

1	B. On April 20th, 2022, the Surplus Lines Broker license expired for failure to		
2	provide the required documentation of administrative actions taken by other states		
3	and failure to pay a delayed notification fee.		
4	C. On August 1 st , 2022, the division received all required documentation of		
5 6	administrative actions to reinstate the license. The Surplus Lines Broker license		
7	was reinstated.		
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9	D. In a routine internal audit performed in July of 2022, it was discovered that AISH,		
10	LLC had sold policies while their license was expired.		
11	E. On August 25 th , 2022, notice was sent to AISH, LLC informing them of the		
12	division's audit that revealed policies posted before initial licensure. This notice		
13 14	requested a Business Transaction Form verifying any additional business that may		
14	have been placed prior to licensure in the state of Alaska.		
16	F. On August 31 st , 2022, Dennis Burden of AISH, LLC provided a Business		
17	Transaction Form to the division. This form indicated one policy was sold prior to		
18	reinstatement generating a commission of \$8,761.50.		
19	G. On September 6 th , 2022, a proposed agreement was issued to AISH, LLC		
20 21	assessing a civil penalty in the amount of \$8,761 with \$4,380 suspended. The		
22	unsuspended penalty of \$4,380 is payable to the division.		
23	H. On September 7 th , 2022, AISH, LLC responded to the Division's request to move		
24	forward and enter into a formal agreement to pay the civil penalty of \$4,380.		
25	Torvard and onter into a tormar agreement to pay the ervir penalty of \$4,500.		
26	II. TERMS OF AGREEMENT		
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	Alliant Insurance Services Houston, LLC Stipulated Agreement and Order		

1	A.	The policy sold prior to the license issuance date on May 6 th , 2022, was in	
2		violation of AS 21.27.440 which subjects AISH, LLC to civil penalties. AS	
3		21.27.440(a) provides that "in addition to any other penalties provided by law, a	
4 5		person that the director of the division (director) determines under AS 21.06.170-	
6		21.06.240 has violated the provisions of this chapter is subject to (1) a civil	
7		penalty equal to the compensation promised, paid, or to be paid, directly or	
8		indirectly, to a person in regard to each violation; (2) either a civil penalty of not	
9			
10		more than \$10,000 for each violation or a civil penalty of not more than \$25,000	
11		for each violation if the director determines that the person willfully violated the	
12		provisions of this chapter; and (3) denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation	
13		of a license." The director has the latitude to impose civil penalties against a	
14 15		person who has violated Alaska's insurance laws	
16	B.	AISH, LLC agrees to pay the civil penalty under AS 21.27.440 in the amount of	
17		\$8761 for activity that occurred prior to the issuance of the firm license with	
18		\$4,380 suspended.	
19 20	C.	In the event AISH, LLC violates Alaska insurance laws during the next two years,	
20		the suspended portion of the penalty referenced in paragraph one will be	
22		reinstated. AISH, LLC will be subject to any and all sanctions authorized by the	
23		insurance laws including imposition of additional penalties regarding any such	
24		violation.	
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26	D.	By signing this agreement, AISH, LLC understands and agrees that any failure to	
27		comply with the conditions of this agreement will be grounds to revoke, suspend,	
28		or not renew Alaska firm license 38254.
