## STIPULATED AGREEMENT AND ORDER

The State of Alaska Division of Insurance (division) and Alliant Insurance Services Houston, LLC (AISH, LLC), the producer in this case, stipulate and agree to the following:

## I. BACKGROUND

A. On April $13^{\text {th }}, 2004$, AISH, LLC received their initial Insurance Producer and Surplus Lines broker license \# 38254, authorizing AISH, LLC to transact insurance business in Alaska.
B. On April $20^{\text {th }}, 2022$, the Surplus Lines Broker license expired for failure to provide the required documentation of administrative actions taken by other states and failure to pay a delayed notification fee.
C. On August $1^{\text {st }}, 2022$, the division received all required documentation of administrative actions to reinstate the license. The Surplus Lines Broker license was reinstated.
D. In a routine internal audit performed in July of 2022, it was discovered that AISH, LLC had sold policies while their license was expired.
E. On August $25^{\text {th }}, 2022$, notice was sent to AISH, LLC informing them of the division's audit that revealed policies posted before initial licensure. This notice requested a Business Transaction Form verifying any additional business that may have been placed prior to licensure in the state of Alaska.
F. On August $31^{\text {st }}, 2022$, Dennis Burden of AISH, LLC provided a Business Transaction Form to the division. This form indicated one policy was sold prior to reinstatement generating a commission of $\$ 8,761.50$.
G. On September $6^{\text {th }}$, 2022, a proposed agreement was issued to AISH, LLC assessing a civil penalty in the amount of $\$ 8,761$ with $\$ 4,380$ suspended. The unsuspended penalty of $\$ 4,380$ is payable to the division.
H. On September $7^{\text {th }}, 2022$, AISH, LLC responded to the Division's request to move forward and enter into a formal agreement to pay the civil penalty of $\$ 4,380$.

## II. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

A. The policy sold prior to the license issuance date on May $6^{\text {th }}, 2022$, was in violation of AS 21.27.440 which subjects AISH, LLC to civil penalties. AS 21.27.440(a) provides that "in addition to any other penalties provided by law, a person that the director of the division (director) determines under AS 21.06.17021.06.240 has violated the provisions of this chapter is subject to (1) a civil penalty equal to the compensation promised, paid, or to be paid, directly or indirectly, to a person in regard to each violation; (2) either a civil penalty of not more than $\$ 10,000$ for each violation or a civil penalty of not more than $\$ 25,000$ for each violation if the director determines that the person willfully violated the provisions of this chapter; and (3) denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license." The director has the latitude to impose civil penalties against a person who has violated Alaska's insurance laws
B. AISH, LLC agrees to pay the civil penalty under AS 21.27 .440 in the amount of $\$ 8761$ for activity that occurred prior to the issuance of the firm license with $\$ 4,380$ suspended.
C. In the event AISH, LLC violates Alaska insurance laws during the next two years, the suspended portion of the penalty referenced in paragraph one will be reinstated. AISH, LLC will be subject to any and all sanctions authorized by the insurance laws including imposition of additional penalties regarding any such violation.
D. By signing this agreement, AISH, LLC understands and agrees that any failure to comply with the conditions of this agreement will be grounds to revoke, suspend, or not renew Alaska firm license 38254 .
E. AISH, LLC understands that this agreement is not binding on the parties unless and until the director signs the order approving the agreement.
