MINUTES OF TELECONFERENCE MEETING December 14, 2004

Tuesday, December 14, 2004

Item 1 Call to Order/Roll Call

The meeting was called to order by Steve Tarola, Chairperson, at 11:02 a.m. There were present, constituting a quorum:

Item 2 Public Comment

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Ms. Corrine Eagle thanked the board for conducting a teleconference to reconsider her application for licensure as a CPA. The board failed to take action on Ms. Eagle's application at its September 29-October 1, 2004 board meeting because they could not determine that she had the equivalent of an accounting concentration with her bachelor's degree. Following the board meeting, Ms. Eagle was mistakenly sent a letter informing her that the board had denied her application and she was given her appeal rights, which she took advantage of.

The matter was assigned to Assistant Attorney General Gayle Horetski and was brought before Hearing Officer Stebing. Upon discovering later that Ms. Eagle's application had not actually been denied, the matter was remanded to the board by stipulation between the parties. This teleconference was scheduled upon the request of Ms. Eagle to resolve the matter.

The board recognized, based on a course syllabus, that Ms. Eagle did indeed have an accounting concentration. Sandra Wilson apologized and told Ms. Eagle that the board had not been able to discern her application had been complete at the September/October board meeting.

Item 3 Application Review

On a motion duly made by Marjorie Kaiser, seconded by Max Mertz, and approved unanimously, it was

RESOLVED to approve the application for CPA licensure of Corrine Eagle.

Ms. Eagle thanked the board.

On another matter Ms. Horetski asked the board its status on signing the Public Company Accounting Oversight Board (PCAOB) agreement.

Ms. Cintra told Ms. Horetski that the board had not yet reviewed the information but will do so at the next board meeting tentatively scheduled for January 27-28, 2005.

Ms. Horestki informed the board that she had researched the matter and that it is okay for the board to sign the agreement.

Ms. Horetski left the meeting at 11:10 a.m.

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Item 4 <u>Regulations - Commissions & Contingent Fees</u> Jun Maiquis, Regulations Specialist joined the meeting at 11:10 a.m.

On a motion duly made by Sandy Wilson, seconded by Marjorie Kaiser, and approved unanimously, it was

RESOLVED to ask the Regulations Specialist to public notice the draft regulations for 12 AAC 04.030 Contingent fees and 12 AAC 04.100 Commissions.

Marjorie Kaiser informed the board that the Alaska Society of Certified Public Accountants has drafted a resolution in support of these regulation changes.

There was no time to discuss the Regional Directors' Focus Questions with the board. Mr. Tarola had drafted responses to the questions and will email them to Ms. Cintra. Ms. Cintra will then in turn forward the questions on to board members for their input, which will then be forwarded on to Mr. Tarola.
