4	ELLIS-POU. In that renewal application, ELLIS-POU responded			
6	negatively to all background questions. During review, it was discovered			
7	that ELLIS-POU attached documentation of misdemeanor convictions in			
8	the Attachment Warehouse. This documentation revealed that ELLIS-			
9 10	POU incorrectly responded negatively to background question 1 and 2 at			
11	initial application indicating no administrative action or criminal			
12	conviction to report to the Division.			
13	C. The Producer Database reflects that administrative action was taken			
14	against ELLIS-POU in State of Washington in effect March 25 th , 2022.			
15 16	The documentation uploaded by ELLIS-POU indicates misdemeanor			
17	convictions in effect October 27 th , 2011, and November 7 th , 2011. The			
18	administrative action and misdemeanor convictions were not disclosed to

25	II. TERMS OF AGREEMENT			
26	A. ELLIS-POU was in violation for failing to report its administrative actions to the			
27 28	Division which subjects ELLIS-POU to civil penalties. Alaska Statute (AS)

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1		21.27.440(a) provides that "in addition to any other penalties provided by law, a
2		person that the director (director) determines under AS 21.06.170-21.06.240 has
3		violated the provisions of this chapter is subject to (1) a civil penalty equal to the
4		compensation promised, paid, or to be paid, directly or indirectly, to a person in
5		
6		regard to each violation; (2) either a civil penalty of not more than \$10,000 for
7		each violation or a civil penalty of not more than \$25,000 for each violation if the
9		director determines that the person willfully violated the provisions of this
10		chapter; and (3) denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license." The
11		director has the latitude to impose civil penalties against a person who has
12		violated Alaska's insurance laws.
13	B.	AS 21.27.020(a) provides: "For the protection of the people of this state,
14		the director may not issue or renew a license except in compliance with

13	to comply with the terms of this agreement will be grounds to revoke, suspend, or
14	non-renew Alaska firm license number 3001563092.
15 16	G. ELLIS-POU understands that this agreement is not binding on the parties unless
17	and until the director signs the order approving the agreement.
