#### ACCUSATION AND FINAL ORDER

Lori Wing-Heier, Director of the Division of Insurance (Division), Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (DCCED), State of Alaska, states the issues on which the accusation is based as follows:

- On December 1, 2023, HEIDI LYNN HARNIST (HARNIST),
   domiciled in the State of Texas applied for an Insurance Producer license
   requesting Health authority with the Division to conduct insurance
   business in the State of Alaska.
- Upon review of the application, HARNIST responded negatively to background question 1B, indicating no criminal convictions to report to the State of Alaska.

- 3. The Attachment Warehouse indicated HARNIST was convicted of a felony in the State of New Mexico in effect June 29, 2000. The documentation in the warehouse received from HARNIST stated HARNIST has a felony conviction. HARNIST failed to provide complete information on her initial application and responded to the background questions incorrectly.
- 4. On December 6, 2023, correspondence was provided to HARNIST informing of the conflicting information reported in the Producer Database and her failure to respond accurately to the background question regarding felony conviction. The Division provided HARNIST the opportunity to voluntarily withdraw the application and provide a new, complete, and accurate application within 30 days. No response was received.
- 5. AS 21.27.040(a) states that "(a) Application for a license shall be made to the director upon forms prescribed by the director. As a part of or in connection with the application, the applicant shall furnish information concerning the applicant's identity, personal history, experience, business record, purposes, and other pertinent facts that the director may reasonably require. The applicant shall declare, subject to penalty of denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license issued by the director, that the statements made in or in connection with the application are true, correct, and complete to the best of the applicant's knowledge and belief…"
