ACCUSATION AND ORDER OF REVOCATION

 On July 31, 2023, the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development, Division of Insurance (Division) received an application for an Insurance Producer license to transact the business of Property and Casualty lines of authority for STEPHEN HITE (HITE), domiciled in the State of Virginia.

 HITE's application was automatically processed as all background questions were answered "no". The Division issued license number 3002636949 which has an expiration date of October 31, on even numbered years.

 On August 24, 2023, the Division received correspondence from LaTanya Jackson of Marsh McLennan, authorized submitter for HITE. Included in STEPHEN HITE Accusation and Order of Revocation SR24-11

4	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, under the provisions of AS 21.27.440, that STEPHEN

7	HITE's Insurance Producer license number 3002636949 is REVOKED for a period of
8	one year.
