ACCUSATION AND FINAL ORDER

Lori Wing-Heier, Director of the Division of Insurance (Division), Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (DCCED), State of Alaska, states the issues on which the accusation is based as follows:

- On November 15, 2024, DIANNA O SHEA (O SHEA), domiciled in the State of California applied for an Independent Adjuster license requesting Property, and Casualty lines of authority with the Division to conduct business in the State of Alaska.
- Upon review of the application, O SHEA responded negatively to background question 2, indicating no administrative action to report to the State of Alaska.

- 3. The Producer Database reflects administrative action was taken against O SHEA in the State of Idaho in effect September 12, 2024. O SHEA failed to disclose her administrative action to the Division and provided inaccurate information on her application.
- 4. On November 29, 2024, correspondence was provided to O SHEA informing of her failure to respond accurately to a background question regarding administrative actions. The Division provided O SHEA the opportunity to voluntarily withdraw the application and provide a new, complete, and accurate application within 30 days. No response was received.
- 5. Alaska Statute 21.27.040(a) states that "(a) Application for a license shall be made to the director upon forms prescribed by the director. As a part of or in connection with the application, the applicant shall furnish information concerning the applicant's identity, personal history, experience, business record, purposes, and other pertinent facts that the director may reasonably require. The applicant shall declare, subject to penalty of denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license issued by the director, that the statements made in or in connection with the application are true, correct, and complete to the best of the applicant's knowledge and belief…"
- 6. AS 21.27.020(a) provides: "For the protection of the people of this state, the director may not issue or renew a license except in compliance with this chapter and not issue a license to a person, or to be exercised by a
