ACCUSATION AND ORDER OF REVOCATION

1. On February 6, 2024, the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development, Division of Insurance (Division) received an Insurance Producer license application to transact the business of Health insurance for **CHRISTINA D MILLER (MILLER)**, domiciled in the State of Texas.
2. **MILLER's** application was processed as all background questions were answered "no", the Division issued license number 3002938595. The license has an expiration date of January 31 on odd numbered years.
3. During the application review, a licensed examiner discovered **MILLER** submitted documentation to the Attachment Warehouse of a misdemeanor conviction effective September 9, 2002 in the State of Texas. **MILLER**

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1 submitted the conviction in the Attachment Warehouse but responded
2 negatively to the initial application.

3 4. **MILLER** provided inaccurate information on her initial application and
4 failed to disclose her misdemeanor conviction.

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6 5. On June 6, 2024, the Division issued a proposed agreement to **MILLER**
7 assessing \$250 civil penalty under Alaska Statute 21.27.440 intending to
8 resolve the failure to disclose the misdemeanor conviction. No response
9 was received.

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11 6. On July 3, 3024, the Division sent correspondence of **MILLER's**
12 proposed agreement, failure to respond, along with a notice that a
13 revocation is in order. **MILLER** did not respond.

15 7. Failure to comply with AS 21.27.040(a) subjects **MILLER** to civil
16 penalties pursuant to AS 21.27.440(a) "in addition to any other penalties
17 provided by law, a person that the director (director) determines under AS
18 21.06.170-21.06.240 has violated the provisions of this chapter is subject
19 to (1) a civil penalty equal to the compensation promised, paid, or to be
20 paid, directly or indirectly, to a person in regard to each violation; (2)
21 either a civil penalty of not more than \$10,000 for each violation or a civil
22 penalty of not more than \$25,000 for each violation if the director
23 determines that the person willfully violated the provisions of this chapter;
24 and (3) denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license." The
25 director has the latitude to impose civil penalties against a person who has
26 violated Alaska's insurance law.
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29 CHRISTINA MILLER
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8. AS 21.27.040(a) states that “(a) Application for a license shall be made to the director upon forms prescribed by the director. As a part of or in connection with the application, the applicant shall furnish information concerning the applicant's identity, personal history, experience, business record, purposes, and other pertinent facts that the director may reasonably require. The applicant shall declare, subject to penalty of denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license issued by the director, that the statements made in or in connection with the application are true, correct, and complete to the best of the applicant's knowledge and belief...”

9. AS 21.27.020(a) provides: "For the protection of the people of this state, the director may not issue or renew a license except in compliance with this chapter and not issue a license to a person, or to be exercised by a person, found by the director to be untrustworthy, incompetent, or who has not established to the satisfaction of the director that the person is qualified under this chapter.”

10. AS 21.27.020(b)(4) provides: "To qualify for issuance or renewal of an individual license, an applicant or licensee shall (4) be a trustworthy person."

11. AS 21.27.025(b) states that “(b) In addition to any other penalty provided by law, a failure to notify the director as required by this section is cause for denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license.”

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IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, under the provisions of AS 21.27.440, that **CHRISTINA D MILLER**' Insurance Producer license number 3002938595 is REVOKED for a period of one year. **MILLER** is still subject to civil penalties for future reinstatement.
