INSTRUCTIONS FOR STATEMENT OF DOMESTICATION *(Please retain for your records):*

IMPORTANT:

This form is to be used only if the foreign (non-Alaskan) business corporation (listed in Item # 2 on the Statement of Domestication) will continue to be doing business in Alaska.

If the domesticated foreign business corporation will not be doing business in Alaska, then you must use form 08-601, A Domestic (Alaskan) Entity Domesticating to an Unqualified Foreign (Non-Alaskan) Entity Not Conducting Business in Alaska.

NOTICE: The Statement of Domestication will not be filed if a biennial report is due. Please verify the following for the domesticating entity before completing the application:

- Is the qualified entity (on record with this division) in "Good Standing" status?
- Have all required biennial reports been filed?
- Are the officials on record correct, current and up to date? *(Used to verify signatures for this filing.)*
- Is the Registered Agent information on record correct, current and up to date?

To verify the above information you may search for the entity by going to the above website, click License Search and under Search License Data select Corporations.

- If there is a biennial report due, it may be filed online (for immediate posting) by selecting Biennial Reports on the above website.
- If the officials have changed and there is no biennial report due then please submit a Notice of Change of Officials located on the above website under Forms and Fees. Select the appropriate version based on your entity type.
- If the Registered Agent information needs to be updated please submit a Statement of Change located on the above website under Forms and Fees. Select the appropriate version based on your entity type.

WHAT IS A DOMESTICATION?

Domestication (moving from a different jurisdiction or home state to a new jurisdiction or home state) means a transaction authorized by AS 10.55.501-10.55.506, with the exception of the entities excluded under AS 10.55.110. Under this:

- A domestic (Alaskan) business corporation may become a foreign (non-Alaskan) business corporation in a foreign jurisdiction if the domestication is authorized by the law of the foreign jurisdiction.

NOTICE: The Statement of Domestication must be filed in conjunction with Certificate of Authority (attached to this form) for a Foreign (non-Alaskan) Business Corporation (which will continue to conduct business in Alaska after the domestication) and the applicable \$150.00 fee (which is already included in the above stated filing fees).

ITEM 1: Provide the domesticating (moving from) domestic (Alaskan) business corporation name (which is moving from Alaska to a different jurisdiction). (Note: the entity type in Item #1 must match the entity type in Item #2.)

ITEM 2: Provide the domesticated (moving to) foreign (non-Alaskan) business corporation name (which will continue to conduct business in Alaska after the domestication) and the domesticated (foreign) jurisdiction. (Note: the entity type in Item #2 must match the entity type in Item #1.)

- A business corporate name must contain the word "corporation," "company," "incorporated," or "limited," or an abbreviation of one of these words.
- The corporate name may not contain a word or phrase that indicates or implies that the corporation is organized for a purpose other than the purpose contained in its articles of incorporation.
- A corporate name must be distinguishable upon the record. To search the availability of the legal name of the corporation in the State of Alaska go to the above website, click License Search, and select Search Corporations Database.
- **NOTE:** the name of the business corporation in Item #2 on the Statement of Domestication must match Item #1 in the Certificate of Authority attached to this filing.

ITEM 3: (Optional) The future effective date of domestication, if different from date of filing, must be a specific future date and cannot exceed 90 days from date of filing. Future effective date (mm/dd/yyyy format).

ITEM 4: This statement is required by statute. Please read through and verify.

ITEM 5: The domesticated (moving to) entity (listed in Item #2 on the Statement of Domestication) is a foreign (non-Alaskan) business corporation, which will continue to be conducting business in Alaska as a foreign business corporation after the domestication, must complete the attached Certificate of Authority portion of this form.

ITEM 6: The Statement of Domestication must be signed on behalf of the domesticating (moving from) entity (listed in Item #1 on the Statement of Domestication) in the following manner:

- If the domesticating entity is a corporation, it must be signed by an officer of the corporation.
- If the domesticating entity is not a corporation, it must be signed by the person authorized by the entity.
- If the domesticating entity is in the hands of a receiver, trustee, or other court-appointed fiduciary, it must be signed by the fiduciary.

If the domesticating entity is currently on record with this division (has an AK Entity Number) and the signer is an official of the entity then the signer must be currently on record with this division.

Provide the printed name of the signer, the full title/capacity of the authorized signer, the name of the business corporation that the individual is representing, and signature of the individual authorized to sign.

NOTE - Signatures:

Per AS 10.55.609, persons who sign documents to be filed with the commissioner that are known by the person to be false in material respects are guilty of a class A misdemeanor.

NOTE: Plan of Domestication –OR- Statement of Domestication

Do not send both together. Submit either the Statement of Domestication **OR** the plan of domestication that is signed on behalf of all entities and contains all the information required to be in the Statement of Domestication and is delivered to the Division for filing after the plan has been adopted and approved by all merging entities. Sending both the plan of domestication and the Statement of Domestication together may cause delays in processing time.

IMPORTANT:

This form is to be used only if the foreign (non-Alaskan) business corporation (listed in Item # 2 on the Statement of Domestication) will continue to be doing business in Alaska. If the converted foreign business corporation will not be doing business in Alaska, then you must use form 08-601, Any Domestic (Alaskan) Entity Converting to an Unqualified Domestic (Alaskan) or Foreign (Non-Alaskan) Entity Not Conducting Business in Alaska.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY

These instructions are specific for the Certificate of Authority which must be attached to the Statement of Domestication (form 08-592)

ARTICLE 1: Name of Corporation

Provided the name of the foreign (non-Alaskan) business corporation:

- A business corporate name must contain the word "corporation," "company," "incorporated," or "limited," or an abbreviation of one of these words.
- The business corporate name may not contain a word or phrase that indicates or implies that the corporation is organized for a purpose other than the purpose contained in its articles of incorporation.
- A business corporate name must be distinguishable upon the record. To search the availability of the legal name of the business corporation in the State of Alaska go to the above website, click License Search, and select Search Corporations Database.
- **NOTE:** The name of the business corporation in Item #1 in the Certificate of Authority must match the name in Item #2 on Statement of Domestication portion of this filing.

The business corporation must be in good standing in their state of domicile, before we can issue a certificate of authority, please check the box to confirm the business corporation is in good standing/compliance in their state of domicile. Note: as proof, the division may ask for a certificate of good standing/compliance, less than 60 days old, from the state of domicile.

ITEM 2: Assumed Name

The name the business corporation elects to use if the name in the state of domicile is already in use by another entity in Alaska. ITEM 3: State of Domicile, Date of Incorporation, Duration

Indicate the state of domicile, or “home state”; date of incorporation in the state of domicile (mm/dd/yyyy format); and the duration.

Duration is the life expectancy of the corporation in Alaska.

- It may be a specific future date of less than 100 years.
- If there is no expected end date, select the “perpetual” box, indicating the corporation plans to transact business uninterrupted for an undeterminable amount of time.

ITEM 4: Disclosure of Corporate Purposes

- The purpose describes activities of the corporation at the time of filing and may include “any lawful.”
- In addition to purpose, also include the NAICS code where indicated. NAICS code may not conflict with the purpose listed. For a complete list of NAICS codes go to the above website and select NAICS Codes.

ITEM 5: Registered agent information:

The registered agent for the foreign (Alaskan) business corporation (listed in item #1 on the Certificate of Authority) is the same agent on record for the domesticating (moving from) entity (listed in Item #1 on the Statement of Domestication). Per Alaska Statutes the registered agent information may only be updated via a Statement of Change Registered Agent form. The non-refundable filing fee for a Statement of Change is \$25. The appropriate Statement of Change form, based on entity type, can be found on the above website and select Forms and Fees.

ITEM 6: Principal Office Address

ITEM 7: Alien Affiliate

ITEM 8: Authorized Shares

All for-profit business corporations must provide the number of authorized shares – the maximum number of shares that a corporation is legally permitted to issue.

- Zero (0) is not an acceptable number for the quantity of authorized shares.
- If there is more than one class or series of authorized shares, please provide this information.
- Par value is the nominal value or dollar value of the original cost of a share and has no relation to market value.
