FROM: Jane P. Sawyer, Regulations Specialist RE: Regulations Project – Video
Surveillance – power backup

At the April 2022 meeting, the board opened a regulations project to require a marijuana establishment's video surveillance recording system have power backup. Attached is initial draft for board discussion.

There are many types of power backup products out there. So, as to not be restrictive, this draft simply adds the requirement of a marijuana establishment having backup power supply to support a minimum of one hour of recording time in the event of power interruption. Enforcement was okay with this draft.

Potential options for board:

- Put out for public comment
- Amend and put out for public comment
- Send back to staff for revisions
- Close the project

(Words in boldface and underlined indicate language being added; words [CAPITALIZED AND BRACKETED] indicate language being deleted.)

3 AAC 306.720(a) is amended to read:

(a) A marijuana establishment shall install and maintain a video surveillance [AND CAMERA] recording system as provided in this section. The video **surveillance recording** system must [COVER]

(1) **cover** each restricted access area and each entrance to a restricted access area within the licensed premises; **each entrance to the exterior of the licensed premises; each point-of-sale area; and**

(2) **have backup power supply to support a minimum of one hour of recording time in the event of power interruption** [EACH ENTRANCE TO THE EXTERIOR OF THE LICENSED PREMISES; AND

(3) EACH POINT-OF-SALE AREA].
