**ACCUSATION AND FINAL ORDER**

Lori Wing-Heier, Director of the Division of Insurance (Division), Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (DCCED), State of Alaska, states the issues on which the accusation is based as follows:

1. On September 26, 2024, **ANDREW ROBERT SCHULTZ (SCHULTZ)**, domiciled in the State of California applied for an Insurance Producer and Surplus Lines Broker license requesting Property, and Casualty lines of authority with the Division to conduct business in the State of Alaska.

- 1                   2. Upon review of the application, **SCHULTZ** responded negatively to  
2                   background question 2, indicating no administrative actions to report to  
3                   the State of Alaska.
- 4                   3. The Producer Database and the Attachment Warehouse reflects  
5                   administrative action was taken against **SCHULTZ** in the State of  
6                   Washington in effect February 16, 2021. **SCHULTZ** failed to disclose his  
7                   administrative actions to the Division and provided inaccurate information  
8                   on his application.
- 9                   4. On October 3, 2024, correspondence was provided to **SCHULTZ**  
10                  informing of his failure to respond accurately to a background question  
11                  regarding administrative actions. The Division provided **SCHULTZ** the  
12                  opportunity to voluntarily withdraw the application and provide a new,  
13                  complete, and accurate application within 30 days. No response was  
14                  received.
- 15                  5. Alaska Statute 21.27.040(a) states that “(a) Application for a license shall  
16                  be made to the director upon forms prescribed by the director. As a part of  
17                  or in connection with the application, the applicant shall furnish  
18                  information concerning the applicant's identity, personal history,  
19                  experience, business record, purposes, and other pertinent facts that the  
20                  director may reasonably require. The applicant shall declare, subject to  
21                  penalty of denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license  
22                  issued by the director, that the statements made in or in connection with  
23                  24                  25                  26                  27                  28

1 the application are true, correct, and complete to the best of the applicant's  
2 knowledge and belief..."

3 6. AS 21.27.020(a) provides: "For the protection of the people of this state,  
4 the director may not issue or renew a license except in compliance with  
5 this chapter and not issue a license to a person, or to be exercised by a  
6 person, found by the director to be untrustworthy, incompetent, or who  
7 has not established to the satisfaction of the director that the person is  
8 qualified under this chapter."  
9

10 7. AS 21.27.020(b)(4) provides: "To qualify for issuance or renewal of an  
11 individual license, an applicant or licensee shall (4) be a trustworthy  
12 person."  
13

14 8. Pursuant to AS 21.27.040(a), **SCHULTZ** provided inaccurate information  
15 at the time of application. Based on the above **SCHULTZ's** Insurance  
16 Producer and Surplus Lines Broker license application is hereby DENIED.

18 ORDER

19 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**, under the provisions of AS 21.27.040(a) that **ANDREW**  
20 **ROBERT SCHULTZ's** application for the Insurance Producer and Surplus Lines  
21 Broker license in Alaska under National Producer Number (NPN) # 16928628 is  
22 DENIED for supplying inaccurate information on the application for licensure.
