STIPULATED AGREEMENT AND ORDER

The Division of Insurance (division) and Hartford Fire Insurance Company. (Hartford), the licensee in this case, stipulate and agree that the failure to timely renew the third party administrator (TPA) registration #15262 and the unlicensed activity that occurred during the time the registration was in lapse status are resolved as follows:

1. Hartford admits that, while its Alaska TPA registration was in lapse status between April 1999 and February 2000, the firm transacted the business of insurance, in violation of AS 21.27.630(a).
2. Prior to this instance, Hartford has never allowed its Alaska TPA registration to lapse and, to the division's knowledge, the firm had not engaged in unlicensed activity.
3. Hartford agrees to pay a civil penalty under AS 21.27.440(a) of \$4,573.21 for the unlicensed activity that occurred between April 1999 and February 2000, with \$1,000 suspended. The unsuspended portion of the penalty is due at the time this agreement and order is signed by the director.

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4. Regardless whether Hartford maintains its TPA registration, in the event Hartford violates the insurance code or applicable regulations regarding third party administrators during the next two years, the suspended portion of the fine referenced in paragraph 3 will be reinstated. Hartford and its compliance officer also will be subject to any and all sanctions authorized by the insurance code including imposition of additional fines or penalties.

5. By signing this agreement, Hartford understands and agrees that any failure to comply with the conditions of this agreement will be grounds to revoke, suspend, or not renew Alaska TPA registration #15262.

6. Hartford understands that this agreement is not binding on the parties unless and until the director signs the order approving the agreement.






