



1 E. As part of the filing requirements to reinstate the firm's license, Hausch provided a  
2 notarized statement to the division indicating whether any business had been transacted while the  
3 firm was not appropriately licensed. This statement indicated that one policy was written  
4 between May 10, 2021, and June 23, 2021, with \$819.00 earned in compensation. These  
5 transactions subject Hausch to civil penalties under AS 21.27.440.  
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
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8 II. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

- 9 1. Hausch agrees to pay a civil penalty under AS 21.27.440 in the amount of \$819.00 for  
10 the activity that occurred while the firm license was lapsed with \$409.50 suspended. The  
11 unsuspended penalty of \$409.50 is payable at the time you are notified that the director  
12 has approved the formal agreement.
- 13 2. In the event Hausch violates Alaska insurance laws during the next two years, the  
14 suspended portion of the penalty referenced in paragraph one will be reinstated. Hausch  
15 will be subject to any and all sanctions authorized by the insurance laws including  
16 imposition of additional penalties.
- 17 3. By signing this agreement, Hausch understands and agrees that any failure to comply  
18 with the conditions of this agreement will be grounds to revoke, suspend, or not renew  
19 Alaska firm license number 100115682.
- 20 4. Hausch understands that this agreement is not binding on the parties unless and until the  
21 director signs the order approving the agreement.  
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


