Application Window Open for Aerospace Engineer on the Technical Working Group of the Statewide Broadband Advisory Board.

Updated on August 3, 2023.

Purpose:

The board is seeking qualified candidates to serve on the Technical Working Group for the Statewide Broadband Advisory Board (SBAB). The Alaska Broadband Office was founded to support the investment of the expected broadband infrastructure funding that the State of Alaska will receive from the Infrastructure, Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA). The technical working group will play a key role offering their technical expertise to the Statewide Broadband Advisory Board, to support the mission of the Alaska Broadband Office to bridge the digital divide in Alaska.

Qualifications:

The SBAB is seeking an Aerospace Engineer who has expertise in their field and project work experience in the state of Alaska. Anyone is welcome to apply for this vacancy if they feel they have the relevant experience to offer appropriate guidance to the SBAB.

Expected Contribution:

Members of the advisory board and broadband technical working group are not entitled to compensation, per diem, or reimbursement of travel expenses. It is expected that the members of the Technical Working Group commit to meeting semi-regularly on a volunteer basis to support the efforts of the SBAB. If appointed, members of the Technical Working Group should expect to commit 3 to 5 hours of work every month to board matters.

Application Period:

The application period is reopening for only the Aerospace Engineer vacancy. At this time, no due date for the application has been set. Public notice of the closure of the application window will be posted a minimum of 2 weeks before any set future deadlines.
