## STIPULATED AGREEMENT AND ORDER

The State of Alaska Division of Insurance (division) and Empathy Claims Inc (EMPATHY CLAIMS), the producer in this case, stipulate and agree to the following:

#### I. BACKGROUND

- A. On February 26<sup>th</sup>, 2020, EMPATHY CLAIMS received their initial Insurance Producer license with Casualty, and Property lines of authority, license # 3000798953, authorizing EMPATHY CLAIMS to transact insurance business in Alaska. This license expired February 26<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
- B. On February 26<sup>th</sup>, 2022, the license expired for failure to renew.

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- C. On March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022, the renewal application for EMPATHY CLAIMS was received by the division.
- D. On March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022, the division provided EMPATHY CLAIMS with instructions on how to reinstate the license. In order to reinstate, the division required a Business Transaction Form and a delayed renewal fee for failing to renew timely.
- E. On April 21st, 2022, the division provided EMPATHY CLAIMS with a second set of instructions on how to reinstate the license.
- F. On June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022, Ryan Reeves of EMPATHY CLAIMS provided a notarized business transaction form to the division detailing two claims adjusted while the license was expired. These two claims generated a total of \$9,407 in compensation for EMPATHY CLAIMS.
- G. On June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2022, a letter was issued to EMPATHY CLAIMS assessing a civil penalty in the amount of \$9,407 with \$4,703 suspended. The unsuspended penalty of \$4,703 is payable to the division.
- H. On July 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022, EMPATHY CLAIMS responded to the Division's request to move forward and enter into a formal agreement to pay the civil penalty of \$4,703.

#### II. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

A. The two claims adjusted between 2/26/22 and 6/1/22, prior to the license issuance date were in violation of AS 21.27.440 which subjects EMPATHY CLAIMS to civil penalties. AS 21.27.440(a) provides that "in addition to any other penalties

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provided by law, a person that the director of the division (director) determines under AS 21.06.170-21.06.240 has violated the provisions of this chapter is subject to (1) a civil penalty equal to the compensation promised, paid, or to be paid, directly or indirectly, to a person in regard to each violation; (2) either a civil penalty of not more than \$10,000 for each violation or a civil penalty of not more than \$25,000 for each violation if the director determines that the person willfully violated the provisions of this chapter; and (3) denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license." The director has the latitude to impose civil penalties against a person who has violated Alaska's insurance laws

- B. EMPATHY CLAIMS agrees to pay the civil penalty under AS 21.27.440 in the amount of \$9,407 for activity that occurred prior to the issuance of the firm license with \$4,703 suspended.
- C. In the event EMPATHY CLAIMS violates Alaska insurance laws during the next two years, the suspended portion of the penalty referenced in paragraph one will be reinstated. EMPATHY CLAIMS will be subject to any and all sanctions authorized by the insurance laws including imposition of additional penalties regarding any such violation.
- D. By signing this agreement, EMPATHY CLAIMS understands and agrees that any failure to comply with the conditions of this agreement will be grounds to revoke, suspend, or not renew Alaska firm license 3000798953.
- E. EMPATHY CLAIMS understands that this agreement is not binding on the parties unless and until the director signs the order approving the agreement.
