ACCUSATION AND ORDER OF REVOCATION

1. On February 7, 2023, the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development, Division of Insurance (Division) received an Insurance Producer license application to transact the business of Health insurance for **SHANNA RENEE SUMMITT (SUMMITT)**, domiciled in the State of Missouri.
2. **SUMMITT's** application was processed as all background questions were answered "no", the Division issued license number 3002366928. The license has an expiration date of December 31 on odd numbered years.
3. On December 12, 2023, the Division received renewal application from **SUMMITT**. In that renewal application **SUMMITT** responded affirmatively to background question 1B.

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- 4. During the application review, a licensed examiner discovered **SUMMITT** submitted documentation to the Attachment Warehouse of a felony conviction in the State of Missouri in effect September 7, 2011. **SUMMITT** submitted the conviction in the Attachment Warehouse but responded negatively to the background question regarding felony conviction on the initial application.
- 5. **SUMMITT** provided inaccurate information on her initial application and failed to disclose the felony conviction.
- 6. On April 15, 2024, the Division issued a proposed agreement to **SUMMITT** assessing a civil penalty under Alaska Statute 21.27.440 intending to resolve the failure to disclose the felony conviction. **SUMMITT** elected not to pay the fine and opted for revocation.
- 7. Failure to comply with AS 21.27.040(a) subjects **SUMMITT** to civil penalties pursuant to AS 21.27.440(a) “in addition to any other penalties provided by law, a person that the director (director) determines under AS 21.06.170-21.06.240 has violated the provisions of this chapter is subject to (1) a civil penalty equal to the compensation promised, paid, or to be paid, directly or indirectly, to a person in regard to each violation; (2) either a civil penalty of not more than \$10,000 for each violation or a civil penalty of not more than \$25,000 for each violation if the director determines that the person willfully violated the provisions of this chapter; and (3) denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license.” The

1 director has the latitude to impose civil penalties against a person who has
2 violated Alaska's insurance law.

3 8. AS 21.27.040(a) states that "(a) Application for a license shall be made to
4 the director upon forms prescribed by the director. As a part of or in
5 connection with the application, the applicant shall furnish information
6 concerning the applicant's identity, personal history, experience, business
7 record, purposes, and other pertinent facts that the director may reasonably
8 require. The applicant shall declare, subject to penalty of denial,
9 nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license issued by the director,
10 that the statements made in or in connection with the application are true,
11 correct, and complete to the best of the applicant's knowledge and
12 belief..."

13 9. AS 21.27.020(a) provides: "For the protection of the people of this state,
14 the director may not issue or renew a license except in compliance with
15 this chapter and not issue a license to a person, or to be exercised by a
16 person, found by the director to be untrustworthy, incompetent, or who
17 has not established to the satisfaction of the director that the person is
18 qualified under this chapter."

19 10. AS 21.27.020(b)(4) provides: "To qualify for issuance or renewal of an
20 individual license, an applicant or licensee shall (4) be a trustworthy
21 person."
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11. AS 21.27.025(b) states that “(b) In addition to any other penalty provided by law, a failure to notify the director as required by this section is cause for denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license.”

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, under the provisions of AS 21.27.440, that **SHANNA RENEE SUMMITT**’ Insurance Producer license number 3002366928 is REVOKED for a period of one year.
