**ORDER OF REVOCATION**

1. On or about September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2019, the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development, Division of Insurance (division) issued a non-resident Independent Adjuster and Independent Portable Electronics Adjuster License, license number 100181645, to engage in the business of insurance to **BRUCE LEIGHTON**, domiciled in the State of Arkansas.
2. On October 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022, the Producer Licensing & Oversight Program Manager of Washington sent correspondence to the State of Alaska that **BRUCE LEIGHTON** had relocated to Washington from the state of Alaska. They also reported **BRUCE LEIGHTON** had been living and

engaging in the business of insurance in Alaska as a non-resident for three years, having relocated to Alaska from Arkansas in 2019.

- 3. During the period that **BRUCE LEIGHTON** was residing in Alaska, but licensed as a resident in Arkansas, he renewed his non-resident Alaska license twice.
- 4. On October 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022, division staff reviewed **BRUCE LEIGHTON's** license status. Division staff found his resident license in Arkansas was no longer active. Division staff corresponded to **BRUCE LEIGHTON** informing him his lack of a resident license removed the basis for his reciprocal license in Alaska.
- 5. On October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022, **BRUCE LEIGHTON** responded to the division staff's inquiry about his resident license. He confirmed the findings of Washington's investigation that he had been residing in Alaska and admitted to renewing his licenses with false information.
- 6. The division is revoking both the Independent Adjuster and Independent Portable Electronic licenses for violation of AS 21.27.025, which states in part that, "(a) A licensee shall notify the director in writing not later than 30 days after a change in residence, place of business..." The division has authority revoke under AS 21.27.025(b) which states that "(b) In addition to any other penalty provided by law, a failure to notify the director as required by this section is cause for denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license."

7. The division is revoking **BRUCE LEIGHTON'S** licenses pursuant to AS 21.27.025(b) which states that "In addition to any other penalty provided by law, a failure to notify the director as required by this section is cause for denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license."

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**, under the provisions of AS 21.27.025, that **BRUCE LEIGHTON's** Independent Adjuster & Independent Portable Electronics Adjuster license 100181645 are revoked for a period of one year.
