



Aurora Blaze, LLC (License #12328) received a Notice of Violation (AMCO Case #AB 18-000739) on June 1, 2018 for "finishing" 141 harvest batches in Metrc and over reporting waste weights. This was due to a misunderstanding that Investigator Stonecipher has since cleared up for us. In the harvest tab of Metrc the "Moisture Loss" category is actually called "Weight". This confused our staff, because the weight numbers in that section didn't match the actual weights we were getting off every strain per harvest. In an effort to fix what we thought was wrong we wasted out the numbers in the "weight" category. Investigator Stonecipher also let us know that harvests shouldn't be "finished" until every package from a harvest has been sold, so we won't finish anymore harvests until all product is sold from now on. Regarding the 41 harvest batches that were never tested (due to the small size of each batch amount), those harvests took place before we were properly keeping track of our waste weights and reporting them to AMCO. In the month of May, Aurora Blaze received an NOV for our improper reporting of marijuana plant waste and corrective actions were immediately performed. All waste is now labeled and stored in one area of the building for a minimum of three (3) days under direct camera surveillance. Waste logs are sent to AMCO on a weekly basis to remain in compliance.

I did a preliminary analysis of the mishap that occurred with properly receiving the two referenced manifests and the errors had not been brought to my attention by our manager. I instantly realized the mistakes that were made and that my manager failed in notifying AMCO or METRC about the accidental failure to promptly receive these manifests when they were actually delivered to our facility. I had a long and thorough discussion with my manager about the importance of these issues and I have already implemented a new policy with redundancy to alleviate any future possibility of failing to receive the manifests properly.

This is what was done to correct the errors made by my manager and my failure to ensure the redundancy of properly reporting and fixing any errors made when receiving deliveries in METRC. Since the errors, I have been observing and monitoring our new process and it seems to be working very well and will never happen again under this protocol and management.

Thanks for the chance to correct these mistakes and improve my operations.

On 4/17/2018 Nathan DAVIS, designated licensee from Green Life Supply LLC, retail marijuana store license #11927, contacted AMCO Enforcement to self-report a problem with his premises' point of sale software (MJ Platform) not reporting sales into METRC since early March. DAVIS reported since opening the store on 03/02/2018 he began noticing the cash register till and the end of day sales reports were not matching up. DAVIS stated from the employee's perspective sales appeared to be recording properly and the point of sale gave no indication to the user that the sale was not actually recording. Upon further review he discovered the point of sale software was not properly reporting the sales into the state's mandatory marijuana tracking system, METRC. DAVIS said he attempted to work with the point of sale software company, MJ Freeway, to resolve the reporting discrepancy.

DAVIS attempted to resolve the issue by working with MJ Freeway. After not being able to resolve the reporting discrepancy with MJ Freeway he began working nights programming a new point of sale system. DAVIS closed the store, inventoried all marijuana and marijuana product in the store, cross referenced the inventory with METRC and found the inventory was off. At this point DAVIS contacted AMCO Enforcement to self-report the issue and worked with AMCO Enforcement to implement a plan to correct the problem. DAVIS did not reopen the store until 04/20/2018 after correcting the inventory discrepancy and implementing the new point of sale software system.

Due to the software deficiency each transaction from the marijuana retail store's original point of sale system was not reconciled at the close of each business day with the marijuana inventory tracking system from when the store opened in early March to when the store was closed to conduct an inventory audit in mid-April.





Speaking with James and Giono Barret, owners of Rainforest Farms, LLC they thought that was how to report waste from a retail store. James informed me it was all wasted and disposed of. I requested the video from the office where the waste was to take place.

Upon entering in the office it was apparent the camera had been moved and I was unable to see where the waste took place.

Upon review video of May 27, 2018 0600 hours, I observed James Barrett taking cash out of the safe and what appears to be him counting the cash and placing it in a suitcase. I did not observe any waste being placed in the suitcase. James walks out of the office approximately three minutes later with two suitcases and a satchel.

On 06/07/2018 I met with James Barrett at Rainforest Farm retail. James informed me he made a mistake in an excel formula and had misreported sales amounts for the last 2 1/2 months. He was instructed to work with METRC to fix the issue.

In response to the NOV, received I will do my best to clarify what has happened in this situation.

The Error Package Adjustment report received by AMCO was due to simple entry error.

As we purchase bulk flower product, it is brought to our store an packaged. After it is packaged, the weight packaged is deducted from the bulk weight packaged which gives us the amount that should be entered into METRC as "waste, scale variance, or drying loss".

For example, if 450 grams are purchased, roughly 400 grams will be packaged and sold to consumers, 10 - 25 grams will be loss due to drying, 10-20 from scale variances, many stems will be also be removed (5-15 grams) and then there is unsaleable trim leftover. This amount usually accumulates to roughly 50 grams per pound of bulk product. After we package bulk products, the packaged weight then gets deducted from original amount and is therefore calculated as the waste. This calculated waste is separate from the physical waste leftover after packaging. All of the physical leftover is mixed with sand and placed in the waste area which is then saved until it is ready to leave the building for waste.

The footage on May 27th does not show the weight inside the waste accumulated in the suitcase because it has accumulated over the course of time. Video footage shows James Barrett taking the waste out of premises but does not show it accumulate over time. Waste is entered into METRC as it leaves the building but accumulates in waste area over time.

In effort to ensure waste is disposed of properly, we usually dispose of waste about once per month. This also creates a more efficient and accurate way to track waste - rather than try to track several packages wasted every day - which can get messy - we like to let them accumulate and then move them all at once for cleaner and easier tracking entries in to METRC.

Apparently waste had accidentally entered as "in house quality control" when it should have been entered as "waste". This was done out of error and should have been entered simply as "waste" in METRC. In the future, this will not happen again and we will make sure these entries are more carefully entered to avoid these types of mistakes.



The obstruction of video footage was due to items being placed in front of the camera. This was an accident made by employees whom did not realise that setting items in front of the camera would obstruct view. We have since moved the items blocking the camera view. Furthermore, we are in the process of changing our security plans to have more video footage coverage so that this situation does not occur or repeat itself.

ACTIONS TO REMEDY NOV:

- 1. Rainforest Farms will further train staff to enter waste correctly and more accurately. More specifically, staff will be trained to know the differences of types of waste entries and how they should be inputted properly. This will ensure the compliance of 3 AAC 306.310 and 3 AAC 306-330.
- 2. Rainforest Farms has informed staff to make sure never to place items in front of video cameras. This will ensure that the requirements of 3 AAC 306.720 has been met.
- 3. Rainforest Farms will file form MJ-14 to add extra cameras in the facility. This will prevent any video obstruction in the future even in the case of accidental obstruction. This will ensure that the requirements of 3 AAC 306.720 has been met.

It is our hope that we can work with AMCO closely on this issue to make sure that it is not only resolved, but will never happen again. We understand the importance of reporting requirements not only for compliance reasons but also for the efficiency of our own operations.

We have been working with AMCO Investigators on this issue and are hoping to rectify any apparent wrongdoing in any way possible.

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



Dear MCB and Enforcement Team:

On July 18th, 2018, my client Kyle Denton, designated licensee for AK Frost, received the NOV number referenced above. The NOV is essentially stating that there was an unreported change of ownership for this license, which would be a violation under 3 AAC 306.040, if this change was a non-controlling ownership change, or 3AAC 306.045 for a major controlling change in ownership.

AK Frost is undergoing ownership restructuring - a group of Alaskan business folks have negotiated to buy less than 50% of an entity named Blackstone Investments, LLC. The concept is that Blackstone Investments will be buying 100% of AK Frost, and Blackstone Investments membership majority is held and owned by the original licensees of this license, David McConnell and Kyle Denton, with Kyle remaining as the manager of the entity.

As you know, our regulations may seem a bit foreign to persons who are not entrenched in this industry and who have not been following the changes to the regulations or do not have that much experience with our regulatory scheme. Therefore, when the group of investors hired a great business attorney to help them with the negotiation and memorialization of said purchase of interest and overall game plan to restructure these entities, a couple assumptions were made about the marijuana specific requirements for transferring ownership of a marijuana license, which lead to the premature filing of the notice of change of officials.

Initially, because the natural persons who originally were the only two licensees for AK Frost (Kyle and Dave) still would hold majority interest of the entity owning the license, Kyle and Dave thought they could do the change of ownership report under 3 AAC 306.040 within ten (10) days for a non-controlling ownership change report. The attorney for the investor group went ahead and filed the notice of changes of officials for AK Frost, replacing Kyle and Dave as owners and adding

Blackstone Investments as the sole owner. See attached change of ownership report filed May 4th, 2018.

During the review of the renewal process, my office worked with Jane Sawyer (AMCO plan reviewer) to come up with a method to "undo" the change of ownership back to the original ownership structure, in order to comply with 3AAC 306.045 and we are now in the process of compiling a controlling change of ownership application, which once completed, will be submitted to AMCO for review and later for MCB hearing review. My office personally walked the Notice of Change (to revert the ownership change) to the Anchorage Corporation Commissions Office to obtain a stamped, received version, to prove to the AMCO review team that the ownership was being reverted, to correct the premature filling of the notice of change of officials. See attached stamped notice of change of officials.

The definition of controlling change in interest is not in the regulations and was defined in an MCB board action and therefore, unless a person is really paying attention to our industry and our meetings, it would be a really tough call to determine what the proper change in ownership regulation applied to the situation. It is a completely understandable misunderstanding and there was no change in the business operations from how the company has always been managed – no other persons other than Kyle and Dave have been operating control of the business, the license, or the finances.

We appreciate Jane Sawyer's help with this matter and this license is now in good standing. The licensees now understand the proper steps that need to occur prior to a transfer in controlling ownership.



Dear MCB and Enforcement Team:

On July 18th, 2018, my client Kyle Denton, designated licensee for Isidore LLC, received the NOV number referenced above. The NOV is essentially stating that there was an unreported change of ownership for this license, which would be a violation under 3 AAC 306.040, if this change was a non-controlling ownership change, or 3AAC 306.045 for a major controlling change in ownership.

Isidore is undergoing ownership restructuring - a group of Alaskan business folks have negotiated to buy less than 50% of an entity named Blackstone Investments, LLC. The concept is that Blackstone Investments will be buying 100% of Isidore LLC, and Blackstone Investments membership majority is held and owned by the original licensees of this license, David McConnell and Kyle Denton, with Kyle remaining as the manager of the entity.

As you know, our regulations may seem a bit foreign to persons who are not entrenched in this industry and who have not been following the changes to the regulations or do not have that much experience with our regulatory scheme. Therefore, when the group of investors hired a great business attorney to help them with the negotiation and memorialization of said purchase of interest and overall game plan to restructure these entities, a couple assumptions were made about the marijuana specific requirements for transferring ownership of a marijuana license, which lead to the premature filing of the notice of change of officials.

Initially, because the natural persons who originally were the only two licensees for Isidore (Kyle and Dave) still would hold majority interest of the entity owning the license, Kyle and Dave thought they could do the change of ownership report under 3 AAC 306.040 within ten (10) days for a non-controlling ownership change report. The attorney for the investor group went ahead and filed the notice of changes of officials for Isidore, replacing Kyle and Dave as owners and adding

Blackstone Investments as the sole owner. See attached change of ownership report filed May 4th, 2018.

During the review of the renewal process, my office worked with Jane Sawyer (AMCO plan reviewer) to come up with a method to "undo" the change of ownership back to the original ownership structure, in order to comply with 3AAC 306.045 and we are now in the process of compiling a controlling change of ownership application, which once completed, will be submitted to AMCO for review and later for MCB hearing review. My office personally walked the Notice of Change (to revert the ownership change) to the Anchorage Corporation Commissions Office to obtain a stamped, received version, to prove to the AMCO review team that the ownership was being reverted, to correct the premature filling of the notice of change of officials. See attached stamped notice of change of officials.

The definition of controlling change in interest is not in the regulations and was defined in an MCB board action and therefore, unless a person is really paying attention to our industry and our meetings, it would be a really tough call to determine what the proper change in ownership regulation applied to the situation. It is a completely understandable misunderstanding and there was no change in the business operations from how the company has always been managed – no other persons other than Kyle and Dave have been operating control of the business, the license, or the finances.

We appreciate Jane Sawyer's help with this matter and this license is now in good standing. The licensees now understand the proper steps that need to occur prior to a transfer in controlling ownership.
