



- 1 B. On September 7, October 6, and November 8, 2022, the Division provided  
2 ACKERMAN renewal notices informing of the impending expiration date of  
3 November 30, 2022.  
4
- 5 C. On December 6, 2022, and January 5, 2023, an expiration notice was sent to  
6 ACKERMAN informing him that his license expired for failure to renew  
7 timely.  
8
- 9 D. On September 23, 2024, the Division received an application to reinstate the  
10 Insurance Producer license for ACKERMAN.  
11
- 12 E. On September 27, 2024, the Division requested a Business Transaction Form  
13 (BTF) from ACKERMAN in support of his application.  
14
- 15 F. On January 9, 2025, ACKERMAN's license was reinstated.  
16
- 17 G. On March 17, 2025, BTF form was submitted by ACKERMAN. BTF indicated  
18 policies were sold without a valid license in the State of Alaska. The policies  
19 totaled \$15,450 in commission received without a valid license.  
20
- 21 H. On April 30, 2025, the Division sent a proposed settlement agreement to  
22 ACKERMAN imposing civil penalties of \$15,450 with \$7,725 suspended.  
23 The unsuspended penalty of \$7,725 is payable to the Division.  
24
- 25 I. On May 28, 2025, ACKERMAN accepted the proposed penalty assessed.

## 27 II. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

- 28 A. Between November 30, 2022, and the reinstatement date of ACKERMAN's  
29 license on January 9, 2025, numerous policies were transacted and were in  
violation of AS 21.27.010 which subjects ACKERMAN to civil penalties. AS  
21.27.440(a) provides that "in addition to any other penalties provided by law, a

1 person that the director determines under AS 21.06.170-21.06.240 has violated  
2 the provisions of this chapter is subject to (1) a civil penalty equal to the  
3 compensation promised, paid, or to be paid, directly or indirectly, to a person in  
4 regard to each violation; (2) either a civil penalty of not more than \$10,000 for  
5 each violation or a civil penalty of not more than \$25,000 for each violation if  
6 the director determines that the person willfully violated the provisions of this  
7 chapter; and (3) denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license.” The  
8 director has the latitude to impose civil penalties against a person who has  
9 violated Alaska’s insurance laws.

12 B. ACKERMAN further agrees to pay the civil penalty in the amount of \$15,450  
13 for activity that occurred prior to the reinstatement of firm license with \$7,725  
14 suspended. The unsuspended portion of \$7,725 must be received by the  
15 Division within 30 days of the signature finalizing this agreement.
- 16  
17 C. In the event ACKERMAN is found to have violations of the Alaska insurance  
18 laws during the next two years, the suspended portion of the penalty of \$7,725  
19 referenced in section II. B. will be reinstated. ACKERMAN also will be subject  
20 to any and all sanctions authorized by the insurance laws including imposition  
21 of additional penalties regarding any such violation.

23 D. By signing this agreement, ACKERMAN understands and agrees that any  
24 failure to comply with the terms of this agreement will be grounds to revoke,  
25 suspend, or non-renew license number 3001779050.
- 26  
27 E. ACKERMAN understands that this agreement is not binding on the parties  
28 unless and until the director signs the order approving the agreement.
