

b. TradeStation shall not state, imply, or infer that it is licensed by the Division to transmit virtual currency;

c. Whenever and wherever TradeStation discloses that it holds an Alaska money transmission license, it must also disclose that the license has not been issued for TradeStation to transmit virtual currency, using the following disclosure: Please note that this license does not cover the transmission of virtual currency.

TradeStation understands and agrees that its failure to comply with the terms of the limited license agreement shall be deemed to be a violation of the Alaska Uniform Money Services Act (AS 06.55 *et. seq.*) and may lead to formal administrative action, which may include, but not be limited to, license revocation or suspension and/or civil penalties under AS 06.55.605.

TradeStation understands that this Agreement is a public document and will be posted on the Division's website.
