On its own motion the Alaska Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (AOGCC) has tentatively scheduled a hearing to propose an amendment to the rules to waive or modify certain requirements of 20 AAC 25.280 concerning Sundry Notice and Reporting requirements for workover operations including through tubing, pumping, rig/coil and other operations regarding the following:
Conservation Order 747, Greater Moose's Tooth Field, Lookout Oil Pool
Conservation Order 793, Greater Moose's Tooth Field, Rendezvous Oil Pool

The AOGCC has tentatively scheduled a public hearing on this matter for December 7, 2021 at 10:00 a.m. via Microsoft Teams. To request that the tentatively scheduled hearing be held, a written request must be filed with the AOGCC no later than 4:30 p.m. on November 23, 2021.
