in meetings by telephone or video conference, or other similar method. In lieu of a meeting, Members may take action by all signing a written consent to the action.

3.2 Meetings. The Company shall have at least one annual meeting at a place and time as determined by the Members

3.3 Management by Managers. Except as otherwise expressly provided in the Act, the Articles of Organization or this Operating Agreement, the Managers are authorized and empowered on behalf of and in the name of the Company to carry out any and all of the purposes of the Company and to perform all acts and enter into and perform all contracts and other undertakings that they may, in their sole discretion, deem necessary, advisable or incidental thereto. Notwithstanding the foregoing, no member other than a Manager shall have authority to manage or specifically bind the Company except as specifically provided in this Operating Agreement. Managers have the power make all decisions affecting such business and affairs, either separately or together, including without limitation, for Company purposes, the power to:

(a) acquire by purchase, lease or otherwise, any real or personal property, tangible or intangible;

(b) construct, operate, maintain, finance and improve and to own, sell, convey, assign, mortgage or lease any property owned or held by the Company;

(c) enter into agreements and contracts in connection with the Company's business;

(d) borrow money for and on behalf of the Company and execute any guaranty on behalf of a third party and pledge Company property to secure any such obligation;

(e) execute or modify agreements or contracts with respect to any part or all of the property owned or held by the Company;

(f) repay, in whole or in part, refinance, amend, modify or extend any mortgages or deeds of trust that may affect any property owned or held by the Company and, in connection therewith, to execute for and on behalf of the Company any extensions, renewals or modifications of such mortgages or deeds of trust;

(g) make any and all expenditures that the Manager, in his sole discretion, deem necessary or appropriate in connection with the management of the affairs of the Company and the carrying out of its obligations and responsibilities under this Agreement, including, without limitation, all operating, capital, legal, accounting, investment advisory and other related expenses incurred in connection with the organization, financing and operation of the Company or in connection with its property;

(h) execute any and all other instruments and documents that may be necessary, or in the reasonable opinion of the Managers, desirable to carry out the intent and purpose of this Agreement;

(i) enter into any kind of activity necessary for, in connection with, or incidental to, the accomplishment of the purposes of the Company;

(j) open bank accounts, and invest and reinvest Company monies in short term instruments or money market funds or any securities or other investments, whether or not publicly traded or readily marketable;

(k) loan money on behalf of the Company;

(1) carry out the Company purposes through other limited liability companies, joint ventures, partnerships, corporations, trusts or other entities;

(m) purchase liability and other insurance to protect the Company's property and business, including policies of life insurance which insure the life of any Member;

(n) pay all Company debts, obligations and expenses;

(o) employ accountants, attorneys, appraisers or other professionals to perform services for or on behalf of the Company and to compensate them from Company funds;

(p) authorize any person to enter into and perform any agreement on behalf of the Company; and

(q) perform any and all other acts as the Managers may deem necessary or appropriate to the conduct of the Company's business.

3.3.1 Election and Removal of Managers. Paul V. Disdier will serve as the Manager of the Company until he resigns or is removed and replaced according to this Agreement. The Company must at all times have a minimum of one Manager but may

have more than one. If a Manager resigns or otherwise vacates the office of Manager, and the Company has no other Manager, the Members shall elect a replacement Manager by the vote of a Majority-In-Interest. Members may remove a Manager with or without cause by vote of a Majority-In-Interest. If a Manager is removed and the Company has no other Manager, the Members shall elect a replacement Manager by vote of a Majority-In-Interest. The Manager may, but shall not be required to, be elected from among the Members.

3.3.2 Duty of Care of the Manager. In exercising his powers and authority under, and otherwise carrying out the provisions of, this Agreement, the Manager shall perform the duties of management in good faith, in a manner he reasonably believes to be in the best interests of the company, and with the care, including reasonable inquiry, that an ordinarily prudent person in a like position would use under similar circumstances.

3.3.3 Compensation and Reimbursement. Each Manager shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for services rendered to the Company in that capacity as well as to be reimbursed for all expenses reasonably incurred by the Manager in connection with the business and purposes of the Company.

3.3.4 Incapacity of Manager. If the Manager becomes incapacitated, he will be deemed to have resigned as Manager. The existence of a Manager's incapacity shall be conclusively established by a determination of a court having jurisdiction of such matters, or by the written opinion of the Manager's physician.

3.4 Books and Records. The Company's books and records shall be maintained by the Managers at its principal place of business, and each Member shall at all times have access to and may inspect and copy any of them. The books shall be kept on a calendar year basis and shall be closed and balanced at the end of each calendar year. The Company will furnish annual financial statements to the Members and prepare tax returns in a timely manner, furnishing copies to all Members prior to filing.

3.5 Non-Competition and Non-Disclosure. While a Member of the Company or for three years after ceasing to be a Member, no Member may work as an employee of, engage in, or possess an interest in any other business venture that produces or sells cannabis or cannabis products in Juneau, Alaska. No member may at any time disclose to a party that is not a Member or employee of the Company any information regarding the methods, practices, or techniques used by the Company or its employees in the production and sale of cannabis or cannabis products. Due to the difficulty in proving damages, the Members agree that injunction is an appropriate remedy for violation of these restrictions on competition and disclosure.

3.6 Reliance on Advice. The Members and Manager shall be entitled to rely on information, opinions, reports or statements, including financial statements and other

financial data, prepared by (a) an employee of the company whom the person reasonably believes to be reliable and competent in the matters presented; or (b) counsel, public accountants, or other professionals or experts as to matters that the person reasonably believes to be within the professional's or expert's competence. However, a person is not entitled to reliance if the person has knowledge concerning the matter in question that makes reliance unwarranted.

ARTICLE IV CAPITAL ACCOUNTS AND TAX MATTERS

4.1 Capital Accounts. Separate capital accounts shall be maintained for each Member pursuant to this section. Each separate capital account (a) shall be credited with such members' (1) original contribution of capital, (2) additional capital contributions, (3) such members' share of Company income and gain (including income and gain exempt from taxation) computed and allocated in accordance with Section 4.2, and (4) the amount of any Company liability assumed by such member or that is secured by any Company asset distributed to such member; and (b) shall be charged with (1) any distributions to such member in reduction of Company capital, (2) such members' share of Company deduction and loss computed and allocated in accordance with Section 4.2 of this Agreement, and (3) the amount of any liabilities of such member assumed by the Company or that are secured by any asset contributed to the Company by such member.

Each separate capital account shall be maintained throughout the term of the Company in accordance with this Article and the provisions of Treasury Regulations ("Regulations") Section 1.704-1(b)(2)(iv), the latter controlling in the event of a conflict between the two provisions.

4.2 Computation and Allocation of Income, Gain, Loss, Deduction, and Credit. The net profits or losses and all items of Company income, gain, loss, deduction, and credit, whether resulting from Company operations or from the dissolution of the Company, shall be computed in accordance with the provisions of Section 703(a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and shall be charged to the Members in the same proportion that their capital accounts bear to each other. The members, upon a unanimous vote, may change the allocation of profit and losses provided that any allocation shall be in accordance with the Internal Revenue Code and applicable regulations so that all such allocations comport with the economic interest of the Members in the Company.

4.2.1 Allocation with Respect to Contributed Property. If, on the formation of the Company, or if at any time during the term of the Company, any Member contributes to the Company property with an adjusted basis to the contributing Member which is more or less than the agreed fair market value of the contributed property and which is accepted by the Company at the time of its contribution, the taxable income, gain, loss, deduction, or credit with respect to such

contributed property for tax purposes only (but not for purposes of calculating the Members' respective Capital Accounts) shall be shared among the Members so as to take account of the variation between the basis of the property to the Company and its agreed fair market value at the time of contribution, pursuant to Section 704(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended.

4.2.2 Varying Interests during Fiscal Year. In the event there is a change in any Membership Interest in the Company during a fiscal year (e.g., as a result of a valid transfer of all or part of a Membership Interest), net profits and net losses shall be appropriately allocated among the members to take into account the varying interests of the members so as to comply with Section 706(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended.

4.3 Members Not Liable. No Member shall have personal liability for the losses, debts, claims, expenses or encumbrances of or against the Company or its property, unless the Member has individually guaranteed repayment of a Company obligation. No Member shall be obligated to restore a deficit balance, if any, in the Member's capital account, except to the extent such deficit balance shall have arisen as a result of the Member's receipt of a distribution in excess of the amount rightfully due him under this Agreement.

4.4 Rights of Creditors. In accordance with Alaska Stat. § 10.50.380, a judgment creditor of a Member shall be entitled only to a charging order and shall only be considered an assignee of the Member and shall have no right to become a Member or have rights to participate in the management of the Company. Alaska Stat. § 10.50.380 provides the exclusive remedy to a judgment creditor.

4.5 Distributions. Available Cash shall be distributed on a semi-annual or more frequent basis to the Members according to their Membership Interests in such amounts and at such times as the Manager shall determine consistent with the Manager's fiduciary duty to the Company and the Members of the Company. "Available Cash" means cash funds of the Company on hand (other than cash funds obtained as Capital Contributions and cash funds obtained from loans to the Company) after (i) payment of all operating expenses of the Company, (ii) reasonable provisions for payment of all obligations of the Company, and (iii) reasonable provisions for working capital and other reserves for identified future uses, including growth and expansion of the Company's business.

4.6 Tax Conformity; Reliance on Attorneys or Accountants. The Members and Managers may rely upon the written formal opinion of tax counsel or accountants retained by the Company with respect to all matters (including disputes) relating to computations and determinations required to be made under this section or other provisions of this Agreement.

4.7 Tax Matters Member. If the Company operates as a partnership for income tax purposes, Paul V. Disdier shall be named on the Company tax return or on a statement filed with the Internal Revenue Service as the "Tax Matters Member" as that term is defined in Section 6231(a) (7) (A) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or its counterpart in any subsequently enacted Internal Revenue Code (the "Code"). The Tax Matters Member shall be authorized to file or revoke an election under Section 754 of the Code on behalf of the Company. References to specific Code sections herein shall not limit the Company's right to make elections as appropriate under provisions of the Code. Notwithstanding reference to specific Code sections of this Agreement, the Tax Matters Member shall at all times handle tax matters in accordance with the provisions of the Code as amended from time to time

ARTICLE V LIMITATION OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION

5.1 Limitation of Liability. No Member shall have personal liability for the losses, debts, claims, expenses or encumbrances of or against the Company or its property, unless the Member has individually guaranteed repayment of a Company obligation. The Members shall not be personally liable to the Company for monetary damages for conduct performed as a Member if the Member acted in a manner reasonably believed to be within the scope of the authority granted to him and in the best interest of the Company; provided that such act or omission did not constitute fraud, intentional misconduct, bad faith, gross negligence, or a knowing violation of law, or from which such Member personally received a benefit in money, property, or services to which such Member is not legally entitled. Any amendment to or repeal of this section shall not adversely affect any right or protection of a Member of the Company for or with respect to any acts or omissions of such Member occurring prior to such amendment or repeal.

5.2 Indemnification. The Company shall indemnify and hold harmless any Member or Manager acting on behalf of the Company, to the fullest extent allowed by the Act including, without limitation, all expenses (including attorneys' fees), costs, judgments, fines and amounts paid in settlement actually and reasonably incurred by such person; provided that such act or omission did not constitute fraud, intentional misconduct, bad faith, gross negligence, or a knowing violation of law, or from which such Member or Manager personally received a benefit in money, property, or services to which such Member or Manager is not legally entitled. All expenses (including attorneys' fees), costs, judgments, fines and amounts paid in settlement of any action, suit or proceeding shall be paid by the Company as they are incurred by any Member or Manager in advance of the final disposition of such action, suit or proceeding, upon receipt of an undertaking by or on behalf of the Member or Manager to repay the amount if it is ultimately determined by a court of competent jurisdiction that such person is not entitled to be indemnified by the Company. The provisions of this section do not affect any rights to advancement of expenses to which personnel of the

Company, other than Members and Manager, or any other person may be entitled under any contract or otherwise by law.

5.3 Exculpation of Managers. So long as a Manager acts in accordance with the duty of care required by the Act, the Manager shall not be liable or accountable to the Company or to any of the Members, in damages or otherwise, for any error of judgment, for any mistake of fact or of law, for any other act or thing that the Manager may do or refrain from doing in connection with the business and affairs of the Company or for any act or omission performed or omitted, except for willful misconduct or gross negligence or breach of the duty of care, and further except for breaches of contractual obligations or agreements between the Manager and the Company.

ARTICLE VI TRANSFER OF MEMBERSHIP INTEREST

6.1 Restrictions on Voluntary Transfers. Except as provided in Section 6.2 and 6.3, each Member agrees that he shall not transfer, including but not limited to, the sale, assignment, mortgage, pledge, hypothecation, encumbrance, lifetime gift, or bequest or devise upon death, all or any portion of his interest in the Company without first obtaining the unanimous written consent of all Members.

6.2 Permitted Transfers. Paul V. Disdier may transfer his Membership Interest, in whole or in part, by sale, assignment, lifetime gift, bequest or devise upon his death, or nontestamentary, nonprobate transfer upon his death to one or more Permitted Transferees. The "Permitted Transferees" shall be June Hall, Paul F. Disdier, and James F. Disdier, or a trust for the benefit of one or more of the forgoing. Upon transfer of all or any portion of Paul V. Disdier's Membership Interest to a Permitted Transferee, the Permitted Transferee shall become a member of the Company without the consent of any other Member by signing a counterpart signature page assenting to the terms of this Agreement. A nontestamentary, nonprobate transfer may be made by a written, signed, and acknowledged designation specifically referring to this section.

6.3 Sale of Membership Interest – Right of First Refusal. If a Member (the "Selling Member") desires to sell his Membership Interest other than in accordance with Section 6.1 or 6.2 and has received a bona fide offer in writing (the "Offer), the Selling Member may sell his interest only in accordance with the terms of this section.

6.3.1 The Selling Member shall first give written notice to the Manager and the other Members of the name of the person or entity that has made the Offer and a copy of the writing containing the terms of the Offer.

6.3.2 The Company shall have the first option to purchase and redeem the Selling Member's interest on the same terms and conditions as the Offer by written

notice to the Manager and the Selling Member within (30) days after receiving notice of the Offer. If the Company exercises its option by providing timely written notice, then the Selling Member shall be required to sell his interest to the Company under the same terms and conditions contained in the Offer.

6.3.3 If the Company does not exercise its option, the other Members shall have the option to purchase the Selling Member's interest on the same terms and conditions as the Offer. Each of the other Members shall initially be entitled to purchase a pro rata portion of the interest for sale. A member exercises his option by providing written notice to the Manager within thirty (30) days. If one or more Members exercises his option (the "Exercising Member") by providing timely written notice, then the Selling Member shall be required to sell the interest to the Exercising Member. If one or more Members does not exercise his option to purchase a pro rata portion of the interest for sale, the portions remaining shall be offered to the Exercising Members pro rata. This procedure shall be repeated until either the entire interest is sold or no Member exercises his option to purchase.

6.3.4 If any portion of the selling member's interest remains unsold, that interest may be sold to the third party on the same terms and conditions as in the initial Offer.

6.4 Admission of New Members. A person who acquires an interest in accordance with Section 6.1, 6.2, or 6.3 shall become a Member upon signing a counterpart to this Agreement assenting to the terms of this Agreement.

6.5 Unauthorized Transfers. Any purported transfer of all or any portion of a Membership Interest not in compliance with the provisions of Section 6.1-6.3 shall be null and void and of no force or effect.

6.5.1 Each member agrees that these provisions are specifically enforceable and agrees to indemnify the Company and each member from all costs, liabilities, attorney's fees or damages resulting from an attempted transfer in violation of this Agreement

6.5.2 If any purported transfer of all or any portion of a Membership Interest is deemed to be valid by a court of lawful jurisdiction despite the provisions of this Agreement to the contrary, the transferee shall not be admitted as a member without the written consent of all other Members and shall be mere assignee. The assignee shall have the right to receive such distributions to which the assignor was entitled to the extent assigned and shall be allocated the share of profits and losses attributable to such interest assigned to such person and shall otherwise be treated as a Member for Federal and state income tax purposes and for purposes of the distribution of cash or other assets to such person upon dissolution of the Company but shall have no right to vote or otherwise participate in the management or affairs of the Company or exercise any rights as a Member under this Agreement, to require any information or account of Company transactions, or to inspect the Company books and records.

6.6 Additional Transfer Restriction. Notwithstanding any other provision contained herein, without the consent of the Members, a Member or an Unadmitted Assignee may not transfer his, her or its Interest in the Company if such transfer, when aggregated with any prior transfers of Interests in the Company results in a sale or exchange within a 12-month period of 50% or more of the Interests of the Company within the meaning of Code Section 708(b).

6.7 Death or Disability of Member. If a Member dies or becomes disabled, the Member's interest in the Company does not terminate.

6.7.1 In the event that a Member is disabled or adjudicated incapacitated, either the Member's agent under a duly executed durable power of attorney or court appointed guardian or conservator may act on the Member's behalf including, but not limited to, having the right to vote in the Company business. A Member shall be considered disabled if two physicians certify that he or she is unable to manage his affairs or property due to the inability to evaluate information or communicate decisions, or is adjudicated incapacitated to manage his affairs by a court of competent jurisdiction.

6.7.2 In the event that a Member dies, and to the extent his interest is not transferred pursuant to Section 6.2, his interest converts to an assignee interest until it is transferred and the new member is admitted pursuant to Section 6.1 or 6.3. For the purpose of a sale of a deceased Member's interest pursuant to Section 6.3, if no offer is made by a third party a value determined under Article VII shall take the place of a third party's offer. The deceased Member's assignee interest shall have the right to receive such distributions to which the deceased Member would be entitled and shall be allocated the share of profits and losses attributable to the interest and shall otherwise be treated as a Member for Federal and state income tax purposes and for purposes of the distribution of cash or other assets to such person upon dissolution of the Company but shall have no right to vote or otherwise participate in the Company.

6.8 No Withdrawal or Resignation. No Member may withdraw or retire from the Company except with the consent of all other Members. A Member's interest will terminate automatically upon the happening of any event listed in AS 10.50.225, .220 or .215.

ARTICLE VII VALUATION AND PAYMENT OF INTEREST OF WITHDRAWING MEMBER

7.1 **Payment for Member Interest**. The amount paid to a withdrawing Member shall be the value of the Member's interest in the Company and the Member's proportionate share of the accrued net income or loss of the Company to the date of withdrawal.

7.2 Valuation. If all Members stipulate to a value, then that value shall be used for the purposes of this section. If a stipulated value is not reached, then the value of a Member's interest in the Company for purposes of this Agreement shall be determined by an independent third party to be chosen by a Majority-In-Interest of the Members. If a Majority-In-Interest of the Members cannot agree on an appraiser, an independent third party appraiser shall be selected by the Company's accountant and the value it determines will be binding upon the parties.

7.3 Cash or Note. Except as otherwise provided, the Company shall purchase a withdrawing Member's interest, at its option, in cash or by promissory note of the Company, or partly in cash and partly by note. Any promissory note shall be dated as of the effective date of the purchase, shall mature in not more than 10 years, shall be payable in installments that come due not less frequently than annually, shall bear interest at the prime rate as published by the Wall Street Journal on the date the loan is made plus 2%, adjusted annually during the life of the note, shall be unsecured, and may, at the Company's option, be subordinated to existing and future debts to banks and other institutional lenders for money borrowed.

7.4 Assumption of Outstanding Company Liabilities. Except as otherwise provided, the continuing Company shall pay, as they mature, all Company obligations and liabilities that exist on the effective date of a Member's termination and shall hold the withdrawing Member harmless from any action or claim arising or alleged to arise from those obligations or from liabilities accruing after that date.

ARTICLE IX DISSOLUTION AND WINDING UP

8.1 Events of Dissolution. The Company shall dissolve and commence winding up and liquidating the Company's assets upon the occurrence of any of the following events ("liquidating event"):

- (a) A written decision by the Majority-in-Interest of Members to dissolve or wind up the Company; or
- (b) The happening of an event that makes it impossible or unlawful for the Company to carry on its business.

8.2 Winding Up. Upon the happening of a liquidating event, the Company shall conduct no business or engage in any activity that is not necessary or appropriate to winding up its business and liquidating the Company, and shall proceed promptly to wind up its affairs in an orderly manner, to liquidate its assets, to satisfy the claims of its creditors and Members, and to distribute its remaining assets to the Members. The Manager shall supervise the winding up and liquidation and shall dispose of the Company's property as promptly as is consistent with obtaining its fair market value. The proceeds of the disposition of the property and the other assets of the Company shall be applied in the following order of priority:

- (a) To the payment, in order of priority, of all Company debts to creditors other than the Members;
- (b) To the payment, in the order of priority, and thereafter pro rata, of the debts of the Company owed to its Members; and
- (c) Any balance to the Members pro rata in accordance with the balances in their capital accounts.

8.3 Members' Rights. Except as otherwise specifically provided in this Agreement, each Member has the right to look only to the Company's assets for a return of his capital contribution, has no right to receive anything other than money in a distribution from the Company, and has no priority over any other Member with respect to distributions, allocations, or the return of capital contributions.

8.4 Notice of Dissolution. Within thirty (30) days of the happening of a liquidating event, the Manager shall give written notice to all creditors of the Company, to the banks and other financial institutions with which the Company normally does business, and to all other parties with whom the Company regularly conducts business. The Manager may also publish notice of dissolution in a newspaper of general circulation in each place in which the Company generally conducts business pursuant to Alaska Stat. § 10.50.440.

8.5 Filing of Articles of Dissolution. If the Company is dissolved, Articles of Dissolution may be filed with the State of Alaska as provided for in the Act.

ARTICLE IX MISCELLANEOUS

9.1 Notices. All notices or other communications required or permitted hereunder shall be in writing and shall be deemed received by the party to whom addressed when delivered to such party, or when posted if sent by certified mail with postage prepaid, or three business days after posting in the regular United States mail, in each case directed to the party for whom intended at the address of such party then on file with the Company.

9.2 Binding Effect. This Agreement shall be binding upon the estate, legal representative, heirs, devisees, successors, and assigns of the Members and Manager.

9.3 Not for Benefit of Creditors. None of the provisions of this Agreement shall be for the benefit of or enforceable by any creditor of the Company or of any Member.

9.4 Partial Invalidity. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be invalid or unenforceable, all other provisions shall nevertheless continue in full force and effect.

9.5 Amendment. Amendments to this Agreement shall only be made by a writing signed by all of the Members.

9.6 Applicable Law. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Alaska.

9.7 Waiver of Partition. Each Member agrees that irreparable damage would be done to the Company if any Member brought an action in court to dissolve the Company. Therefore, each Member agrees not to, either directly or indirectly, take any action to require partition of the Company or of any of the assets or properties of the Company. The Members accept the provisions of this Agreement as the sole source of entitlement on termination, dissolution or liquidation of the Company and hereby irrevocably waives any and all right to maintain any action for partition or to compel any sale or other liquidation with respect to his Interest, in or with respect to, any assets or properties of the Company.

9.8 Non-Waiver. The failure of any Member to insist upon strict performance of a covenant hereunder or of any obligation hereunder, irrespective of the length of time for which such failure continues, shall not be a waiver of such Member's right to demand strict compliance in the future. No consent or waiver, expressed or implied, to or of any breach or default in the performance of any obligation hereunder, shall constitute a consent or waiver to or of any other breach or default in the performance of the same or any other obligation hereunder.

9.9 Counterparts. This agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original but all of which shall constitute one and the same instrument.
