3	B.	As a part of the application process YOUNG consented to a criminal			
4		background check. YOUNG's background report from the Department of			
5 6		Public Safety revealed misdemeanor convictions effective June 10, 2010,

8		August 18, 2011, and August 13, 2012.			
9	C.	On November 22, 2022, the Division sent correspondence to <b>YOUNG</b>			
10		requesting copy of charging documents, final judgement, and written			
11		statement to support the conviction. No response was received.			
12	D.	On December 20, 2022 the Division received a signed certified mailing			
13		slip which indicated that the document referenced in paragraph C was			
14 15		received by YOUNG. The Division did not receive the correction			
16		documents as requested.			
17	E.	On March 4, 2024, the Division sent another correspondence after an			
18		internal audit of YOUNG's license history proposing to settle the			
19		violation by assessing civil penalties of \$250. No respond was received.

4 5	II. TERMS OF AGREEMENT
6	A. YOUNG was in violation for failing to report her misdemeanor
7	convictions to the Division which subjects YOUNG to civil penalties.
8	Alaska Statute (AS) 21.27.440(a) provides that "in addition to any other
9	penalties provided by law, a person that the director (director) determines
10 11	under AS 21.06.170-21.06.240 has violated the provisions of this chapter
11	is subject to (1) a civil penalty equal to the compensation promised, paid,
13	or to be paid, directly or indirectly, to a person in regard to each violation;
14	
15	(2) either a civil penalty of not more than \$10,000 for each violation or a
16	civil penalty of not more than \$25,000 for each violation if the director
17	determines that the person willfully violated the provisions of this chapter;
18	and (3) denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license." The
19	director has the latitude to impose civil penalties against a person who has
20 21	violated Alaska's insurance laws.
21	B. AS 21.27.020(a) provides: "For the protection of the people of this state,
23	the director may not issue or renew a license except in compliance with
24	
25	this chapter and not issue a license to a person, or to be exercised by a
26	person, found by the director to be untrustworthy, incompetent, or who
27	has not established to the satisfaction of the director that the person is
28	qualified under this chapter."

1	C. AS 21.27.020(b)(4) provides: "To qualify for issuance or renewal of an
2	individual license, an applicant or licensee shall (4) be a trustworthy
3	person."
4 5	D. AS 21.27.040(a) states that "(a) Application for a license shall be made to
6	the director upon forms prescribed by the director. As a part of or in
7	connection with the application, the applicant shall furnish information
8	concerning the applicant's identity, personal history, experience, business
9 10	record, purposes, and other pertinent facts that the director may reasonably
11	require. The applicant shall declare, subject to penalty of denial,
12	nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license issued by the director,
13	that the statements made in or in connection with the application are true,
14 15	correct, and complete to the best of the applicant's knowledge and
16	belief"
17	E. YOUNG agree to pay the civil penalty under AS 21.27.440 in the amount
18	of \$250. Payment must be received within one year of the signature
19 20	finalizing this agreement.
21	F. By signing this agreement, YOUNG understand and agrees that any failure
22	to comply with the terms of this agreement will be grounds to revoke,
23	suspend, or non-renew Alaska license number 3002201102.
24	G. YOUNG understands that this agreement is not binding on the parties
25 26	unless and until the director signs the order approving the agreement.
