STIPULATED AGREEMENT AND ORDER

The Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development,
Division of Insurance (Division) and **EMILY SMALLWOOD** (**SMALLWOOD**) the producer
in this case, stipulate and agree to the following:

I. BACKGROUND

A. On April 25, 2018, the Division received an application for a Travel Insurance Limited Producer license to transact the business of Travel lines of authority for SMALLWOOD, domiciled in the State of Nebraska. The application was automatically processed, and the Division issued

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nonresident license number 100159384 which has an expiration date of December 31 of odd numbered years.

- B. On November 16, 2023, the Division received a renewal application from SMALLWOOD. In that renewal application, SMALLWOOD requested to add Insurance Producer license to transact Property and Casualty lines of authority. In the same renewal application SMALLWOOD responded affirmatively to background question 1A, indicating she has criminal history to disclose to the Division.
- C. During review, it was discovered that SMALLWOOD attached documentation of misdemeanor convictions in the Attachment Warehouse. This documentation revealed that SMALLWOOD has a misdemeanor conviction in the State of Nebraska effective December 10, 2016.
 SMALLWOOD incorrectly responded negatively to background question 1 at initial application indicating no criminal conviction to report to the Division, providing inaccurate information at initial application.

II. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

A. **SMALLWOOD** was in violation for failing to report her misdemeanor to the Division which subjects **SMALLWOOD** to civil penalties. Alaska Statute (AS) 21.27.440(a) provides that "in addition to any other penalties provided by law, a person that the director (director) determines under AS 21.06.170-21.06.240 has violated the provisions of this chapter is subject to (1) a civil penalty equal to the compensation promised, paid, or to be paid, directly or indirectly, to a person in

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regard to each violation; (2) either a civil penalty of not more than \$10,000 for each violation or a civil penalty of not more than \$25,000 for each violation if the director determines that the person willfully violated the provisions of this chapter; and (3) denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license." The director has the latitude to impose civil penalties against a person who has violated Alaska's insurance laws.

- B. AS 21.27.020(a) provides: "For the protection of the people of this state, the director may not issue or renew a license except in compliance with this chapter and not issue a license to a person, or to be exercised by a person, found by the director to be untrustworthy, incompetent, or who has not established to the satisfaction of the director that the person is qualified under this chapter."
- C. AS 21.27.020(b)(4) provides: "To qualify for issuance or renewal of an individual license, an applicant or licensee shall (4) be a trustworthy person."
- D. AS 21.27.040(a) states that "(a) Application for a license shall be made to the director upon forms prescribed by the director. As a part of or in connection with the application, the applicant shall furnish information concerning the applicant's identity, personal history, experience, business record, purposes, and other pertinent facts that the director may reasonably require. The applicant shall declare, subject to penalty of denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license issued by the director, that the statements made in or in connection with the application are true,
