

## Notice of Public Hearing

### STATE OF ALASKA ALASKA OIL AND GAS CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Re: Docket Number: CO-20-019

The application of Hilcorp Alaska, LLC (Hilcorp) to amend Conservation Order No. 510A to allow for the addition of perforations in Undefined Sterling Pool in KU 21-07 above Sterling Gas Pool 3, defined in CO 510A for the Kenai Gas Field.

By application received September 22, 2020, Hilcorp requests that Alaska Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (AOGCC) amend Conservation Order No. 510A to allow regular production for the KU 21-07 gas development well from an Undefined Sterling Gas Pool within 1,500 feet of a property line where the owners and landowners are not the same on both sides of the line and within 3,000 feet of a well open to or capable of producing from the same pool (KU 42-12).

Pursuant to 20 AAC 25.537 (a)(1) and (a)(2), Kenai Unit 21-07 well:

Surface Hole Location (SHL): 450' FSL, 935' FWL, Sec. 6, T4N, R11W, Seward Meridian

Top of Production Horizon (TPH): 110' FSL, 1,401' FWL, Sec. 6, T4N, R11W, Seward Meridian

Bottom-hole Location (BHL): 17' FNL, 1,589' FWL, Sec. 7, T4N, R11W, Seward Meridian

The AOGCC has tentatively scheduled a public hearing on this subject for October 29, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. at 333 West 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Anchorage, Alaska 99501. To request that the tentatively scheduled hearing be held, a written request must be filed with the AOGCC no later than 4:30 p.m. on October 15, 2020.

If a request for a hearing is not timely filed, and the AOGCC deems the information submitted in support of Hilcorp's application sufficient to make a decision, the AOGCC may issue an order without a hearing. To learn if the AOGCC will hold the hearing, call (907) 279-1433 after October 16, 2020.

If a hearing is requested, the COVID-19 virus may necessitate that the hearing be held telephonically. Those desiring to participate or be present at the hearing should check with AOGCC the day before the hearing to ascertain if the hearing will be telephonic. If the hearing is telephonic, on the day of the hearing, those desiring to be present or participate should call 1-800-315-6338 and, when instructed to do so, enter the code 14331 followed by the # sign. Because the hearing will start at 10:00 a.m., the phone lines will be available starting at 9:45 a.m. Depending on call volume, those calling in may need to make repeated attempts before getting through.

In addition, written comments regarding this application may be submitted to the AOGCC, at 333 West 7th Avenue, Anchorage, Alaska 99501. Written comments must be received no later than 4:30 p.m. October 28, 2020, except that if a hearing is held, comments will be accepted until the conclusion of the October 29, 2020 hearing.
